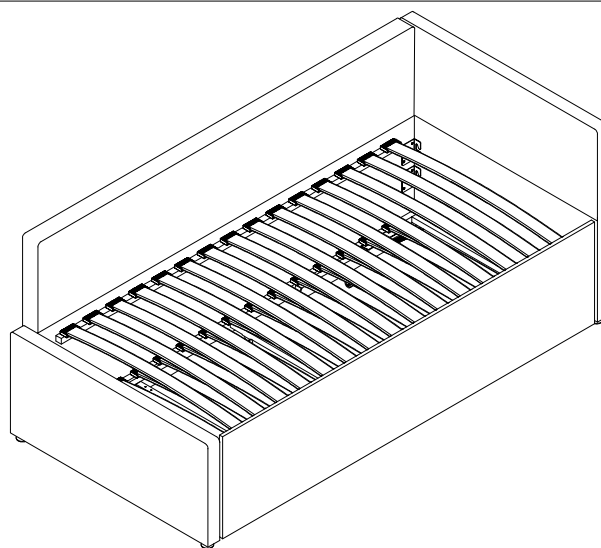




BAILEY DAYBED

SINGLE BED ASSEMBLE INSTRUCTION

Top Tips before you start!

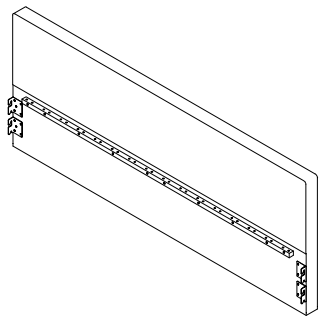
1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture, as once assembled, the furniture is exempt from our home approval policy.
2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
3. For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people (as indicated on page to assemble you product safely).
4. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
5. For the protection of your furniture, particularly items of high gloss finish, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
6. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product.

Care and Maintenance of your Furniture

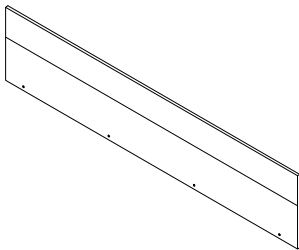
- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- To clean your item, please use a damp cloth and wipe clean.
- Please do not jump on your furniture.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause finishes to de-laminate.
- Periodically check the condition of your bed slats and plastic locating caps to ensure they are in good condition and have not become loose.
- This is very important when moving your bed. It is best to lift the bed, and never to drag it.
- Please kindly take account of your floor covering when assembling a new bed! If the floor offers little resistance (such as wood or laminate) then it is recommended to use rug or similar be placed under each leg.

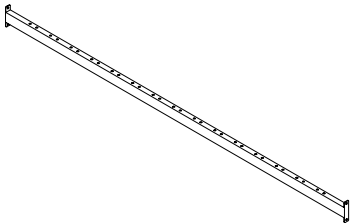
(A) Backboard x 1



(B) Trundle front panel x 1

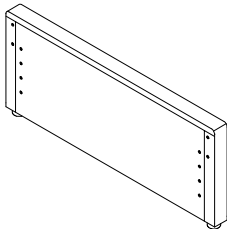


(C) Trundle metal centre rail x 1

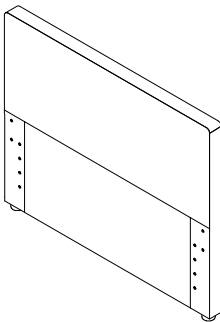


Component of Carton 2

(D) Sideboard (L) x 1

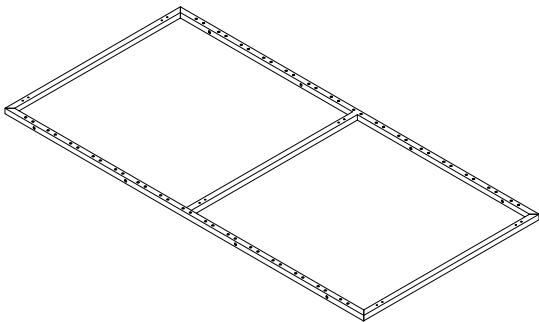


(E) Sideboard (R) x 1

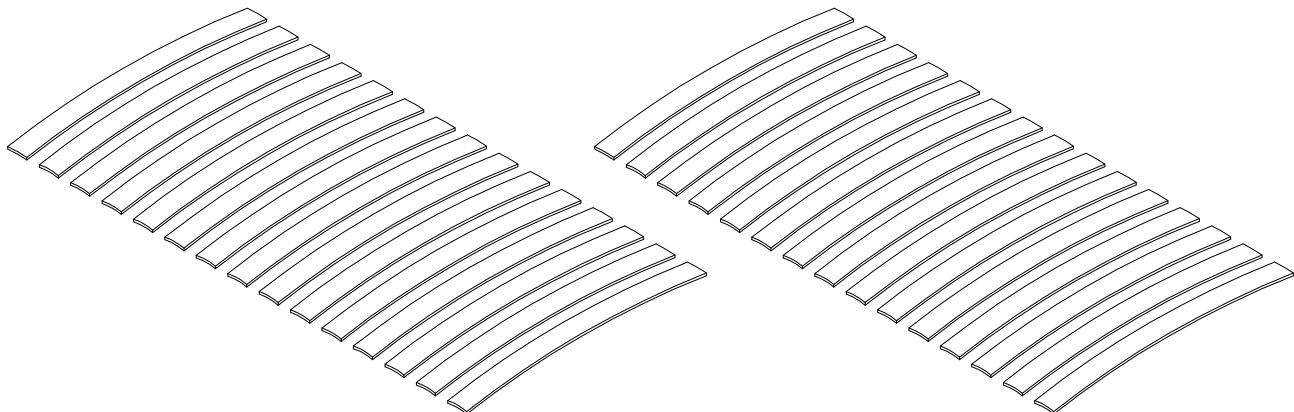
(F) Trundle metal frame x 1

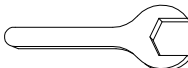
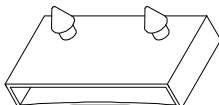

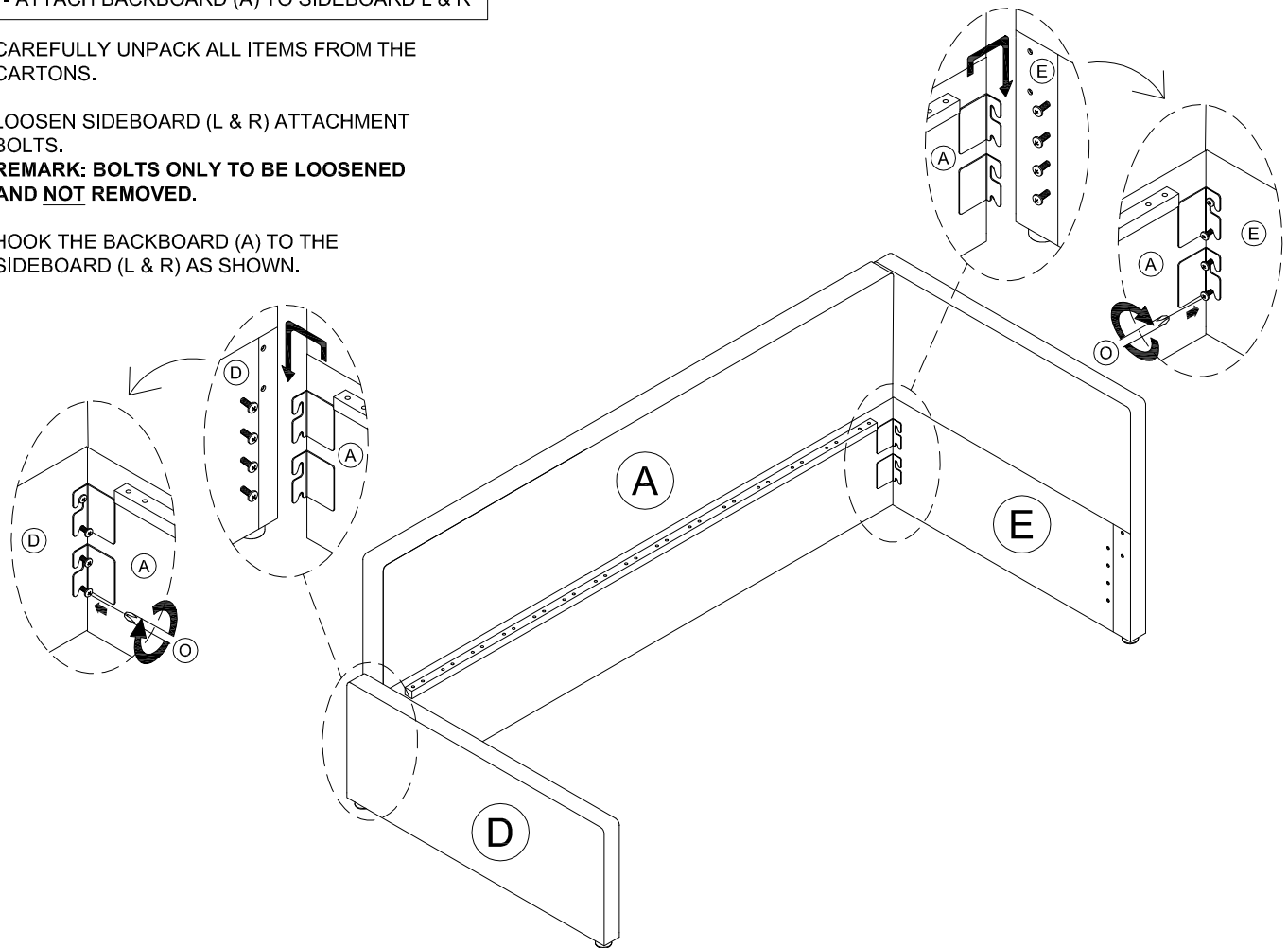
1- ATTACH BACKBOARD (A) TO SIDEBORD L & R

CAREFULLY UNPACK ALL ITEMS FROM THE CARTONS.

LOOSEN SIDEBORD (L & R) ATTACHMENT BOLTS.

REMARK: BOLTS ONLY TO BE LOOSENED AND NOT REMOVED.

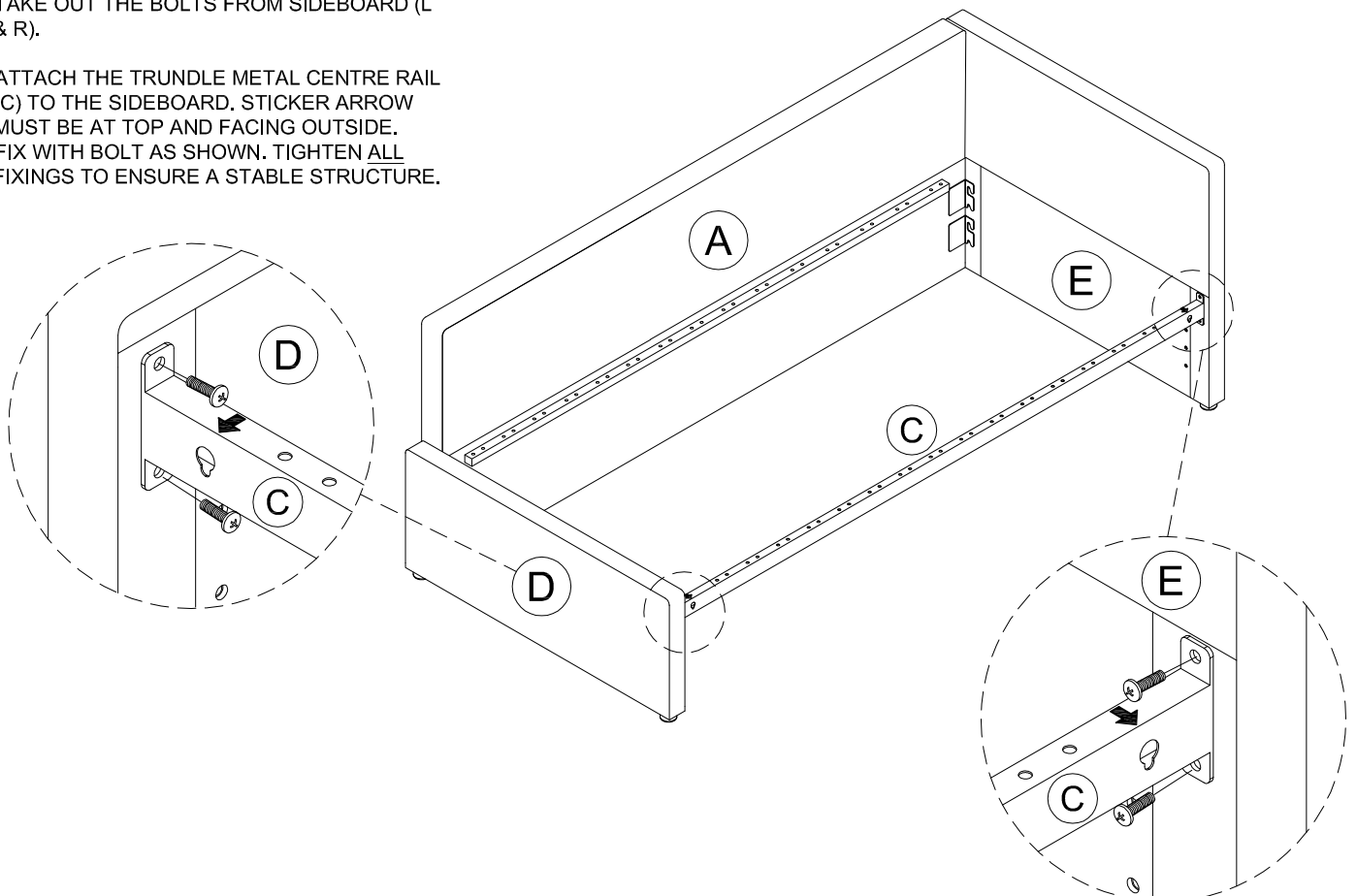
HOOK THE BACKBOARD (A) TO THE SIDEBORD (L & R) AS SHOWN.



2- ATTACH TRUNDLE METAL CENTRE RAIL (C) TO SIDEBORD (L & R)

TAKE OUT THE BOLTS FROM SIDEBORD (L & R).

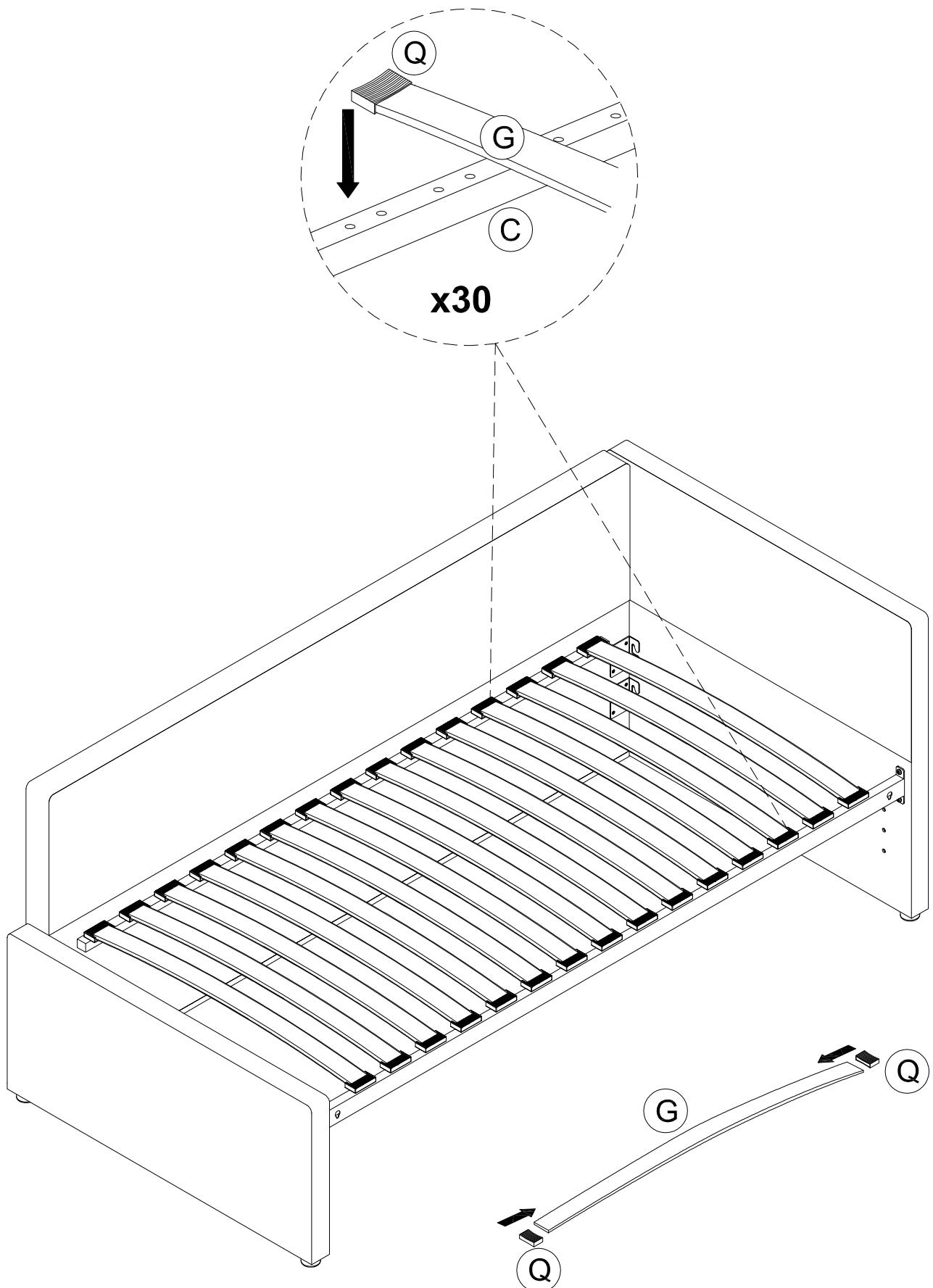
ATTACH THE TRUNDLE METAL CENTRE RAIL (C) TO THE SIDEBORD. STICKER ARROW MUST BE AT TOP AND FACING OUTSIDE. FIX WITH BOLT AS SHOWN. TIGHTEN ALL FIXINGS TO ENSURE A STABLE STRUCTURE.



3- ATTACH END CAPS (Q) TO POSTURE SLATS (G)

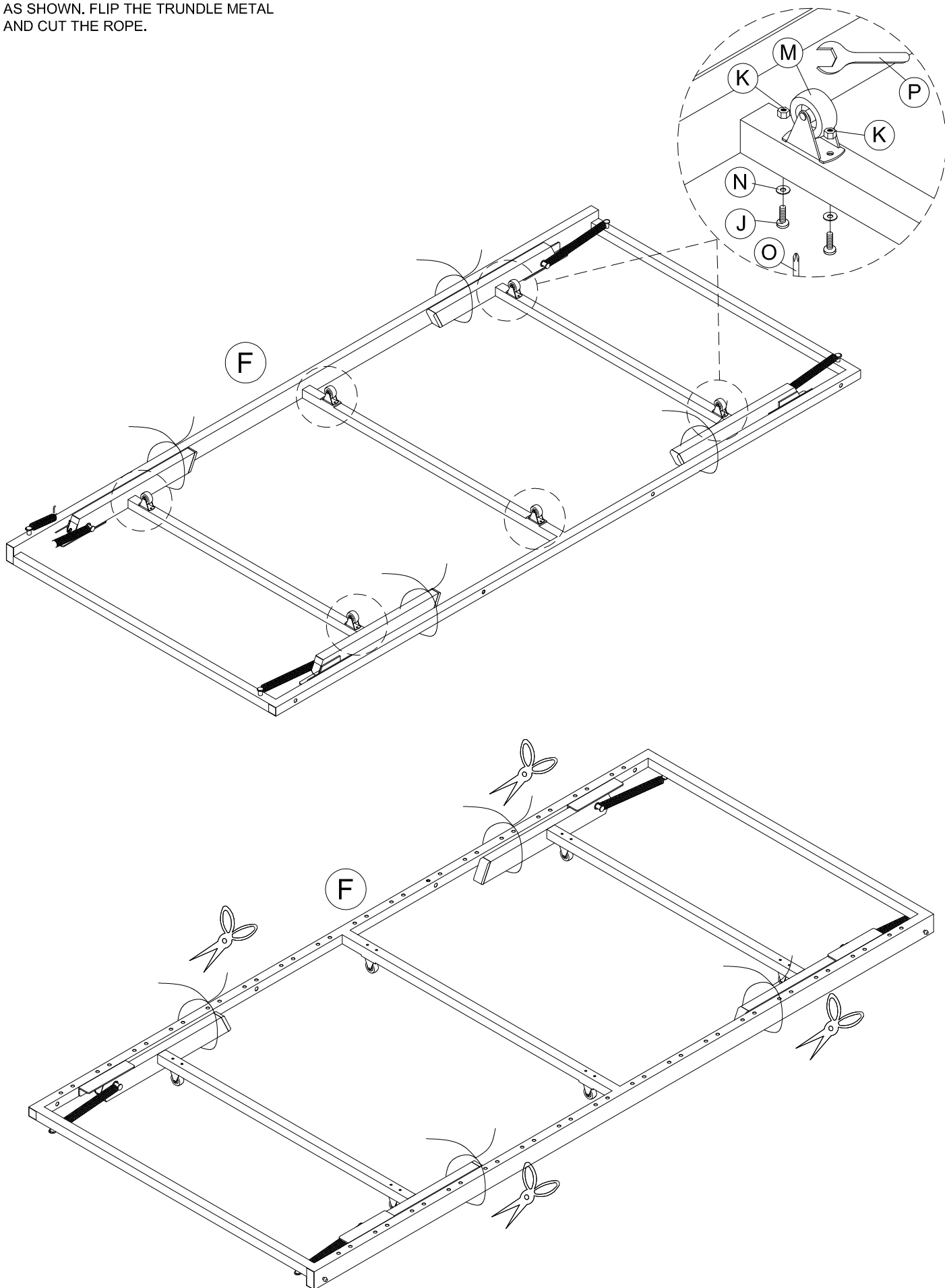
ATTACH THE END CAPS (Q) TO BOTH END OF POSTURE SLATS (G) AS SHOWN.

FIRMLY PUSH THE END CAP LUGS INTO THE HOLES IN THE BACKBOARD (A) & TRUNDLE METAL CENTRE RAIL (C).



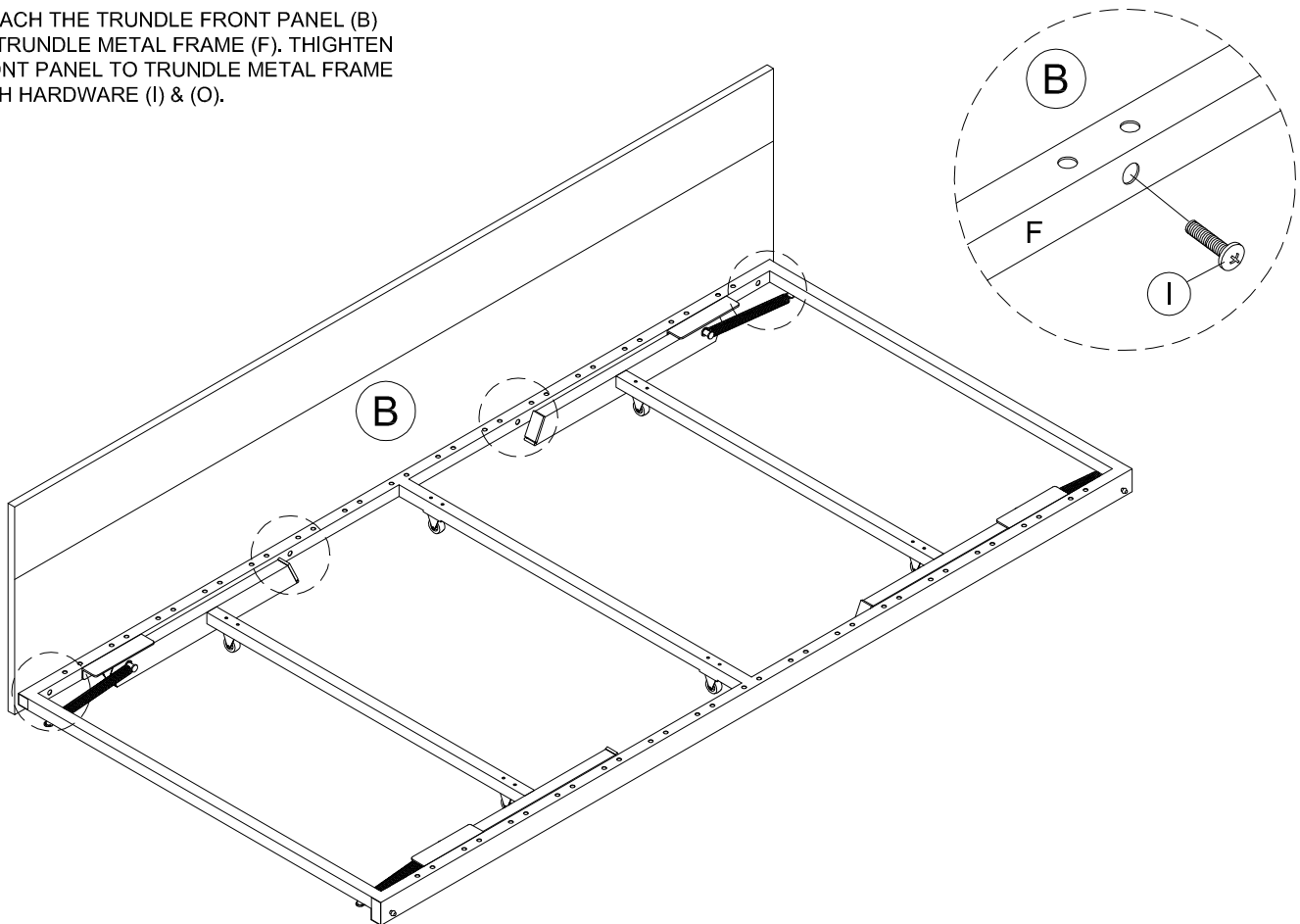
4- ATTACH CASTORS (M) TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F)

ATTACH CASTORS (M) TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F) & FIX WITH THE HARDWARES AS SHOWN. FLIP THE TRUNDLE METAL AND CUT THE ROPE.



5- ATTACH TRUNDLE FRONT PANEL (B) TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F)

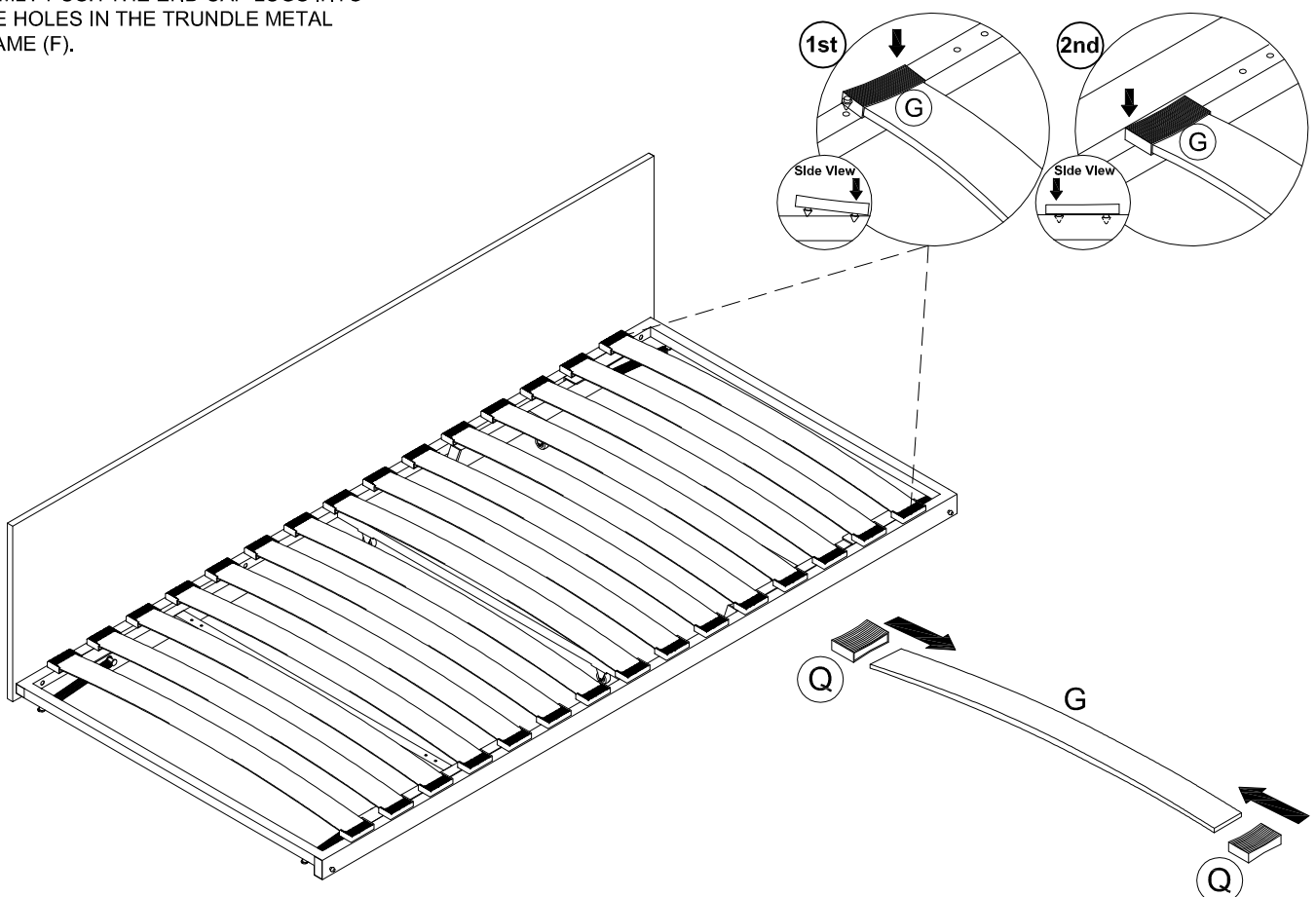
ATTACH THE TRUNDLE FRONT PANEL (B) TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F). TIGHTEN FRONT PANEL TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME WITH HARDWARE (I) & (O).



6- ATTACH POSTURE SLATS WITH END CAPS TO TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F)

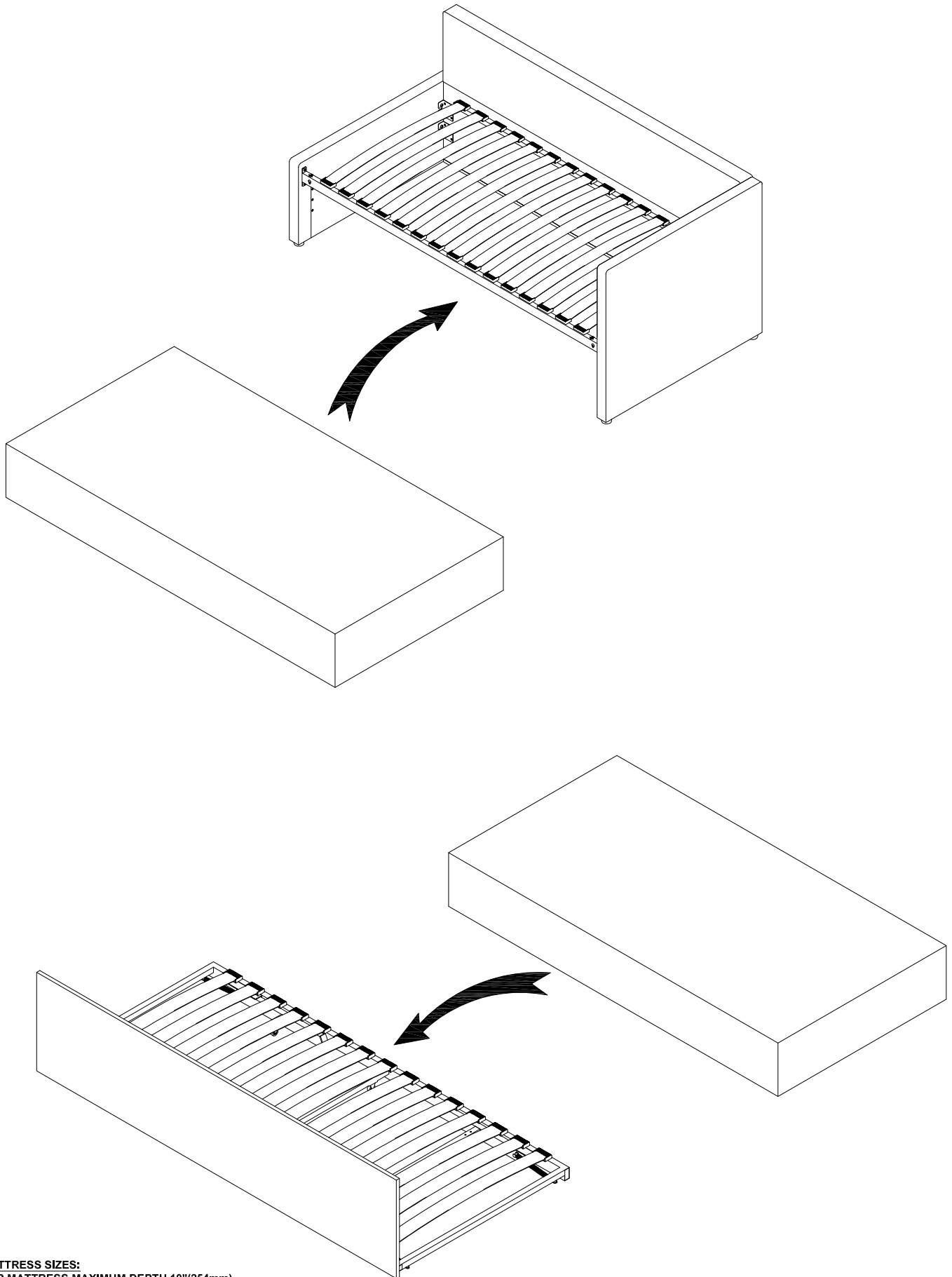
FIRMLY PUSH THE END CAP LUGS INTO THE HOLES IN THE TRUNDLE METAL FRAME (F).

INSERTING END CAP TO THE FLIP METAL FRAME



7- PUT THE MATTRESS

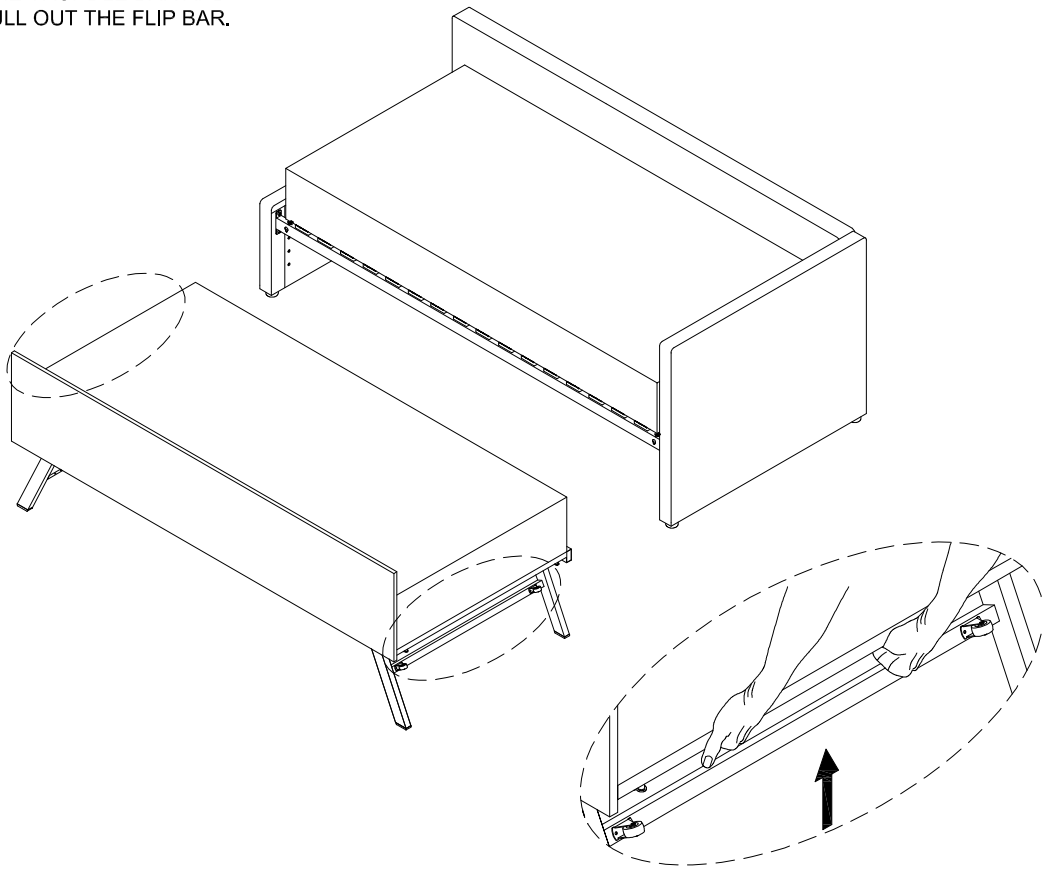
PUT THE MATTRESS ON TOP OF THE SLATS.

TOP MATTRESS MAXIMUM DEPTH 10"(254mm)
LOWER MATTRESS MAXIMUM DEPTH 10"(254mm)
TOP AND LOWER BED MAXIMUM WEIGHT LOAD 95KG

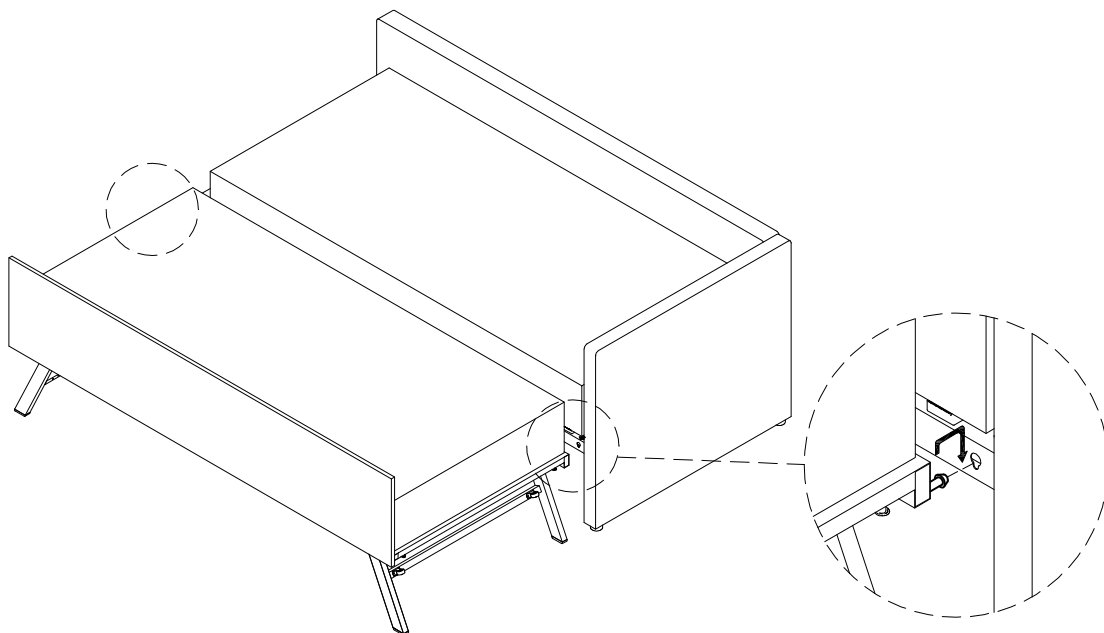
8- OPEN THE TRUNDLE LEG

USE 2 HANDS TO OPEN THE TRUNDLE LEG.
ONE HAND HOLD THE TRUNDLE BAR AND
ANOTHER HAND PULL OUT THE FLIP BAR.



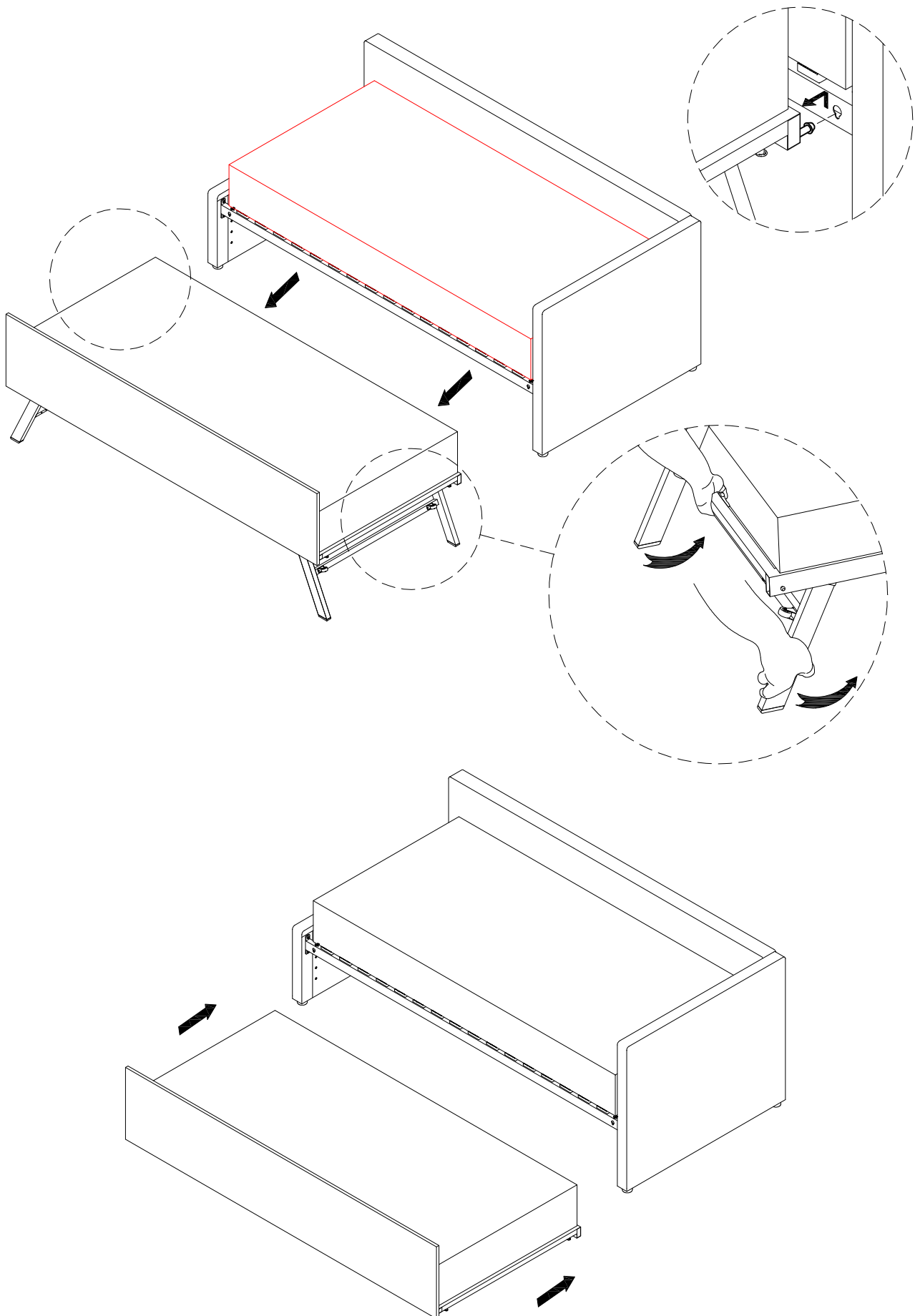
9- ATTACH THE TRUNDLE TO TRUNDLE METAL CENTRE RAIL.

INSERT THE PIN (AS SHOWN) TO THE
TRUNDLE METAL CENTRE RAIL END HOLE.

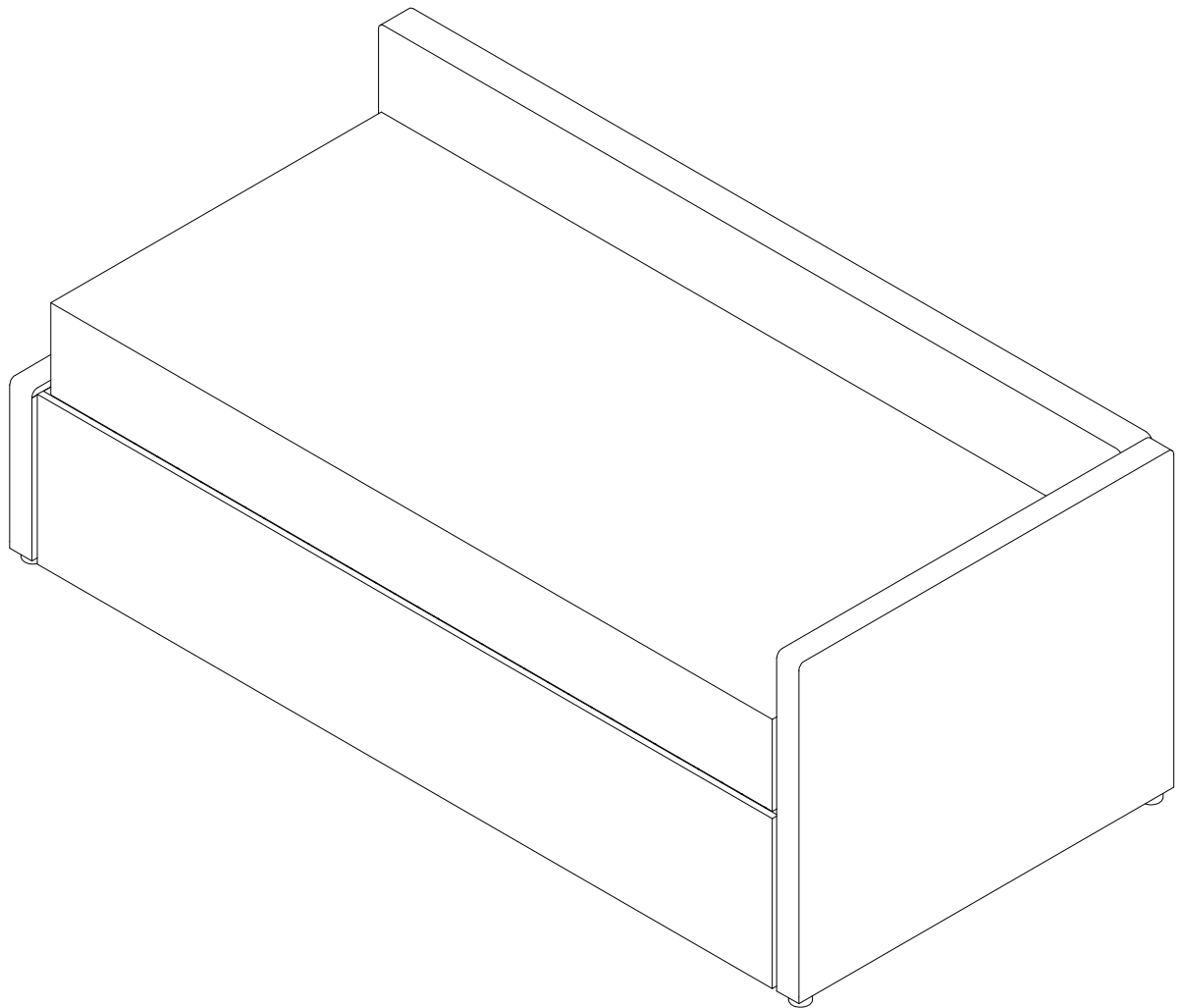


10- PULL OUT AND FLIP THE TRUNDLE.

LIFT A BIT THE TRUNDLE AND PULL OUT THE PIN FROM TRUNDLE CROSS RAIL HOLE. USE TWO HANDS TO FLIP THE LEG. HOLD THE TRUNDLE BAR AND ANOTHER HAND PUSH TO FLIP THE TRUNDLE LEG.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS.

1. KEEP AWAY FROM DIRECT SUNLIGHT TO AVOID DISCOLORATION.
2. DO NOT DRAG THE BED ACROSS THE FLOOR WHEN POSITIONING OR MOVING WHILST CLEANING.
3. TIGHTEN ALL SCREWS AT REGULAR INTERVALS, TO AVOID DAMAGE TO THE FRAME.
4. ENJOY YOUR PRODUCT.

On Delivery

Once your new bed is in place and all the packaging is removed, let it air for approximately 1 hour before putting on your mattress, mattress protector and bed linen.

Don't worry if your bed feels a little strange at first. It takes time for your body to adjust to a new level of support and comfort. You'll soon be enjoying a more relaxed sleep.

Please consider the surface your bed will be stood on. If your bed frame is to be stood on an uncarpeted surface please ensure that you use rubber backed mat under the legs to avoid slipping.

Day to day Care

Check all bolts, screws and legs regularly to make sure they haven't loosened and tighten all joins of your furniture or bedstead after 6 months. Please keep these instructions in a safe place for further use.

Storage Drawers in Bedsteads are designed to carry lightweight items such as Pillows, duvets and linen. Please try to avoid storing heavier items such as books or toys.

Returns

If you have bought a large item such as a bed or mattress which is damaged or faulty and would like to return it, we will be able to arrive at your home and take your item away. All we ask is that your item is in perfect condition and in its original packaging (you can open the packaging to inspect your item). Items will not be able to be returned if they are not in their original packaging.

For online and telesales orders, you can only return an item within 7 days from the date of your delivery.
