

Hello, thanks for choosing to purchase your bed from Dreams - you're now on your way to your best ever night's sleep. Before you begin building your bed, please take a moment to read through the instructions and make sure that you've got all the relevant parts listed on the following pages.



## Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



## Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



## Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.


## Recycling

# Parts

## Important information

The bed you have purchased comes with 2 different base options, solid slats or sprung slats. Please identify which base you have purchased as the assembly method may change. If you have purchased solid or sprung slats please follow the instructions below in the current order.



Legs (H&I) are only supplied with the sprung system.

# Bed assembly - use pack 'A'




Loosely screw in the bolts but do not tighten them 100% yet.


Make certain the bed is squared up, as shown in the diagram.



Once all four corners are located, make sure the bed is square as in the sketch, then tighten all the bolts 100% using Allen key (d).




# Fitting wooden slats - use pack 'B'




- i Using two bolts (e) with spring washers (v), flat washers (g) and sleeve nuts (f) loosely fix one slat next to headboard.


Carefully lay wooden slat set (E) on the metal supports on each side rail.



- ii Roll out wooden slats just over half way down the bed and using two more bolt sets, loosely bolt the central slat into position - align slats and fix all four bolt sets 100% by Allen key (h).






- iii Fit centre slat with the support leg (F) using screw (u) and flat washer (g). Fully tighten using a cross-head screwdriver.

Carefully turn adjustable foot clockwise until it just touches the floor and slat is horizontal.



- iv Roll out rest of the wooden slats and fix with last two bolt sets; fully tighten using Allen key (h).




# Fitting upgraded sprung slat frame use pack 'B'




- i 1. The support legs each have four adjustable parts that need to be set to suit the height of the bed slat frame. Please adjust the height of each leg by selecting the correct hole and inserting the bolts and nuts as shown.
- 2. You can fine-tune the height of each leg by screwing the adjustable foot in or out so it just touches the floor.




- ii Open the sprung slat frame and lay face down on the working surface. Fit the support legs (I & H) to the positions shown securing with the bolts (p). Fully tighten using Allen key (h).





- iii Carefully turn the slat frame over and position onto the metal slat supports on each side panel. Align the frame with the fixing holes at each end and secure using four sets of bolts (e), spring washers (v), flat washers (g) and sleeve-nuts (f). When all in place tighten using Allen key (h).



Finally, please check carefully that all bolts are fully tightened before the bed is used.



# Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



## Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



## Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



## Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



## Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



## Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
