

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your sofa bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new sofa bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built sofa bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.

- 3. Large Backest x 1pc (Pack 2)
- 4. Small Backest x 1pc (Pack 2)
- 5. Cube Leg x 6pcs (Pack 2)

- 6. Round Leg x 6pcs (Pack 2)
- 7. Caster x 4pcs (Pack 2)
- 8. Sofa x 1pc (Pack 3)
- 9. Cushion x 1pc (Pack 3)
- 10. Cushion x 1pc (Pack 3)

Tools required




Allen Key M5 (included) Allen Key M4 (included)



Place Armrests (1) upside down on a clean, flat surface.

Align and affix Cube Legs (5) to the bottom of the Armrests using Bolts (A) the M5 Allen Key (C) (supplied).






Place Chaise (2) upside down on a clean, flat surface.

Align and affix Cube Legs (5) to the bottom of the Chaise using Bolts (A) and the M5 Allen Key (C).


Align and affix Round Legs (6) to the bottom of the Chaise. Twist the legs clockwise to secure them in place.






Carefully turn Sofa (1) 90 degrees on a clean, flat surface as shown.


Align and affix Round Legs (6) to the bottom of the Sofa. Twist the legs clockwise to secure them in place. Align and affix Casters (7) to the bottom frame of the Sofa using Bolts (B) and the M4 Allen Key (D).






Align inserts each side and push the Large Backrest (3) backward to secure it onto the Sofa. Align inserts each side and push the Small Backrest (4) backward to secure it onto the Chase.








With help from an assistant, carefully align inserts and attach the Sofa to the Armrest.






With help from an assistant, carefully align inserts and attach the Chaise to the Armrest.






With help from an assistant, carefully align inserts and attach the Sofa to the Chaise.

Attach Cushions (9), (10) to the Large Backrest, Small Backrest with the Zipper as Steps 8a, 8b, 8c, 8d. Note: Each side of the zipper was pre-attached on the back of cushions and the front of backrests.






Operating Instructions

FROM SOFA TO BED

Grasp the handle on the pull-out drawer and pull out carefully until it is fully extended, then pull upwards and outwards until the pop-section is in place.






Operating Instructions

FROM BED TO SOFA


To collapse the pop-up section, pull upwards carefully on the handle, then push the pop-up section downwards and backwards until it within the drawer.



TO OPEN the Folding Table / Armrest with cupholders by pulling down the centre back section.

TO CLOSE the Folding Table / Armrest with cupholders by pulling up the centre back section.

TO ACCESS the Chaise Storage by lifting the chaise cushion from its front edge, which should open on a hinge to reveal the storage space underneath. Gently close the cushion by lowering it until it rests securely in place.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new sofa bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new sofa bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new sofa bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between sofa beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
