

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your chair. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new chair in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built sofa bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this sofa bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.



Chair Assembly


Use Pack 'X'



Unpack your chair and check you have all the neccessary items (see page 3).

Place the chair face down on a clean, flat surface.


Affix the legs as shown in the diagram on the right, using the bolts and allen key supplied.





Turn your chair over and place on its legs.

The back part should slot into place using the fixings already there.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new chair in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new chair, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new chair, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between chairs. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
