

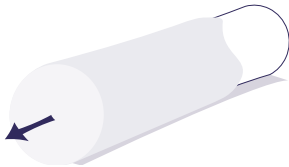

## MATTRESS OPENING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

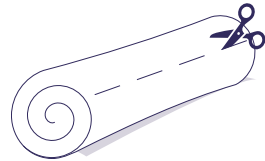
Once opened, your new mattress will be ready to use in around 4-6 hours.

1



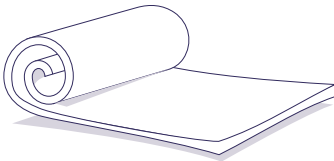
Remove the outer plastic bag and recycle according to your local guidelines.

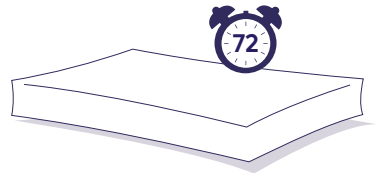
Make an opening across the inner bag, being careful not to damage the mattress. Remove and recycle along with the outer bag.

Allow to unroll naturally. During the recovery process, there may be some creasing as a result of the rolling. This is normal and will disappear over time and does not prevent you from using your new mattress straight away.

Mattresses containing foam may require up to 72 hours to fully recover.

# MATTRESS CARE

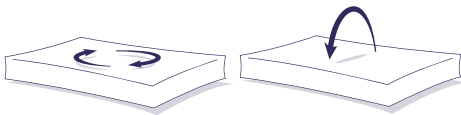
All mattresses need a little care to make sure you always get the very best sleep possible, but also to preserve its longevity.

## FRESH AND LOVELY

Do not cover your mattress straight away. Allow it to air thoroughly for at least 6 hours. Also airing the mattress on a regular basis will help keep the comfort fillings and fabric fresh.

## MATTRESS WEAR

The fillings in your mattress are designed to flex to your body contours. To avoid premature wear on the fillings we recommend that every 3 months you either rotate the mattress from head to foot for **Non Turn** (one sided) mattresses.

## TREAT IT KINDLY - DO'S AND DON'TS

Treat your new mattress kindly and it will look after you. **Please do not attempt to bend or fold your mattress after unrolling**, as it will likely cause it damage. Also if it has a zipped cover, it's only to aid manufacture and is not removable for washing. Any loose threads should be cut away with a pair of scissors. never pull the thread as this could cause stitching to come undone and cause damage to the fabric.

## CLEANING

Should the surface need cleaning, it may be lightly sponged with a weak solution of soap and water. Detergents or chemical cleaners should be avoided to prevent potential damage to the covering material. Use a mattress protector to ensure your mattress remains in good condition.
