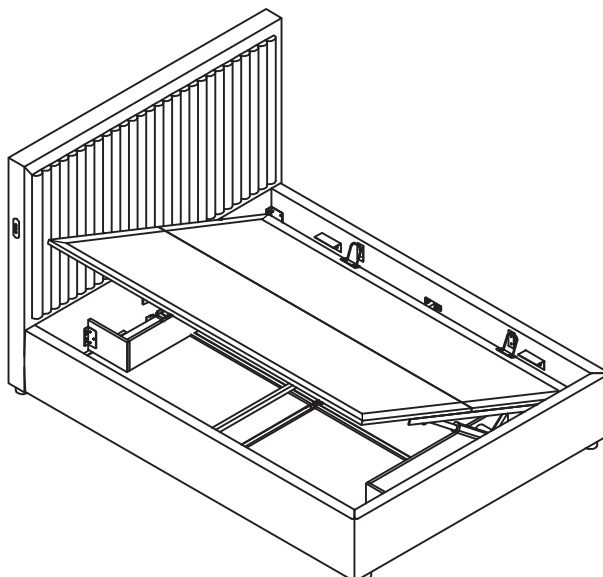


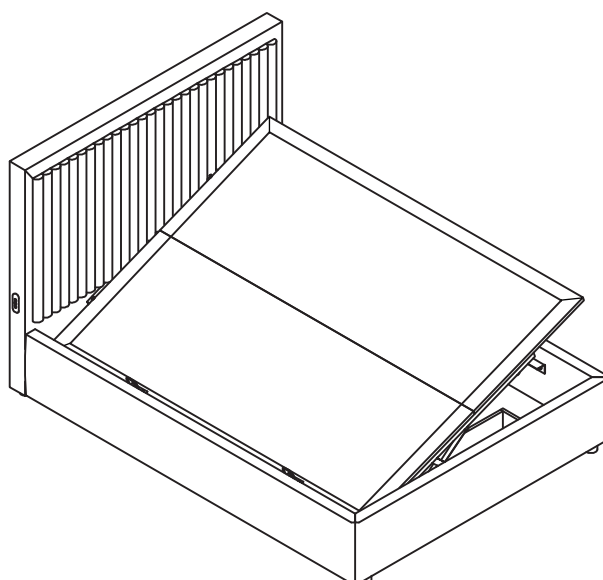

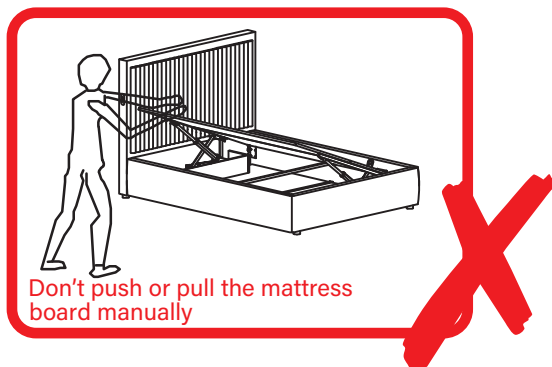
IMPORTANT OTTOMAN SAFETY WARNINGS

- **IMPORTANT-READ CAREFULLY - RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**
- **Ensure the combine bedding and mattress weight is within the recommended weight guidance.**

Recommended weight guidance for safe operation:

- **Adult Operation Only:**
Not recommended for the use by children under the age of 12 years old,
- **Avoid Entrapment:**
Always raise the electric lift right to the upper limit.
Do not put hands or body near the lifting platform.
Use the buttons only on the side being lifted.
In case of a power cut, carefully read the emergency instructions in Step 24.
Only use the operating buttons, on the side being lifted.



- **Fully Open Ottoman:** Ensure the ottoman is **FULLY** open before accessing the storage area.
- **Avoid Hinge Area:** Do not reach into the storage area through the hinge mechanism.
- **Keep Children and Pets Away:** Ensure children and pets stay away from the storage area, Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.
- **Do not attempt to lie on the mattress** when the ottoman is in the raised position.
- **Note:** The bed uses an electric motor system - please treat it with respect.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect your bed to ensure it is functioning correctly.

Assembly tips

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. 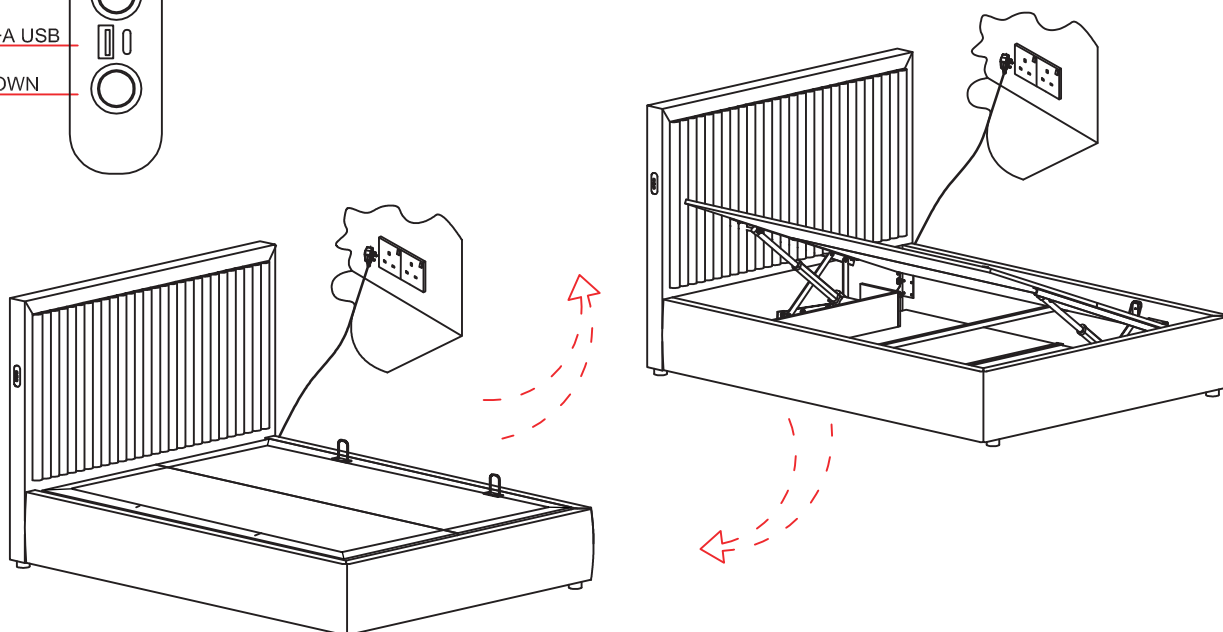
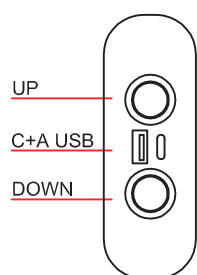
For safety, the system is always locked.

On each side of the headboard is a control station with two buttons as below.

For 3 seconds press both buttons at the same time, you will hear a beep - this means the system is now unlocked.

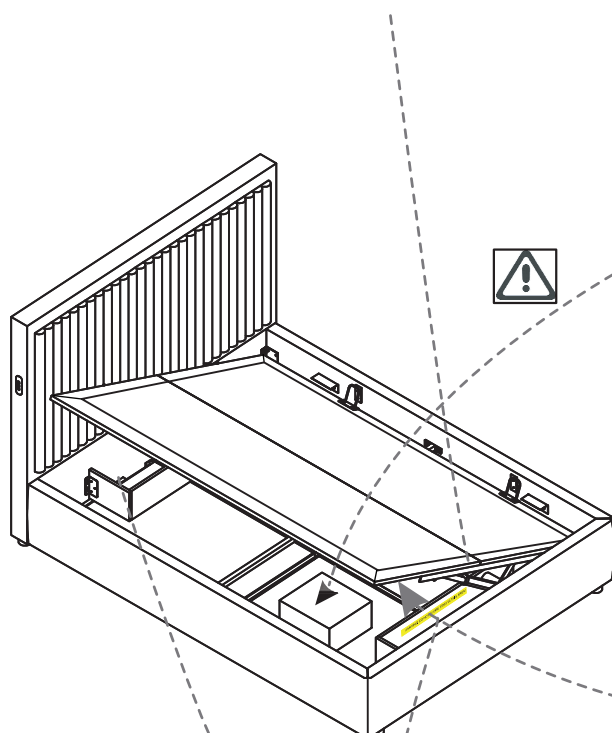
You can now raise or lower the platform by pressing the appropriate up or down button continuously - remove your finger and the platform will stop.

After stopping, in one minute the system will lock. To start again repeat the above procedure.



Warnings - Mattress Base Boards

⚠ WARNING! HAZARD - DO NOT REACH INTO THE SPACE BELOW!



WARNING! DO NOT STORE ITEMS IN THIS AREA!

Note: Be very careful what you store under the bed - the top of an item, like a suitcase or a box, must not touch the underside of the mattress base or it may get damaged.

Maximum item height is 22.5 cm.

⚠ WARNING

TO AVOID ACCIDENTS

To access the storage area, the ottoman frame **MUST BE FULLY OPENED** and then **FULLY CLOSED** afterwards.

Ensure the combine bedding and mattress weight is within the recommended weight guidance.

Adult Operation Only: Not recommended for use by children under the age of 12 years old. Please note ease of operation is dependent on height and strength of user.

Avoid Entrapment: Only unlock the button control when it is safe to do so.



Fully Open Ottoman: Ensure the ottoman is fully open before accessing the storage area.

Avoid Hinge Area: Do not reach into the storage area through the hinge mechanism.

Keep Children and Pets Away: Ensure children and pets stay away from the storage area. Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.

Maintenance - Regularly inspect your bed to ensure it is functioning correctly.

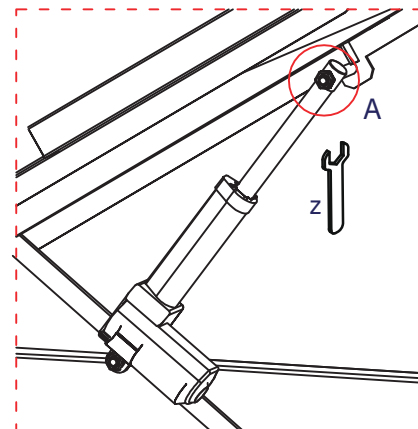

25a Emergency Lowering



In an emergency such as a power cut with the bed in the UP position, it can be lowered by hand;
THIS REQUIRES TWO PEOPLE;

- Unplug the power supply plug from the wall. Remove the mattress & bedding.
- First person supports the mattress base board - if low down, it can be lifted to a working level - if necessary use a suitable prop for safe working.
- Second person removes the two UPPER M8 motor nuts on A with the 17mm spanner supplied in the hardware kit.
- When doing this, do not stand inside the bed on the storage base boards.
- Push the motor link off the pivot pins evenly, gently laying them on top of the storage base-board.
- The mattress base is then gently lowered into it's lower resting position using the hand straps - keep your hands clear of the side rails when lowering the base. It is heavy so be careful..

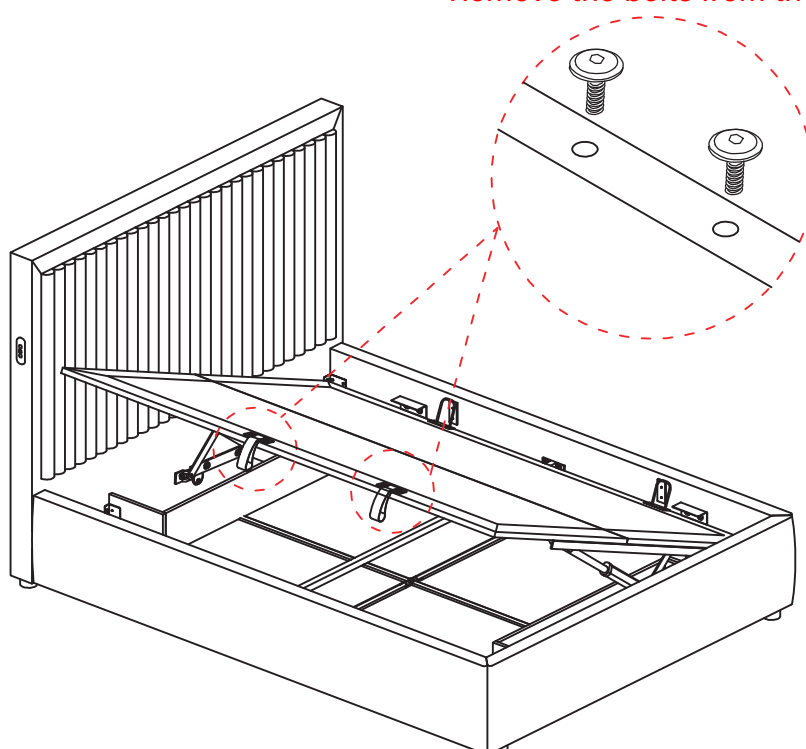

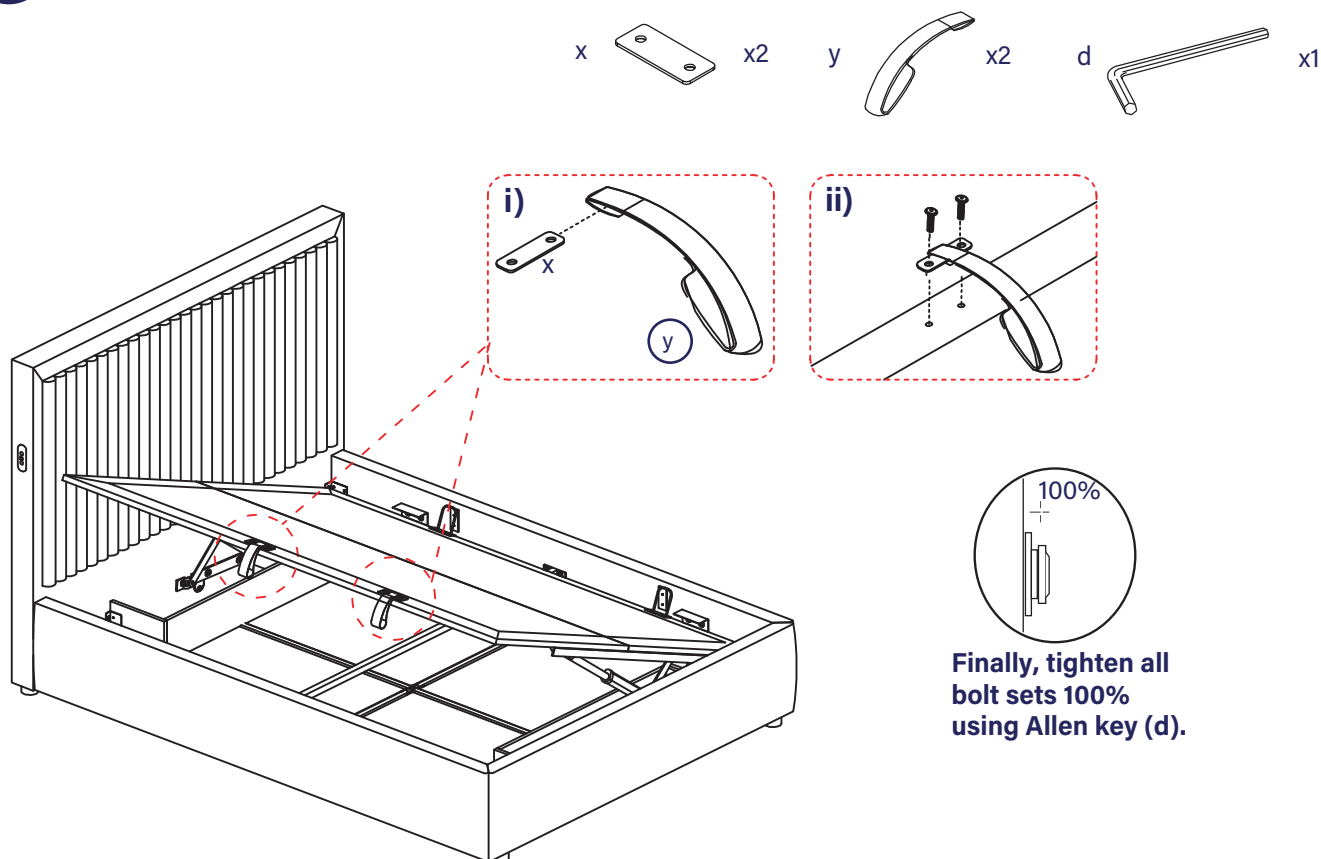

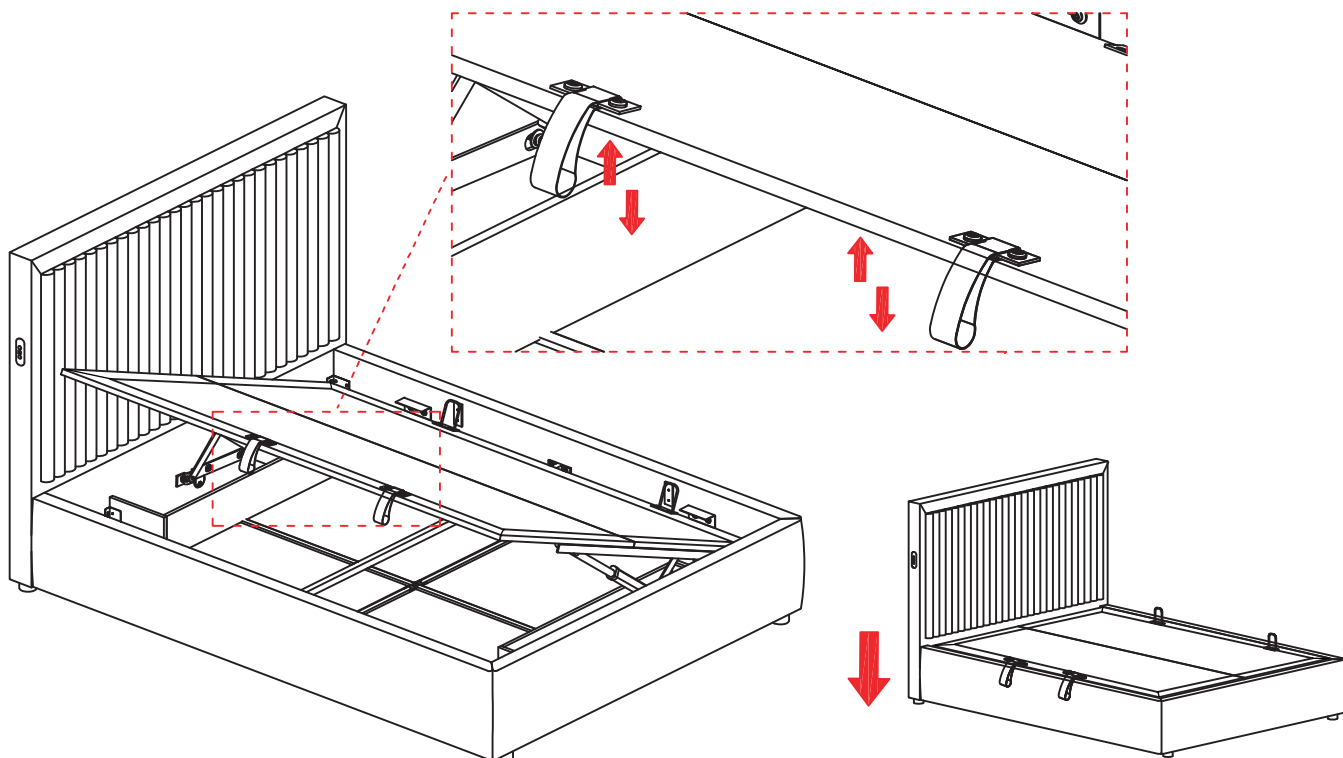

Remove mattress & bedding, assistant holds the frame while lock nuts are removed & pistons taken off and laid down, then frame lowered down with the handle straps.

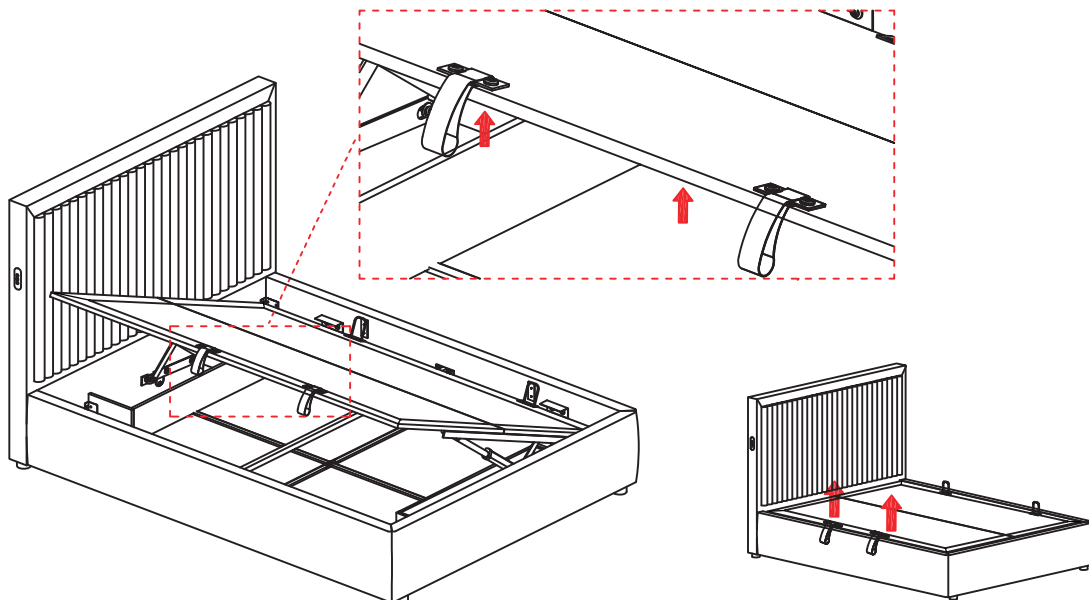


25e Emergency Lifting

When Emergency access is required to the storage area, follow steps 25b, 25c & 25e.



CAUTION: Lift the bed base using the installed emergency fabric hand straps making sure it is sure it is supported by the 2nd person. Once access is gained, lower the bed base back down to its closed position using the emergency fabric hand straps.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner. Please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
