

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your sofa bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new sofa bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built sofa bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.




Sofa Bed Assembly



Place the Sofa Bed (1) upside down on a clean, flat surface.

Align and affix Front Legs (2), Back Legs (3) to the bottom of Sofa Bed using Bolts (A), Washers (B) and the Allen Key (supplied).


• Front legs are oblique, the back legs are straight.


Operating Instructions

FROM BED TO SOFA


To convert to reclining position: Lift back section carefully until you hear one click.


To convert back to sofa position: Lift back section carefully until you hear two clicks.


Ensure that you push from the centre of the back section to avoid damaging the mechanism.



To close the folding table / armrest with cupholders by pulling up the centre back section.








FROM SOFA TO BED

Hold the back of the sofa and tilt forward slowly until a click can be heard, then lower the back until it is lying flat.

Ensure that you push from the centre of the back section to avoid damaging the mechanism.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new sofa bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new sofa bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new sofa bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between sofa beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
