

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.

IMPORTANT OTTOMAN SAFETY WARNINGS

- IMPORTANT READ CAREFULLY RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE
- You must ensure that the mattress is on the bed frame before operating the lift mechanism Failure to do so could result in injury.
- Keep hands clear of the mechanism when opening or closing the ottoman.
- Beware of entrapment Never reach in through the mechanism to access the storage area.
- Always ensure that the ottoman is FULLY opened before accessing the storage area.
- Do not reach into the storage area through the hinge mechanism.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight as specified in the table below:



- Use caution when operating, always use the handle when lifting
- Note: This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- To be operated by adults only
- Please ensure that children and pets are kept away from the bed when operating the lift mechanism.
- Keep children and pets away from the storage area.
- No children or animals are left unattended when the frame is in the 'up' position.
- Do not overload the internal storage base.
- Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed
- Before removing the mattress secure the frame to ensure it does not open unexpectedly.
- Do not attempt to lie on the mattress when the ottoman is in the raised position.
- When lifting the ottoman remove all bedding except the fitted sheet.
- Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed.
- NOTE: When fully assembled and the mattress is in position, please raise and lower the ottoman 4 / 5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.


Attach 2 x legs (6) to the bottom of headboard (1).




Attach 2 x legs (6) to the bottom of bracket (5).

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










Attach brackets (5) to side rail (3 and 4) with 4 X bolts 25mm (C) and 4 X washers (D) by Allen key (B) as shown.




Install 4 x bolts 18 mm (A) to the holes in the headboard (1) as shown by hand. Note: Do not tighten fully but leave 10mm gap as in the diagram.




Attach side rails (3 and 4) to headboard (1) by Allen key (B) as shown.




Attach side rails (3 and 4) to the footboard (2) with 4 \times bolts 25 mm(C) and 4 \times washers(D) by Allen Key (B).




Attach 6 x brackets (E) to the headboard (1), side rails (3 and 4) and footboard (2) with 12 x bolts 25mm (C) by using Allen key(B). Stick the felt pad (F) on each top of bracket (E).





Put the baseboard (7) inside of bed. Attach the velcro to the four edges of frame.



Tighten both slat frame (9 and 10) together with $4 \times 80 \text{ mm}$ (G), $8 \times 80 \text{ mm}$ (G) and $4 \times 80 \text{ mm}$ (I) by using spanner (J) and allen key (B).
















With help form your assistant, lift slat frame (9 and 10) onto slat frame support bars aliging first set of holes on the support bars (nearest to headbaord). Using 8 x bolts 45mm (H) , 16 x wahsers (D) and 8 x nuts (I) by allen key (B) and spanner (J) .

Ensure slat frame (9 and 10) is central with even gaps all around before fully tightening all bolts.


Un-tie each mechanism, take out the transit protection block Tilt the arms upwards slat frame support bar. Tighten all nuts and washers on the arms.







Tighten the center supporter(8) to the side rails (3 and 4) with 4 x screws (K) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided). Stick the felt pad (F) on the top of end of center supporter(8).

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














The bracket (14) must be assembled on the left side rail(4).



Put mattress holders (11) on the slat frame shown in the diagram.



Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed. Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.

NOTE: When fully assembled and the mattress is in position, please raise and lower the ottoman 4 /5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Sleep well

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
