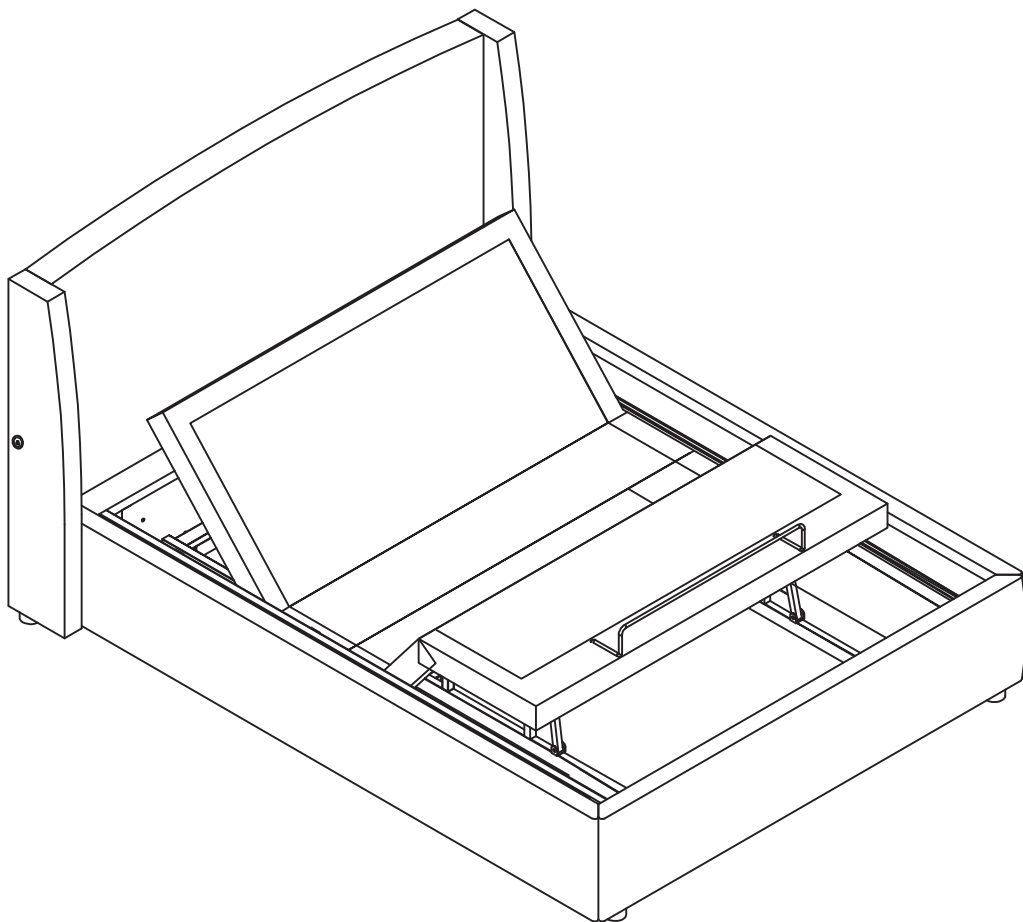

Hello, thanks for choosing to purchase your bed from Dreams - you're now on your way to your best ever night's sleep. Before you begin building your bed, please take a moment to read through the instructions and make sure that you've got all the relevant parts listed on the following pages.



Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.

Recycling

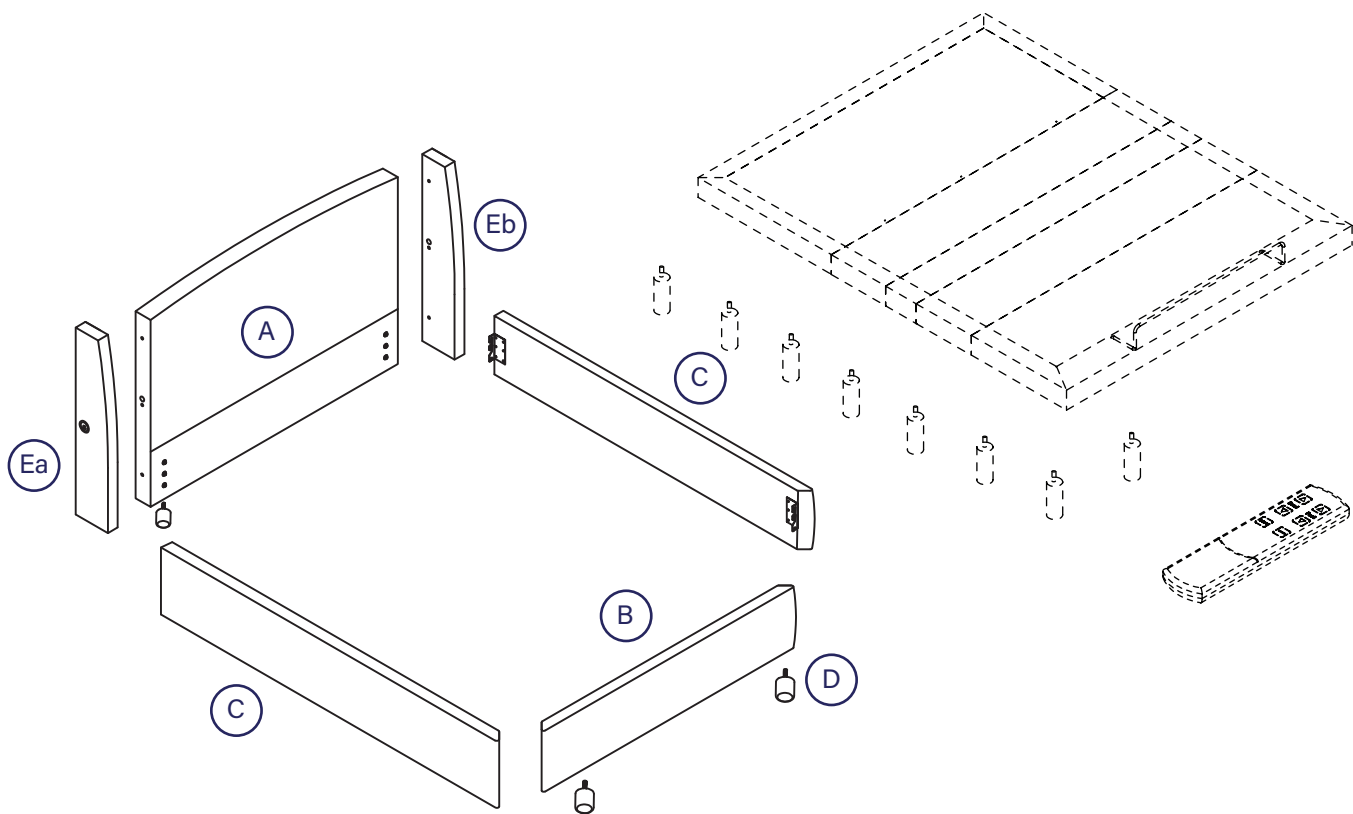

Important information

The bed that you have purchased comes with a Sleepmotion electric bed base. Please follow the instructions that came with the base in the following order.

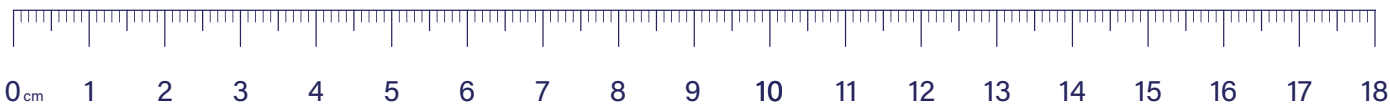
Once the base is built please follow the instructions to build your frame around the Sleepmotion electric base itself.



Parts shown in dotted lines are packed in the Sleepmotion bed base carton.

Before starting assembly please refer to the owners manual supplied with your sleepmotion bed base and follow the instructions taking note of any safety precautions or operational safety requirements of the installation.
Build the bed base first fitting the eight longer legs 6" (15cm), please see step 1.

Important

Place the base in final position in the room it is to be used in and connect the power.

Check the operation then, step by step, follow the bed assembly instructions below, to build the bed around the electric bed base itself.

Please note

To control the bed via an App, please go to the App store or Google Play and download the "NAPP by Dreams".

Once downloaded and registered stand close to the bed and 'add device' then follow the instructions carefully.






When connection is made you will be able to control the Bed using 'NAPP by Dreams'.

Fittings

Please check you have all the parts listed below with your product:

PLEASE NOTE: There are bolts which have been pre-fitted to the Headboard & Footboard (A&B) not included below - please study Step 3 carefully.

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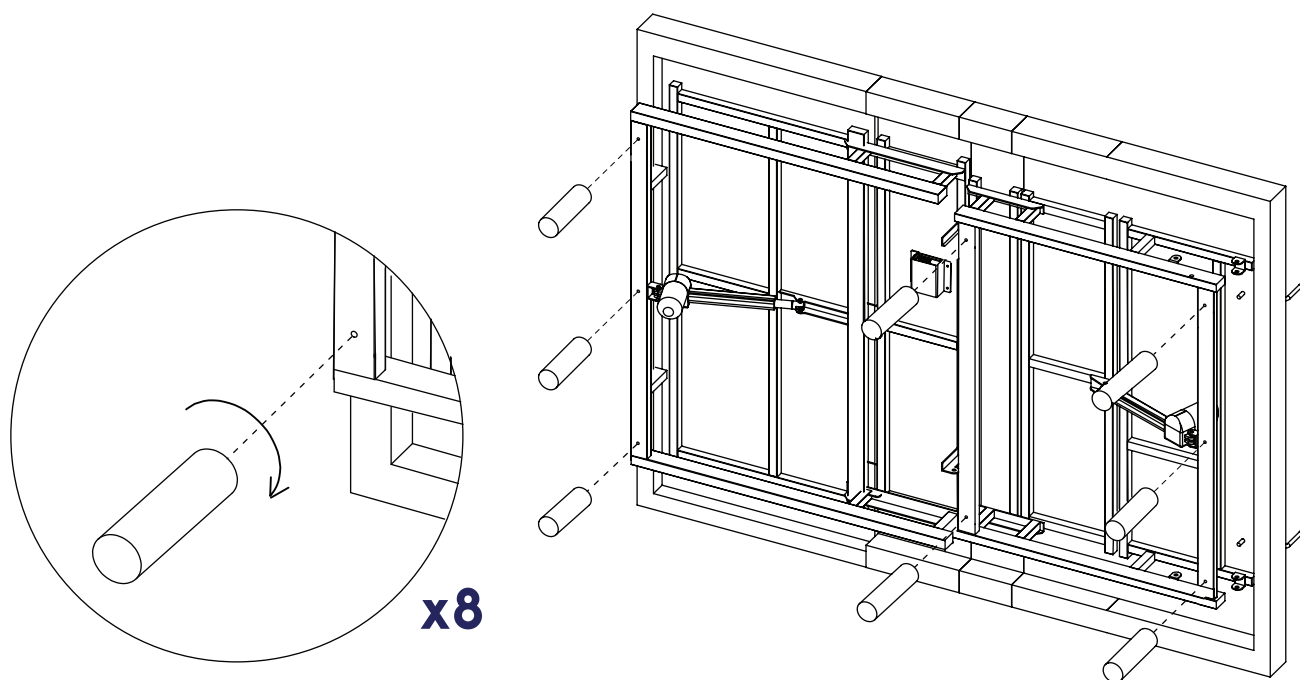
Tools required

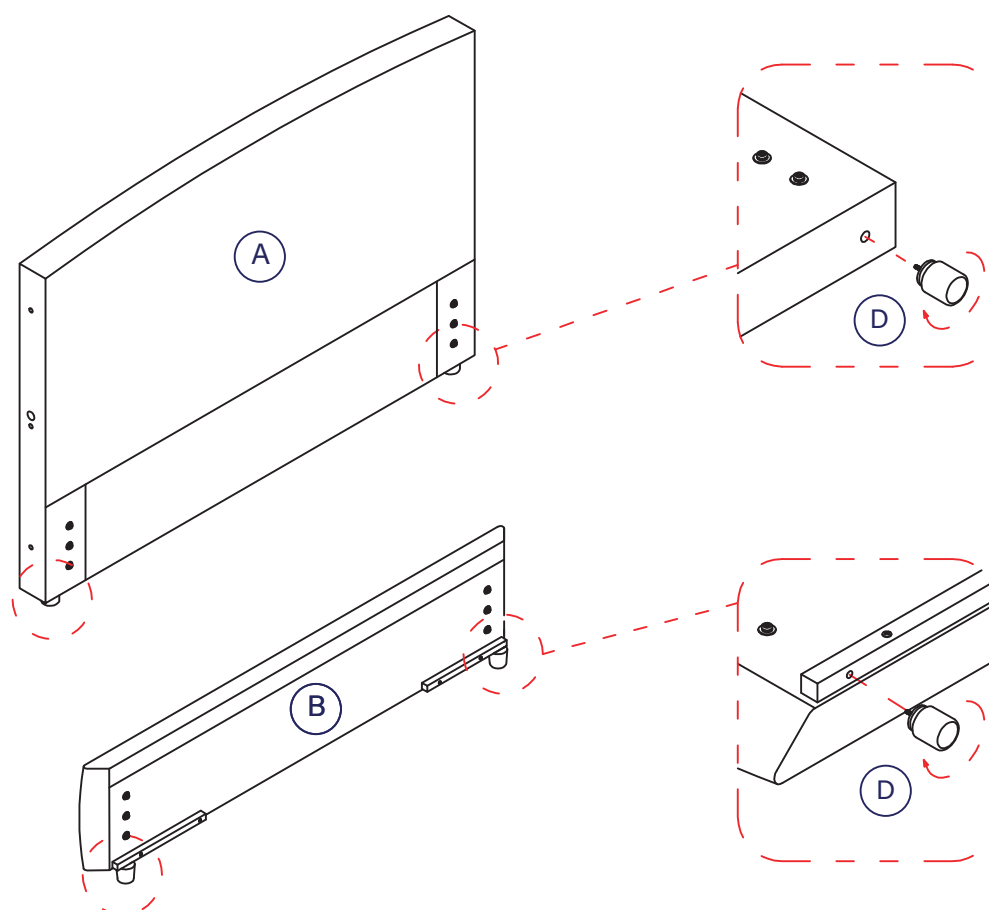


Tape measure

- 1** Screw in the legs and place the electric bed base in the final position in which it is to be used.



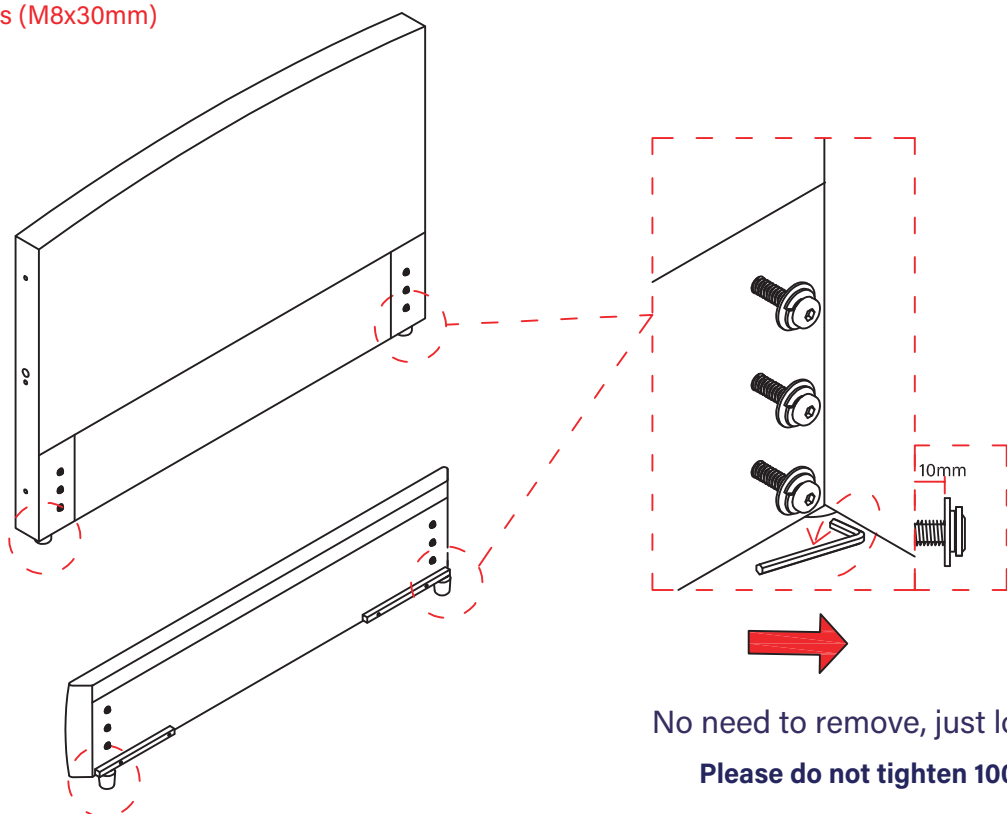
- 2** Prepare the headboard & footboard for assembly.



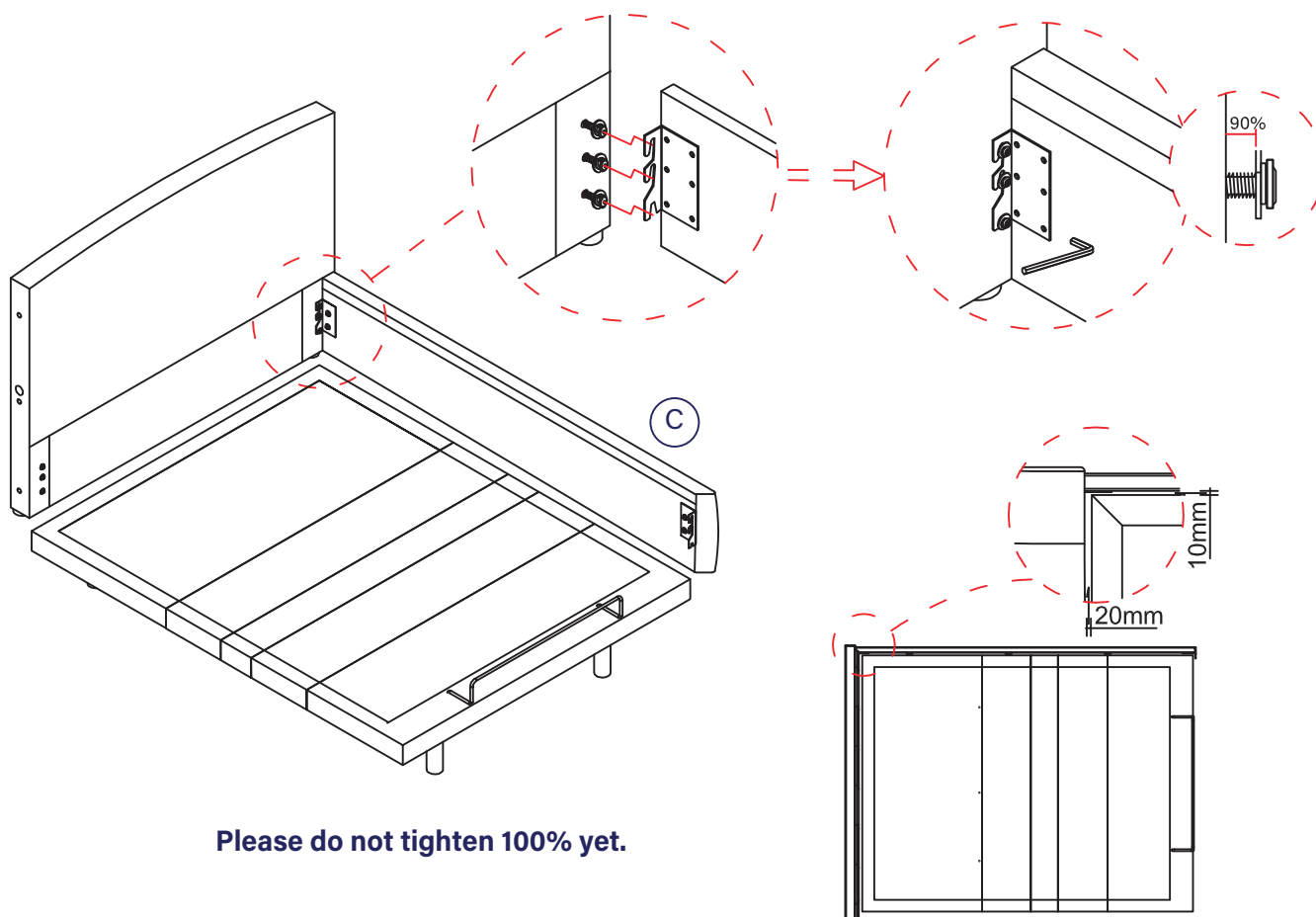
3 Prepare to fit the first side rail (C).

Hardware pre-fitted to the headboard & footboard (A&B)

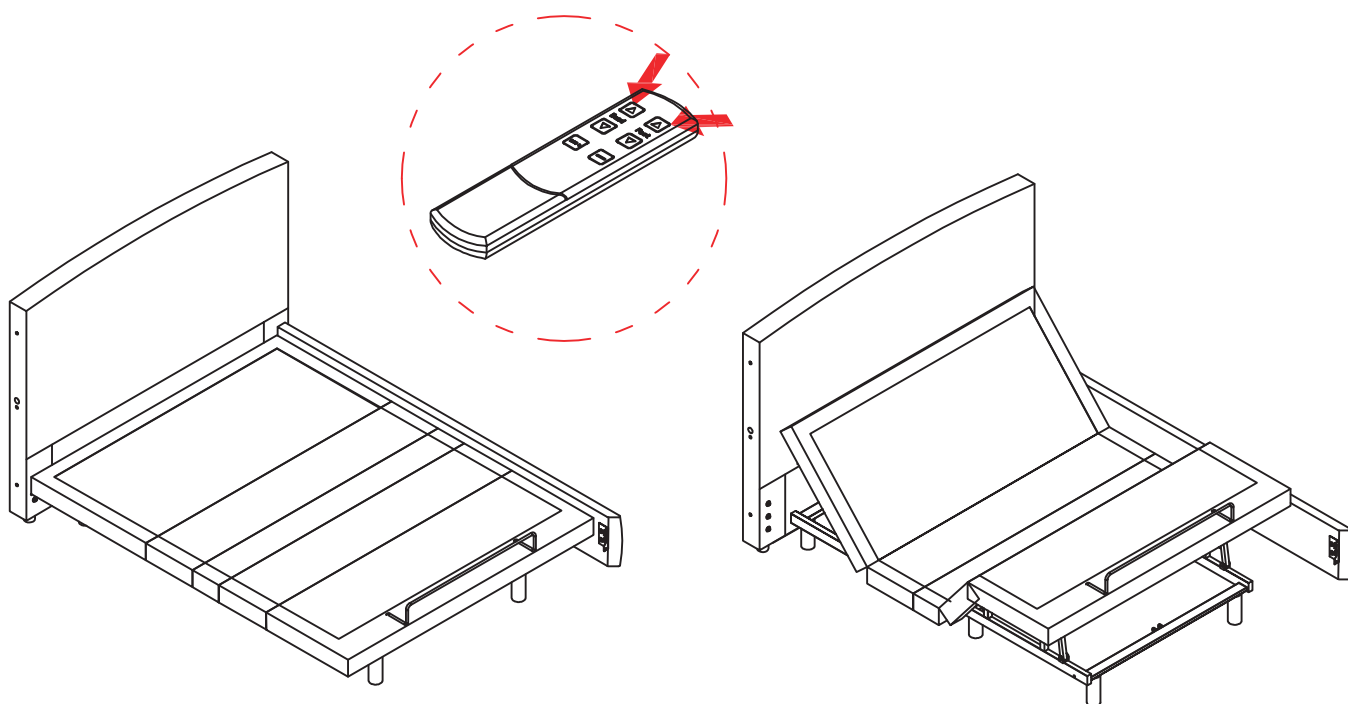

Bolts (M8x30mm)



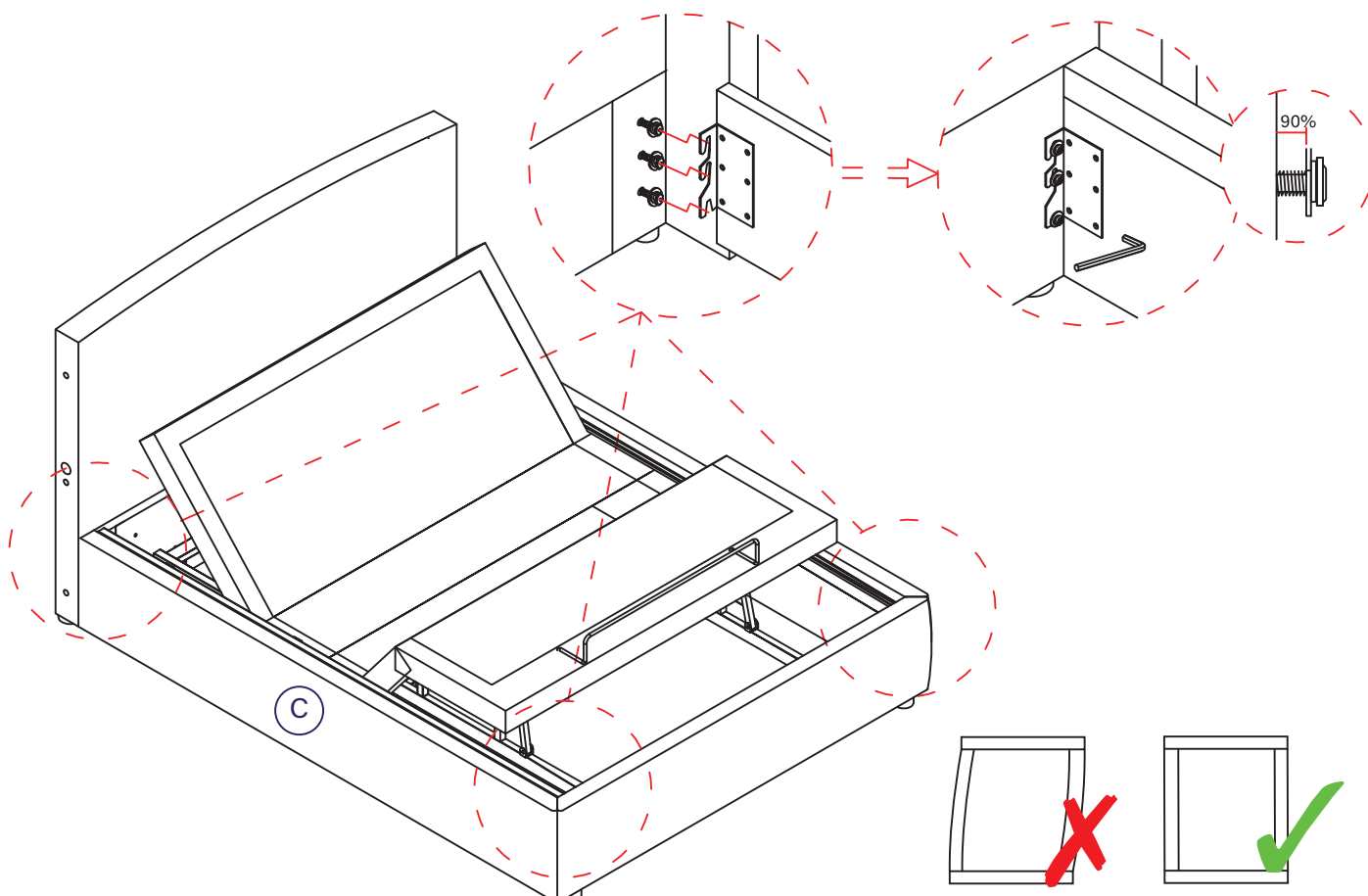
4 To the pre-positioned headboard, fit the right hand side rail .



- 5** Carefully position the electric bed base and plug the power supply into the wall socket, then raise the head and foot ends. For safety, the power supply must be earthed



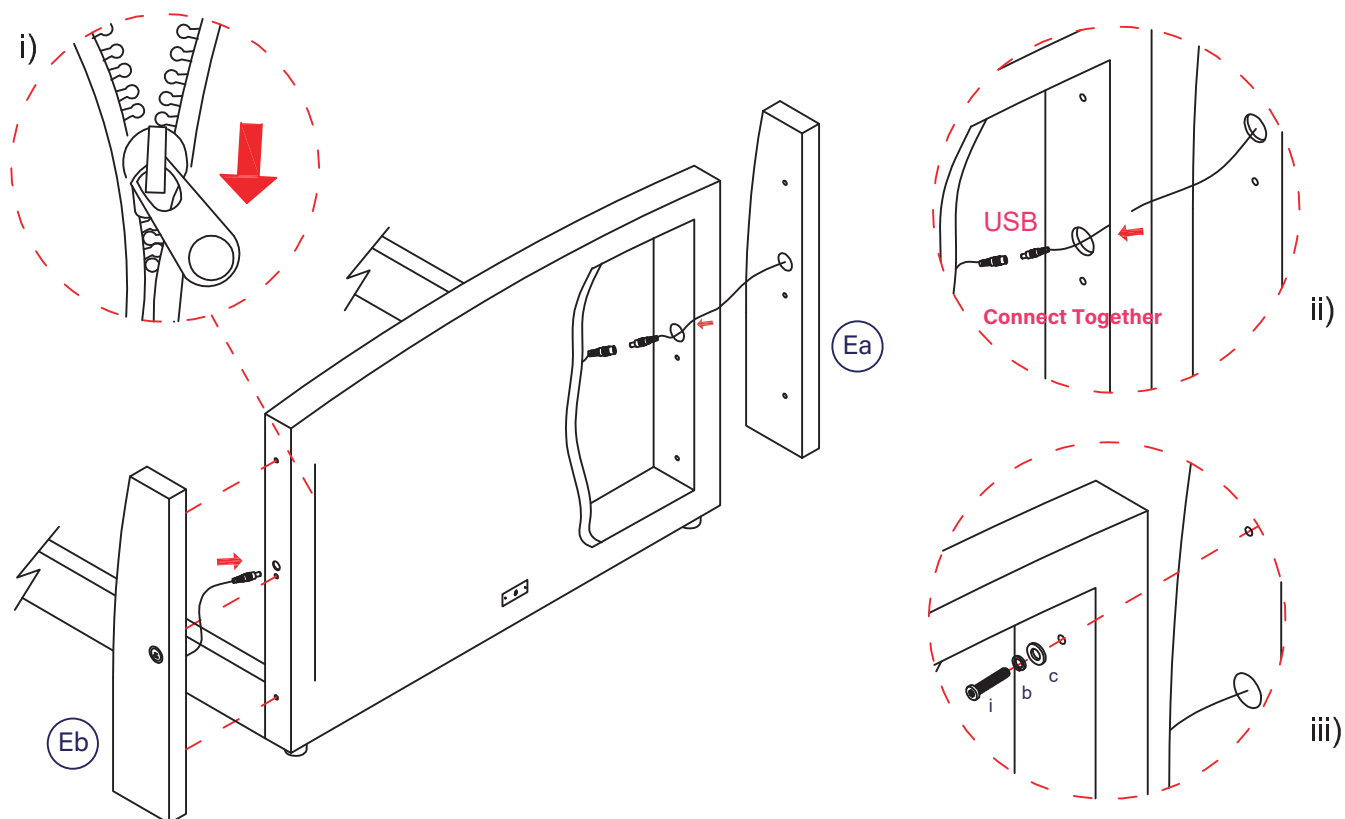
- 6** Fit the footboard to the RH side rail then carefully fit the LH side rail.



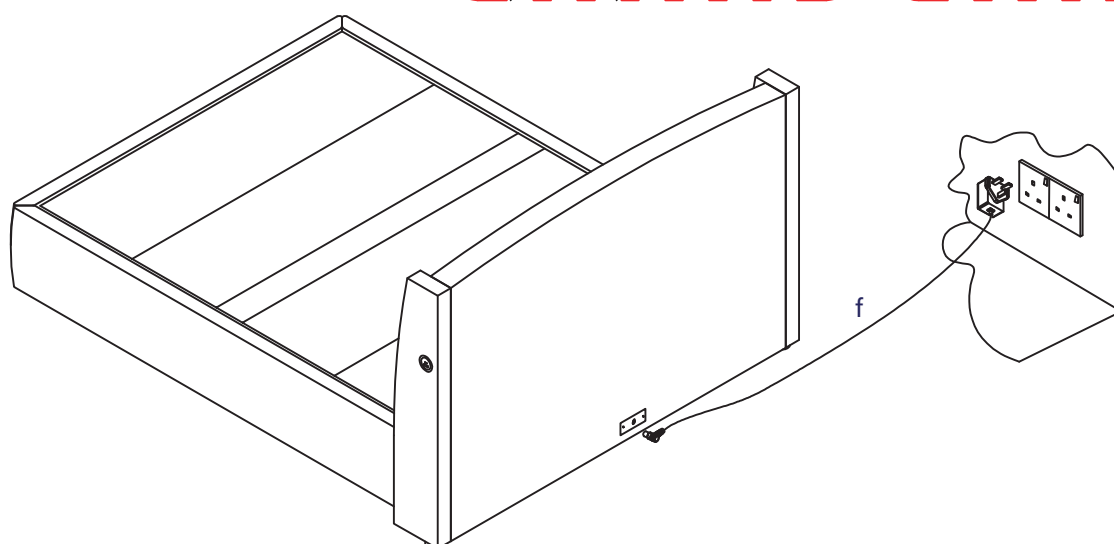
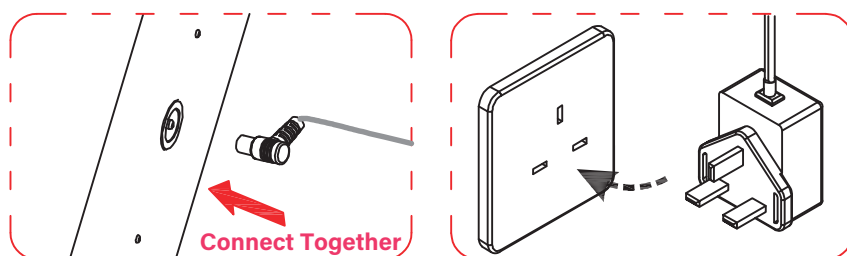
Make certain the bed is squared up as shown in the diagram then tighten all bed assembly bolts 100%.

7 Fit the wings carefully.

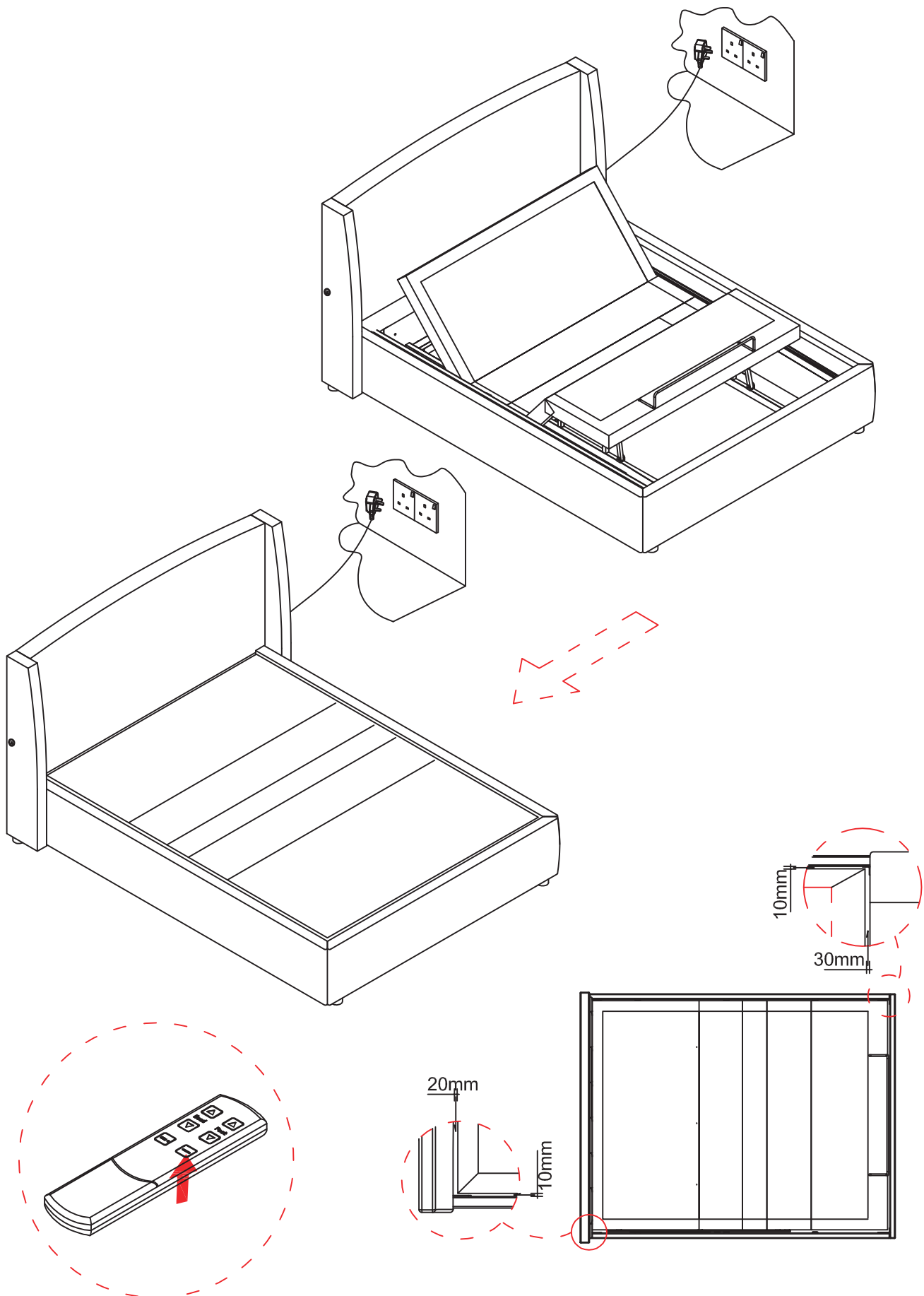

8 Connect the power.



9 Make certain the gaps around the bed base are even.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new furniture in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new furniture, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new furniture, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
