- Ensure the combine bedding and mattress weight is within the recommended weight guidance.

- Adult Operation Only: Not recommended for the use by children under the age of 12 years old, Please note ease of operation is dependent on height and strength of user.
- Avoid Entrapment: Always lift the bed with the mattress in place, using the handle(s) to lift and lower the base, keeping clear of the mechanism.





- Fully Open Ottoman: Ensure the ottoman is FULLY open before accessing the storage area.
- Avoid Hinge Area: Do not reach into the storage area through the hinge mechanism.
- Keep Children and Pets Away: Ensure children and pets stay away from the storage area, Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.
- Do not attempt to lie on the mattress when the ottoman is in the raised position.
- Note: The bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Maintenance: Regularly inspect your bed to ensure it is functioning correctly.

Ottoman Beds - Important Safety Features

Our aim is always to give you the best experience and to ensure every effort has been made to guarantee your comfort and safety. Please take time to look at these instruction as they will help remind you how to operate your ottoman bed safely.

Here's a few things you need to remember;

- Pistons are already assembled, or occasionally need to be fitted, in their correct orientation this improves piston performance and durability.
- ✓ "Break in" the piston seals on first use by raising & lowering the platform at least five times.
- Recommended mattress weights do not exceed the maximum relevant weight specified in this Assembly Instruction.
- ✔ Ottoman support bar always engage the support bar when accessing the ottoman storage area.

Read all the instructions before using your Ottoman bed-frame and save the instruction booklet for future reference.

Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.)

For optimal safety during operation, always ensure the O.S.B. is engaged when accessing the ottoman storage area.



- 1. Always raise the ottoman slat-frame to it's highest position before using the storage area.
- 2. Locate the end of the O.S.B and insert into the fixed retaining bracket on the bed frame.
- 3. When you are ready to lower the ottoman platform, return the O.S.B to its original parking position.
- 4. Always ensure that the O.S.B is in position when the ottoman is open, this prevents injury, or damage to the product.

WARNING! Risk of Entrapment

- The pistons on the ottoman bed frame can support a maximum load (evenly spread) as indicated in the Minimum and Maximum load table, on Page 2 of this Assembly Instruction.
- Overloading the sleeping platform may contribute to damage to the product resulting in potential serious injury.
- $\circ~$ Do not sit on the mattress whilst the platform is in motion or is in the raised position.
- \circ Users should only get in and out of bed when platform is in the flat (horizontal) position.

AUDIO OPERATION GUIDE



Occasionally the pairing between Remote Control & the bed control system is lost, usually due to atmospheric conditions. To re-pair please folow these instructions.



(1) Disconnect all mains electrical power to the bed for at least 60 seconds.

(2) Press either the UP or DOWN Button on TV Lift Remote Control and keep holding the button down, simultaneously re-connect mains electric power to bed keeping button down for at least a further 5 seconds. The TV Lift unit receives the signal from the RC and the TV lift will begin to move UP or DOWN whichever button was pressed.

3 Re-pairing is now complete.

Control Panel Operating Instructions

- 1. Light forward button: Press button to select the next colour/light in sequence.

Care & Maintenance



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner. Please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your newbed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
