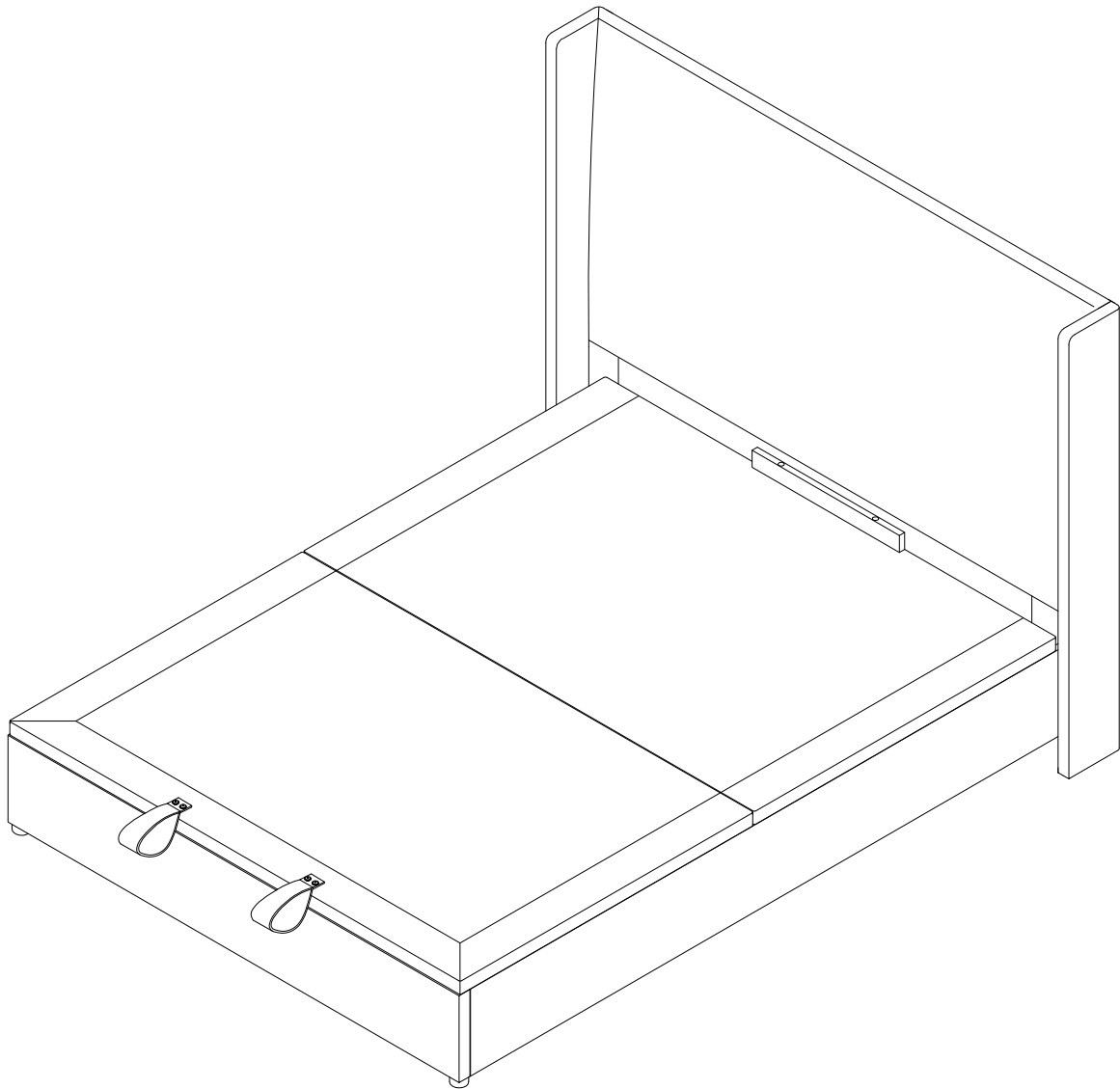
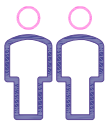

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. 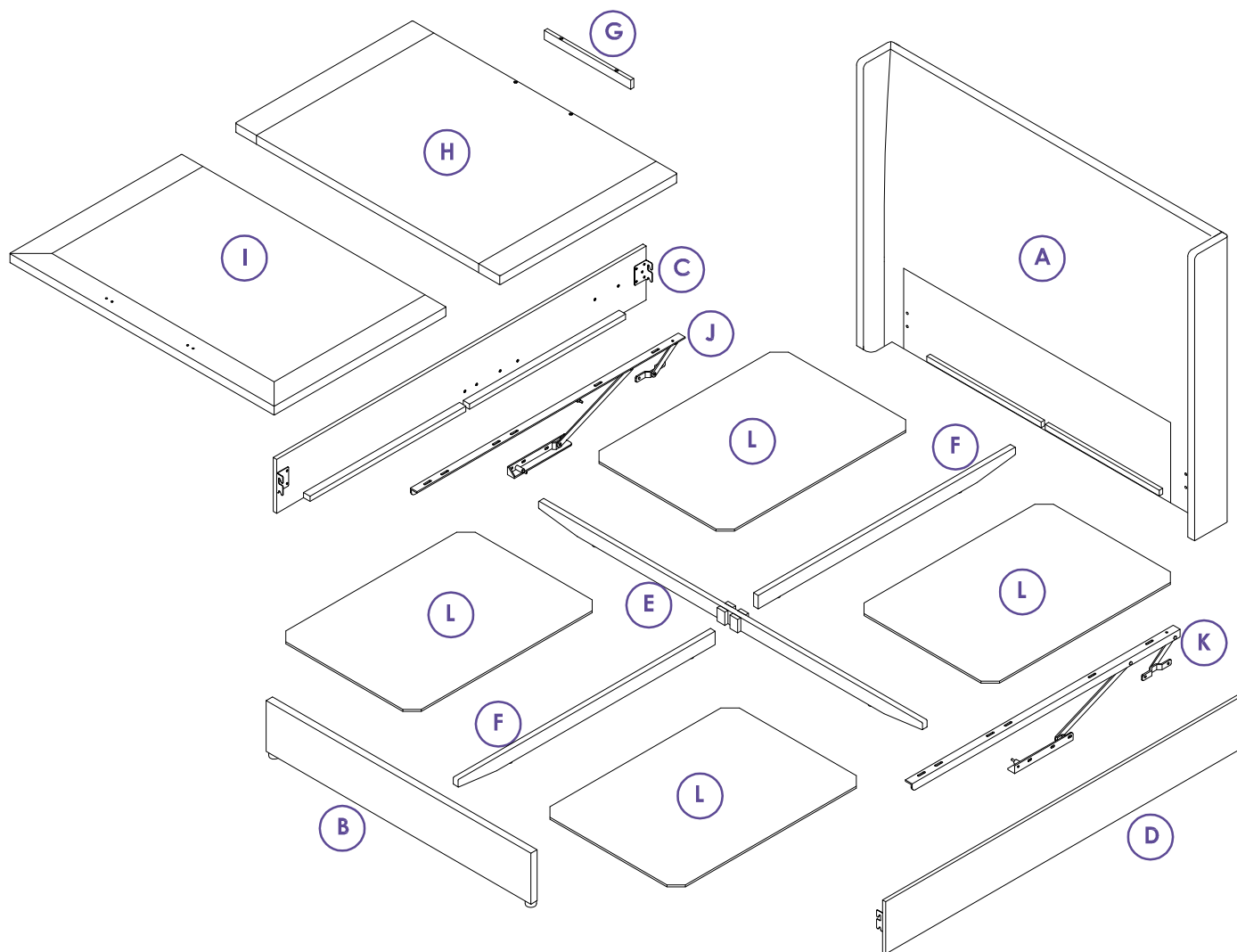
Recycling

Side Rail Assembly

1

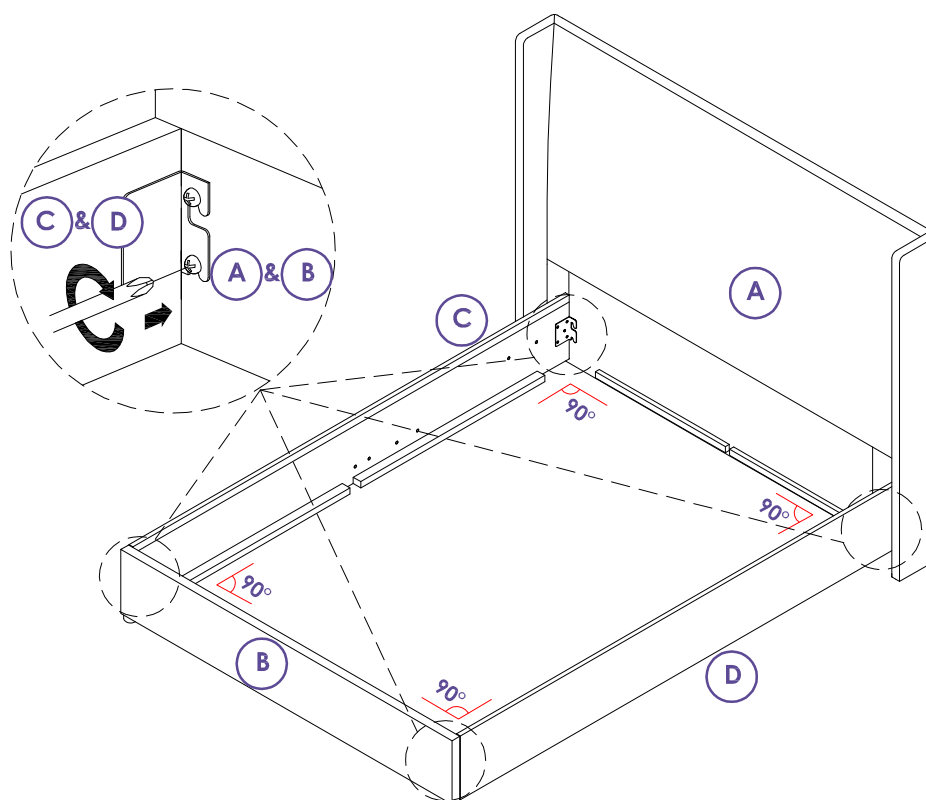
Loosen side rail attachment bolts & hook the side rail over the bolts in the headboard & footboard as shown.
(Remark : Do not tighten the bolts until step 2)



Side Rail & Rubber Stopper Assembly

Now fully tighten the bolts to headboard & footboard as shown.
Ensure all angles are at 90°.

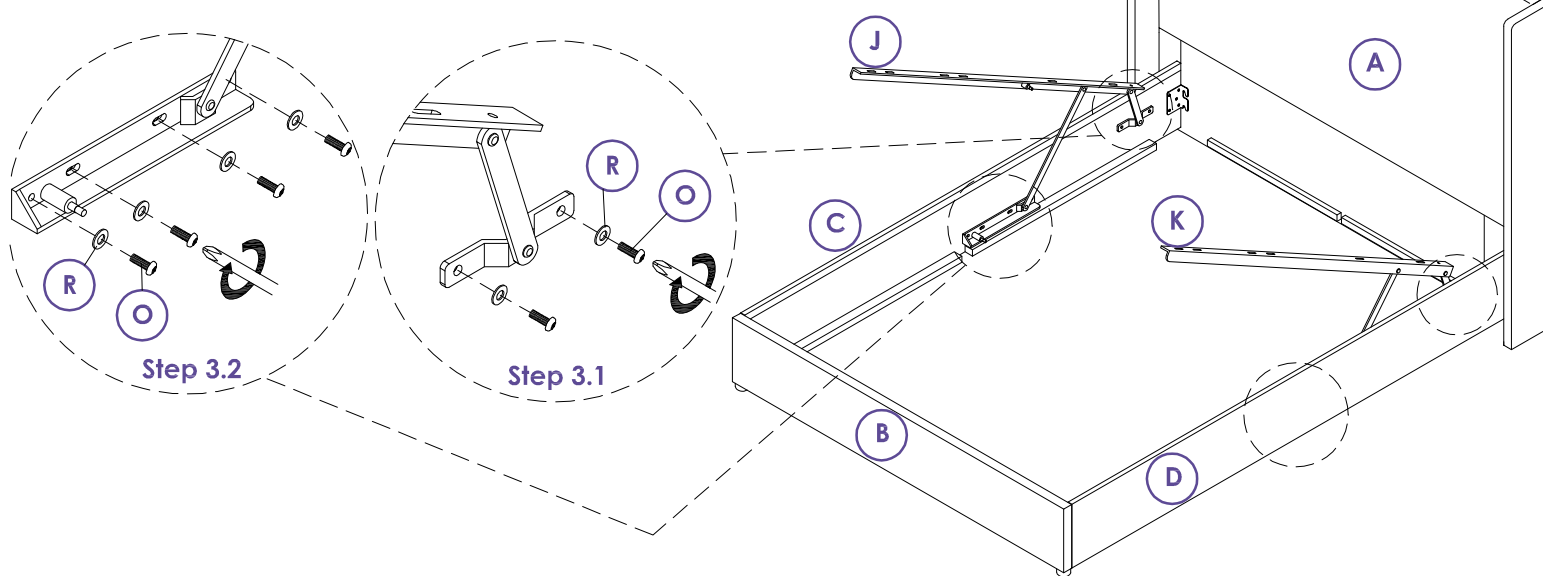


Lift Up Mechanism Assembly

Attach the lift up mechanism to the side rail with bolts & washer provided.

Assemble the metal plate with 2 holes first (Step 3.1). Then locate the longer metal plate & fix with bolt & washer (Step 3.2).

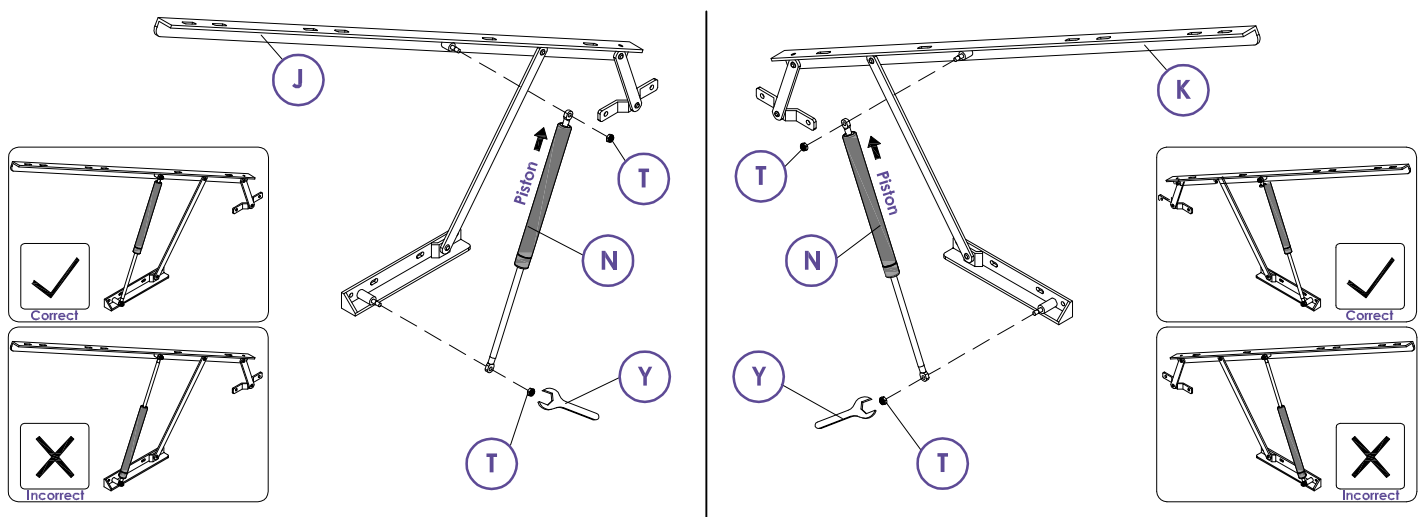


Piston Assembly

Fix the piston to the lift up mechanism with the lock nut & spanner provided.

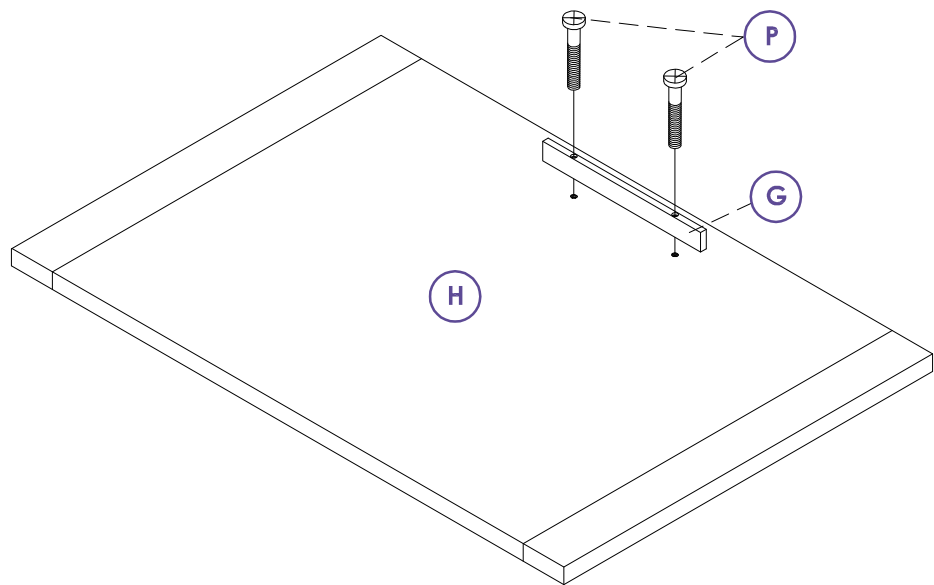
Fully tighten all nuts after attaching the pistons.



Mattress Support Rail Assembly

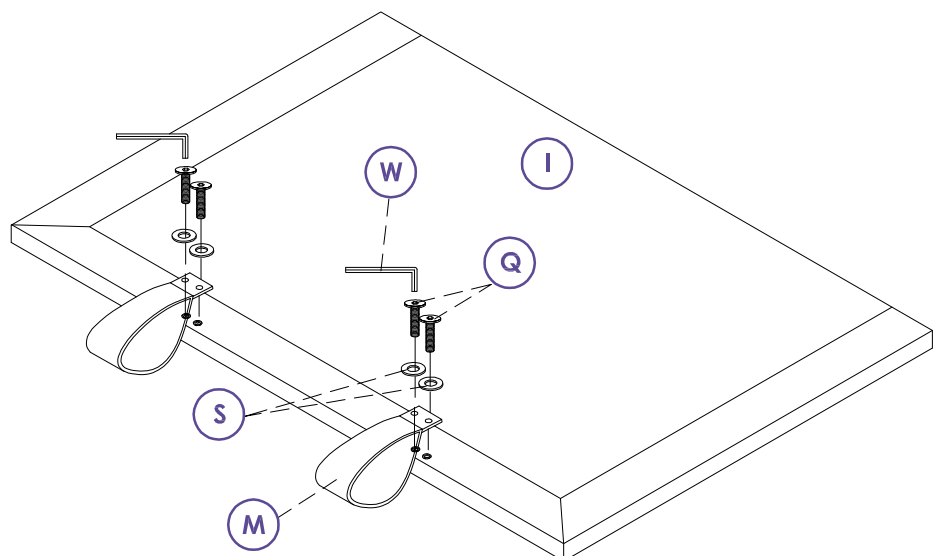
Fix the mattress support rail to the front lift base with bolts and screwdriver provided.



Strap Handle Assembly

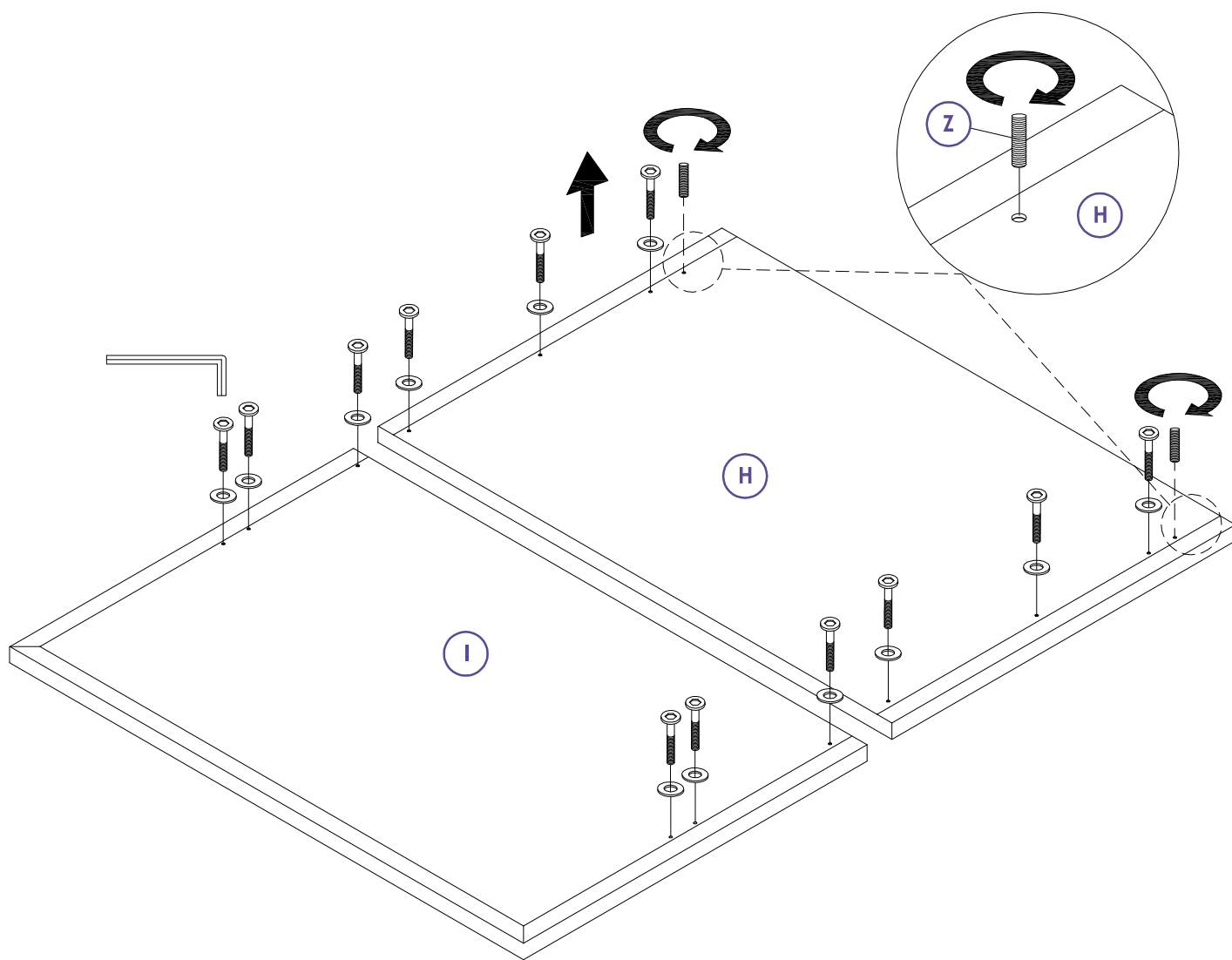
Fix the strap handle to the back lift base with flat washer and screw using allen key provided.



Stud Bolts Assembly

Remove prefitted allen head bolts and washers from the lift base and fix stud bolts as shown.

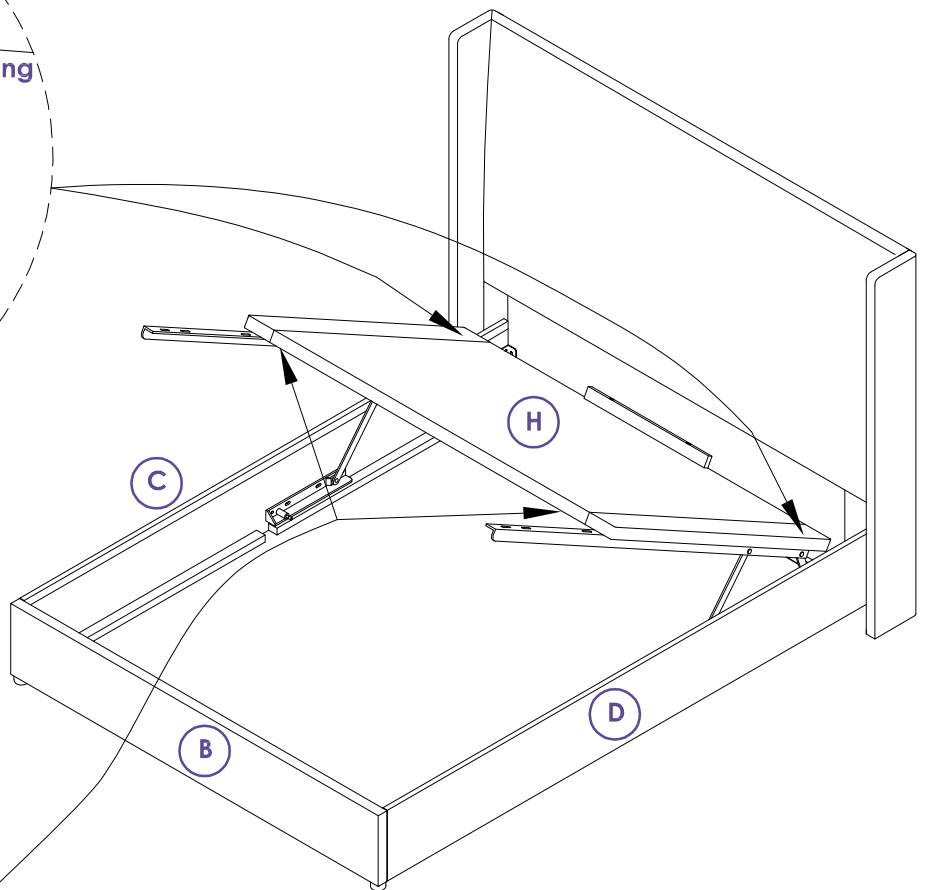
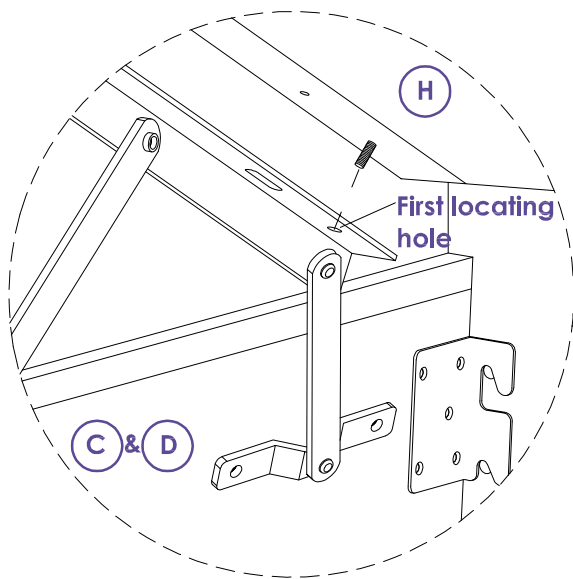


Front Lift Base Assembly

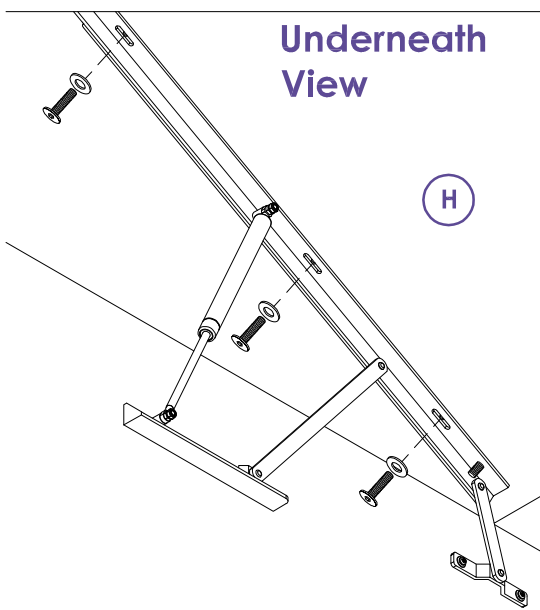

First put the front lift base on top of lift up mechanism with the pre-installed stud bolt to the first hole for safety and to prevent the lift base from dropping down.

Use allen head bolts & flat washer to fix the front lift base as shown.



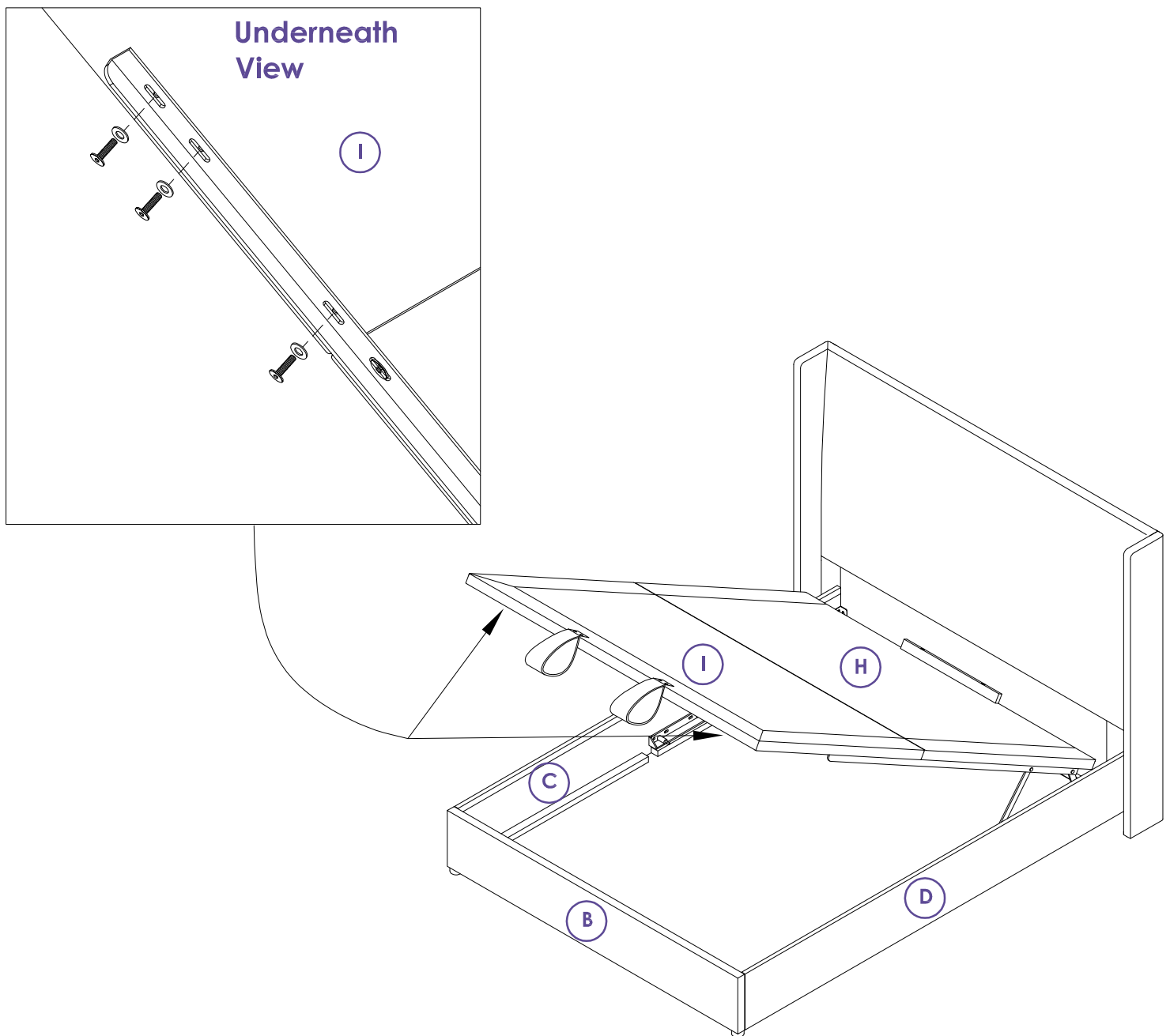
Underneath View



Back Lift Base Assembly

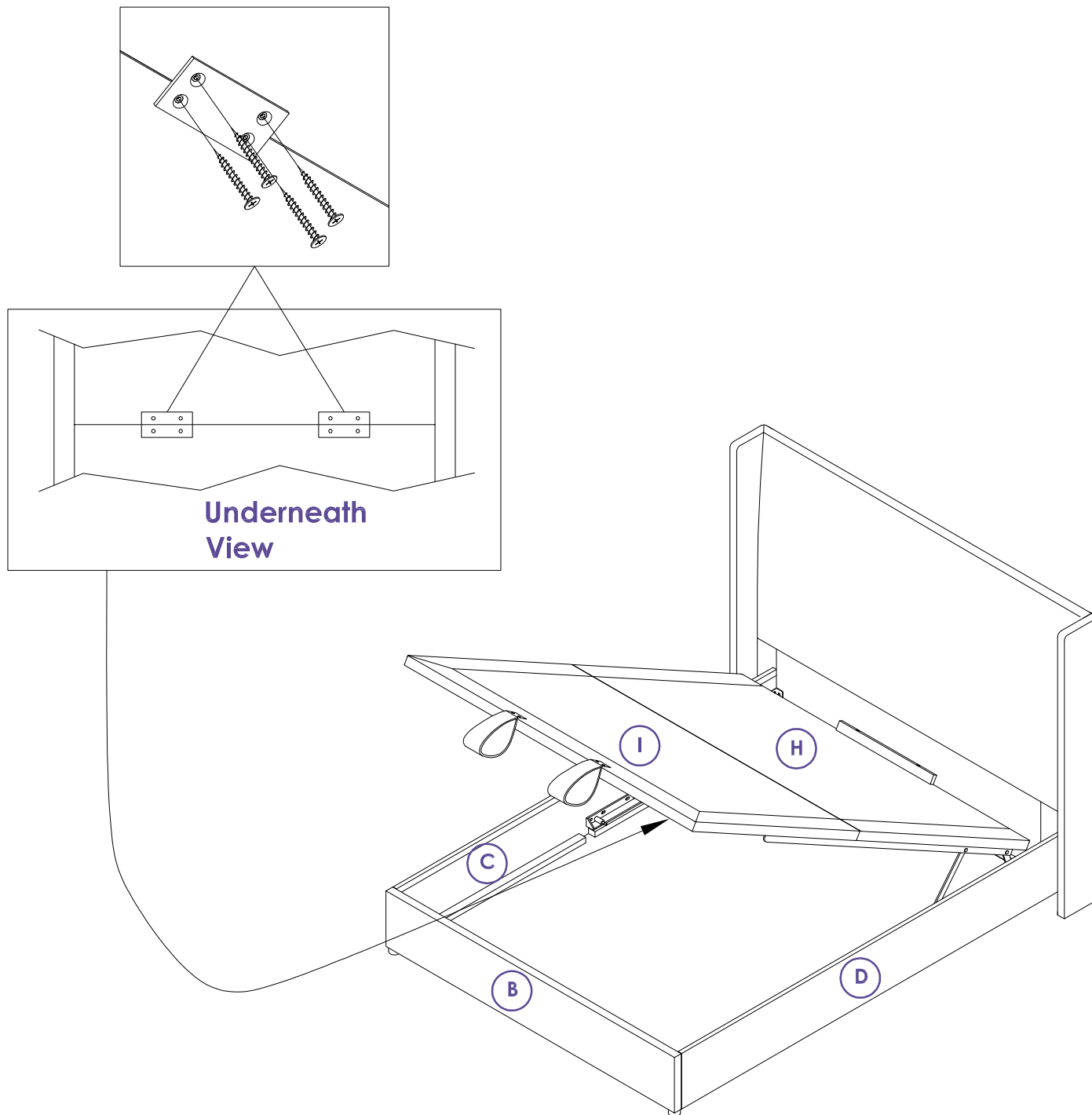
Attach the back lift base on top of lift up mechanism.
Use allen head bolts & flat washer to fix the back lift base as shown.



Metal Plate Assembly

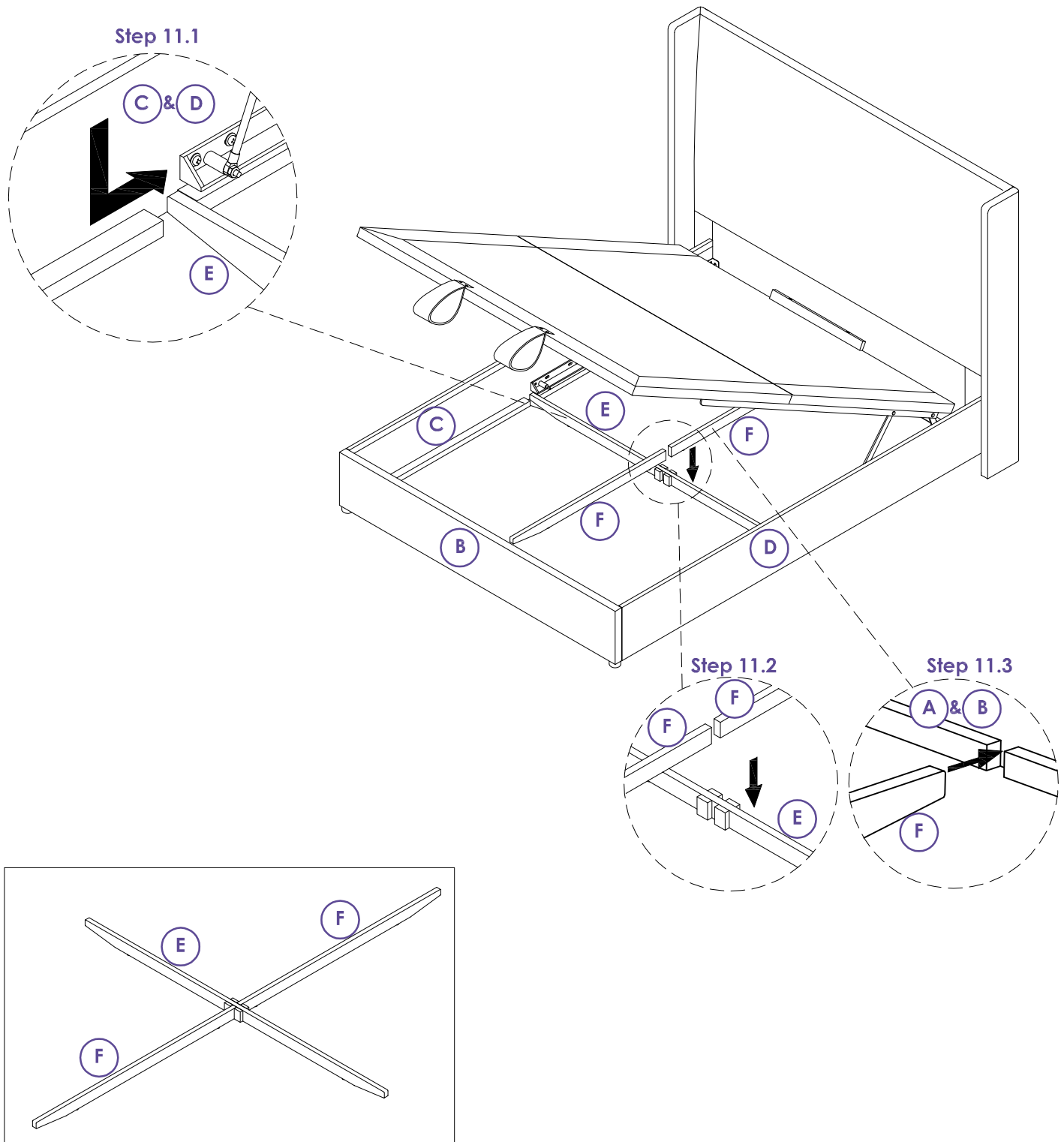
Affix metal plates to the underside of the mattress bases with fixings and screwdriver provided.



Bottom Cross Rail Assembly

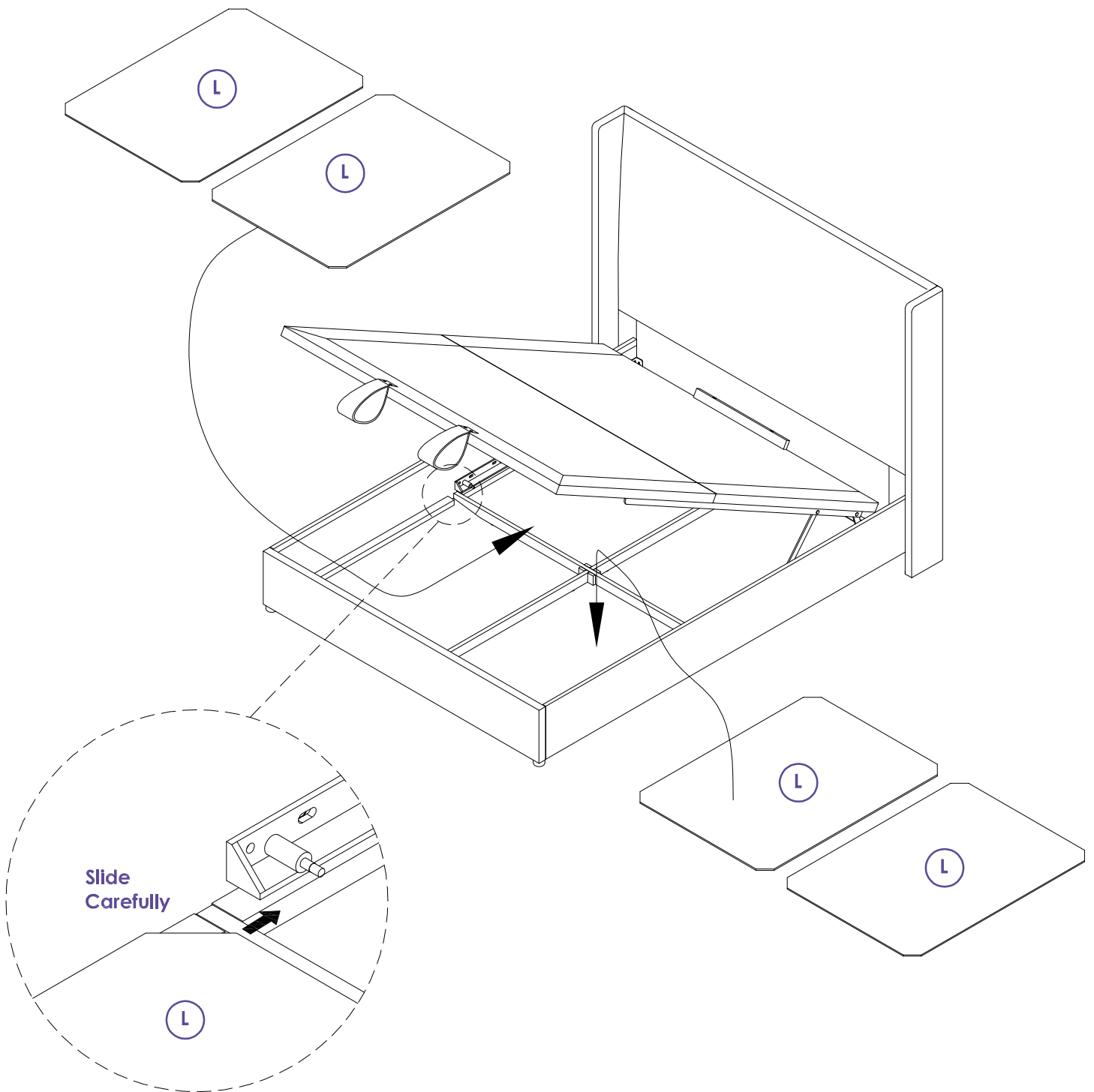
Slot together bottom cross rail short to bottom cross rail long. Attach the bottom cross rail in the cavity of the bed.



Base Panel Assembly

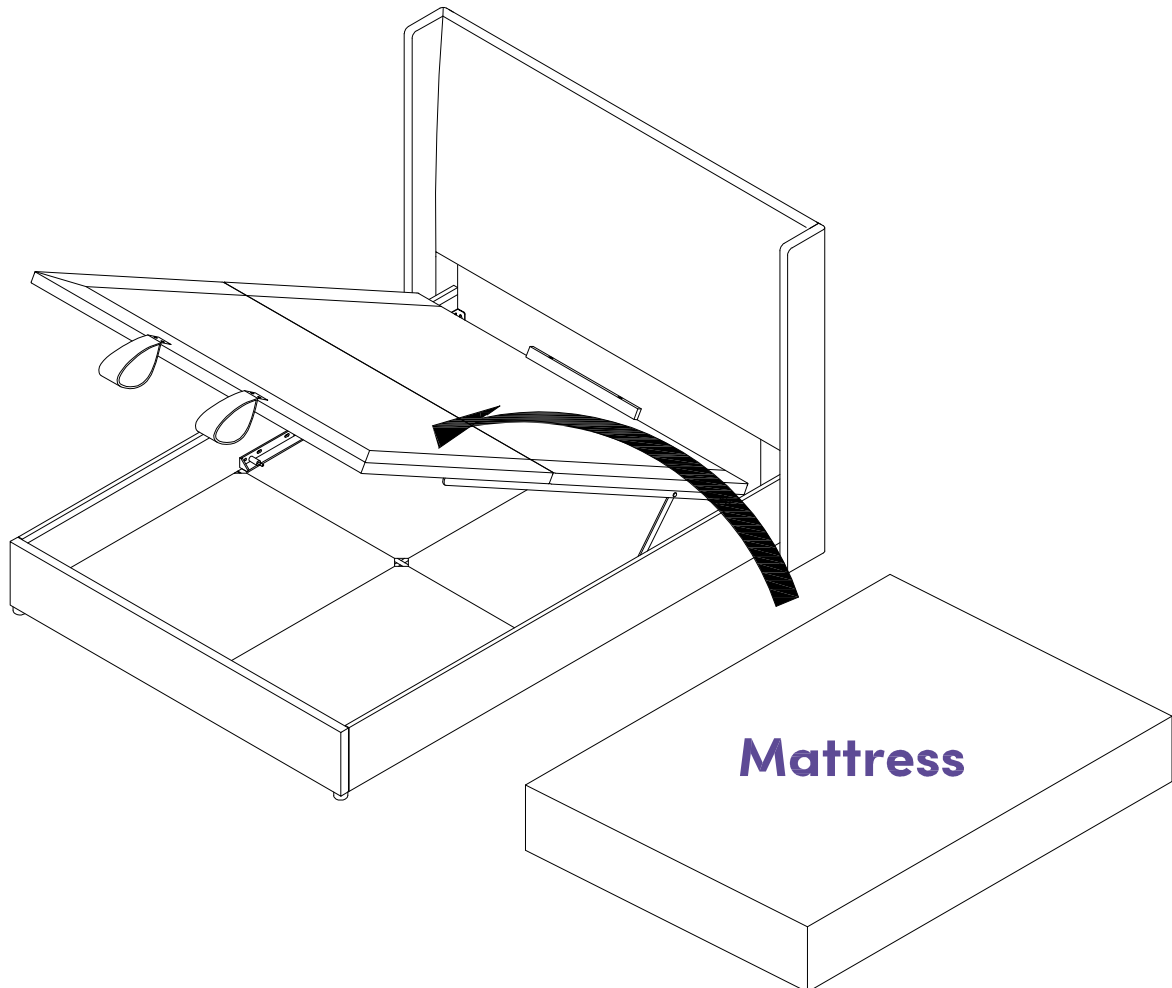
Slide base panels into place, taking care not to catch them on the side mechanisms.



Mattress Assembly

Attach the mattress on top the lift base as shown.



A. This Lift Mechanism provides assistance with the lift of the mattress fitted to the base - it does not lift the mattress for you. The system has been designed to effectively lift the base system fitted with a variety of mattress weights and combinations of depth. The combination of mattress weight and depth determines the degree of assistance provided by the mechanism.

B. Following installation of the mechanism lift / pull the base up and down a few times to free off the system. The gas cylinders fitted to the system may be stiff when first used or if the system has not been operated for a period of time. The mattress must be fitted to the base.

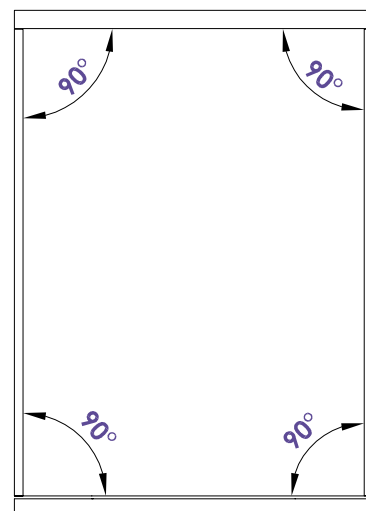
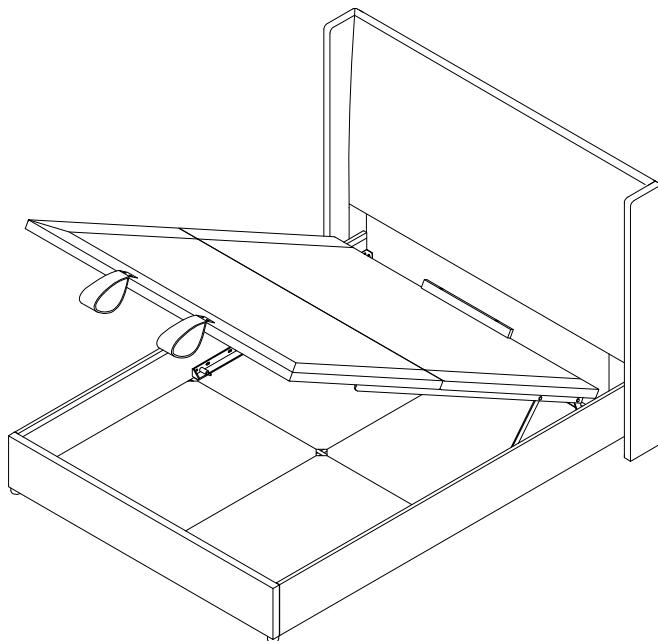
C. Use the strap handles to lift up the mattress base using two hands - Pull the mattress base down using two hands equally spaced from the centre of the mattress base. **DO NOT** pull down on one side of the base only as this is likely to damage the base system with potential failure of the mattress base system and lift mechanism. Do not operate the lift up mechanism without the mattress fitted to the base.

CAUTION : Do not allow children to operate the lift Mechanism.
Do not allow children near the lift base when operating the Mechanism.
Do not allow children in the area of the internal storage base.
Keep hands clear of the mechanism when operating the base system.
Do not stand inside the bed / on the internal storage base.
Do not overload the internal storage base.

Make sure the bed frame 4 side angles are at 90° before you closing the lift base.

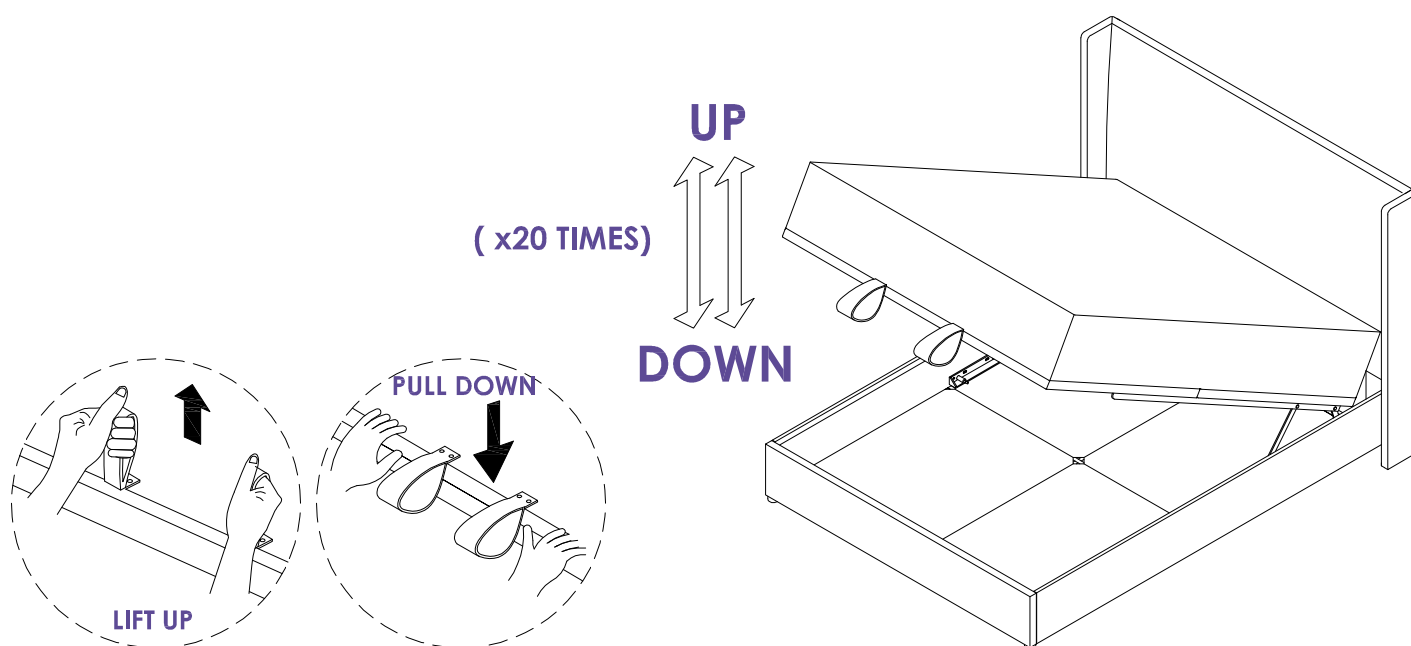

The mattress must be fitted to the lift base. (Do not operate the lift up mechanism without the mattress fitted to the base.)

Lift up and down the lift up frame with mattress at least 20 times before use.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
