- **IMPORTANT-READ CAREFULLY -RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**
- **Ensure the combine bedding and mattress weight is within the recommended weight guidance.**

- **Adult Operation Only:** Not recommended for the use by children under the age of 12 years old, Please note ease of operation is dependent on height and strength of user.
- **Avoid Entrapment:** Always lift the bed with the mattress in place, using the handle(s) to lift and lower the base, keeping clear of the mechanism.



- **Fully Open Ottoman:** Ensure the ottoman is **FULLY** open before accessing the storage area.
- **Avoid Hinge Area:** Do not reach into the storage area through the hinge mechanism.
- **Keep Children and Pets Away:** Ensure children and pets stay away from the storage area, Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.
- **Do not attempt to lie on the mattress when the ottoman is in the raised position.**
- **Note:** The bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect your bed to ensure it is functioning correctly.

Our aim is always to give you the best experience and to ensure every effort has been made to guarantee your comfort and safety. Please take time to look at these instructions as they will help remind you how to operate your ottoman bed safely.

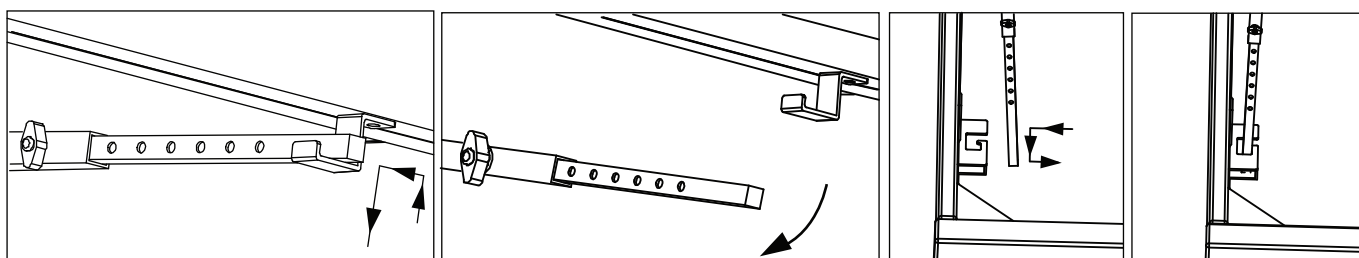
Here's a few things you need to remember;

- ✓ **Pistons are already assembled, or occasionally need to be fitted, in their correct orientation - this improves piston performance and durability.**
- ✓ **"Break in " the piston seals on first use by raising & lowering the platform at least five times.**
- ✓ **Recommended mattress weights - do not exceed the maximum relevant weight specified in this Assembly Instruction.**
- ✓ **Ottoman support bar - always engage the support bar when accessing the ottoman storage area.**

Read all the instructions before using your Ottoman bed-frame and save the instruction booklet for future reference.

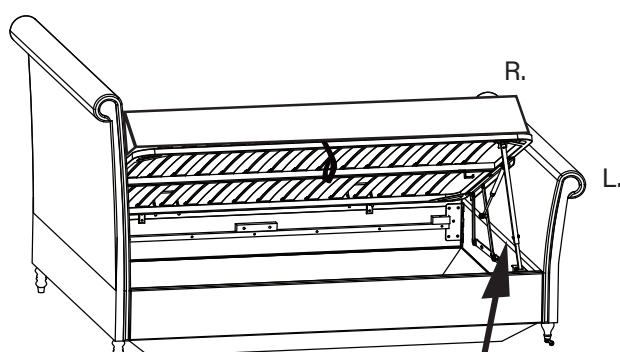
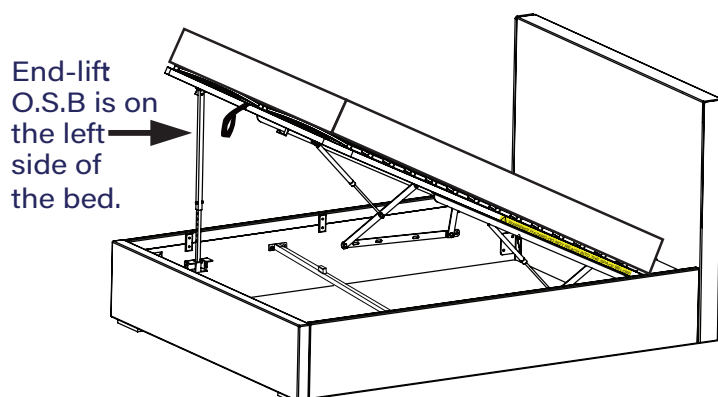
Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.)

For optimal safety during operation, always ensure the O.S.B. is engaged when accessing the ottoman storage area.



1. Always raise the ottoman frame to it's highest position before using the storage area.
Locate the end of the O.S.B and insert into the fixed retaining bracket on the bed frame.
2. When you are ready to lower the ottoman platform, return the O.S.B to its original parking position.
3. Always ensure that the O.S.B is in position when the ottoman is open, this prevents injury, or damage to the product.

Location of the O.S.B



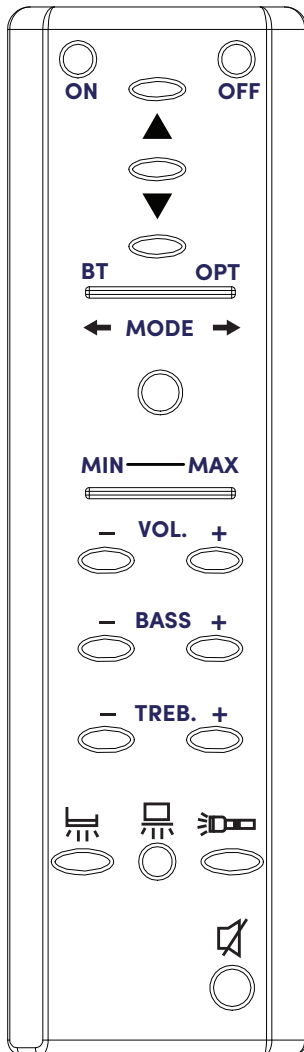
Side-lift: O.S.B is on either the left side or right side of the footend or side rail.

WARNING! Risk of Entrapment

- The pistons on the ottoman bed frame can support a maximum load (evenly spread) as indicated in the Minimum and Maximum load table, on Page 2 of this Assembly Instruction.
- Overloading the sleeping platform may contribute to damage to the product resulting in potential serious injury.
- Do not sit on the mattress whilst the platform is in motion or is in the raised position.
- Users should only get in and out of bed when platform is in the flat (horizontal) position.

AUDIO OPERATION GUIDE

QUANTUM TV BED 2.1 STEREO SYSTEM



TURN AMPLIFIER ON or OFF.



- 1) Turn on the mains power to the TV Bed.
- 2) Press the Remote Control (RC) ON button for 2 seconds to synchronise and prepare the system, system voice shall say 'Power On'.
- 3) When finished press the OFF button for 2 seconds.

LIFT or LOWER THE TV.



Press once and TV will rise to it's upper working position. Power to the TV will be connected automatically - operate the TV using it's Operation Guide.

Press once and TV Lift will stop.

Press once and TV will go down - as soon as the lower resting position is reached, power to the TV is switched off to prevent it overheating.

NOTE: BLUETOOTH WILL WORK NORMALLY WHEN TV IS UP OR DOWN.

SELECT OPTICAL or BLUETOOTH MODE.



Select the required mode by pressing OPT (Optical) to watch TV or

Select BT (Bluetooth) to connect to your smart device to play music.

Pair your device in the normal way searching for -- 'MY BT' --.

Two devices can pair with the system but each will need to disconnect to allow the other to connect.

If a device was previously connected, system will immediately say PAIRED. If not previously connected, system shall say PAIRING.

Note you cannot play films through the system from any BT device.



The same blue LED light bar is used to show steps for all the following controls: VOLUME, BASS & TREBLE.

VOLUME CONTROL



Use + or - button to increase or decrease the volume.

Note that this control operates step by step and as it is adjusted, the blue LED light bar follows each step until full volume is reached, then the blue lights are all on.

BASS CONTROL



Adjust the Bass attenuation - these buttons increase or decrease the lower frequencies of the sound.

TREBLE CONTROL



Adjust the Treble attenuation - these buttons increase or decrease the higher frequencies of the sound until the preferred sound level is achieved. Note: if higher frequency sound is reduced, the volume of the sound appears to be reduced too - this is normal.

LED Lights



Switch on or off the LED arrays on the front & back of the head end.



Switch on or off the platform light under the TV and the media tray light mounted above the side rail (Ca) media tray access.



This button operates the torch.



MUTE BUTTON

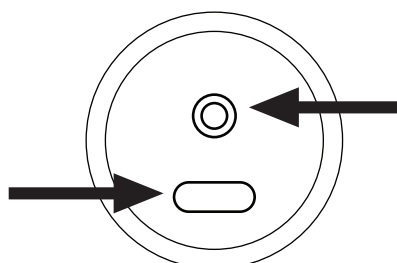

Between the the headboard & footboard (A&B), carefully plug in the long connection cable (r) and finger-tighten the screws. The cable is reversible so plugging in at either end is fine.

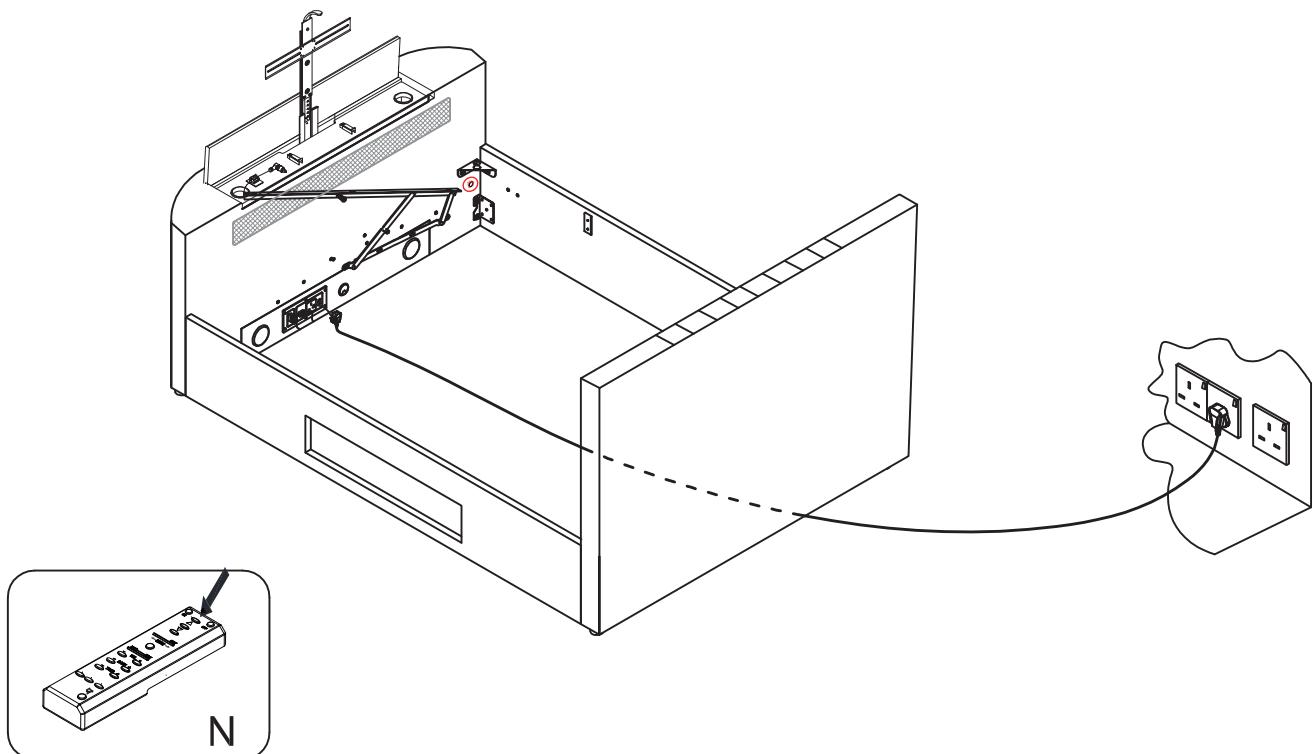

Plug the small power plug of one end of the mains power lead (C) into the socket at the bottom of the footboard. On the other end of the lead, bring the 3 pin plug out under the headboard and connect it to your wall socket - for safety this must be an earthed power supply.

Note: Be very careful what you store under the bed - the top of an item, like a suitcase or a box, must not touch the mattress base or they may be damaged.
Maximum storage height is 285mm.

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new furniture in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new furniture, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new furniture, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.

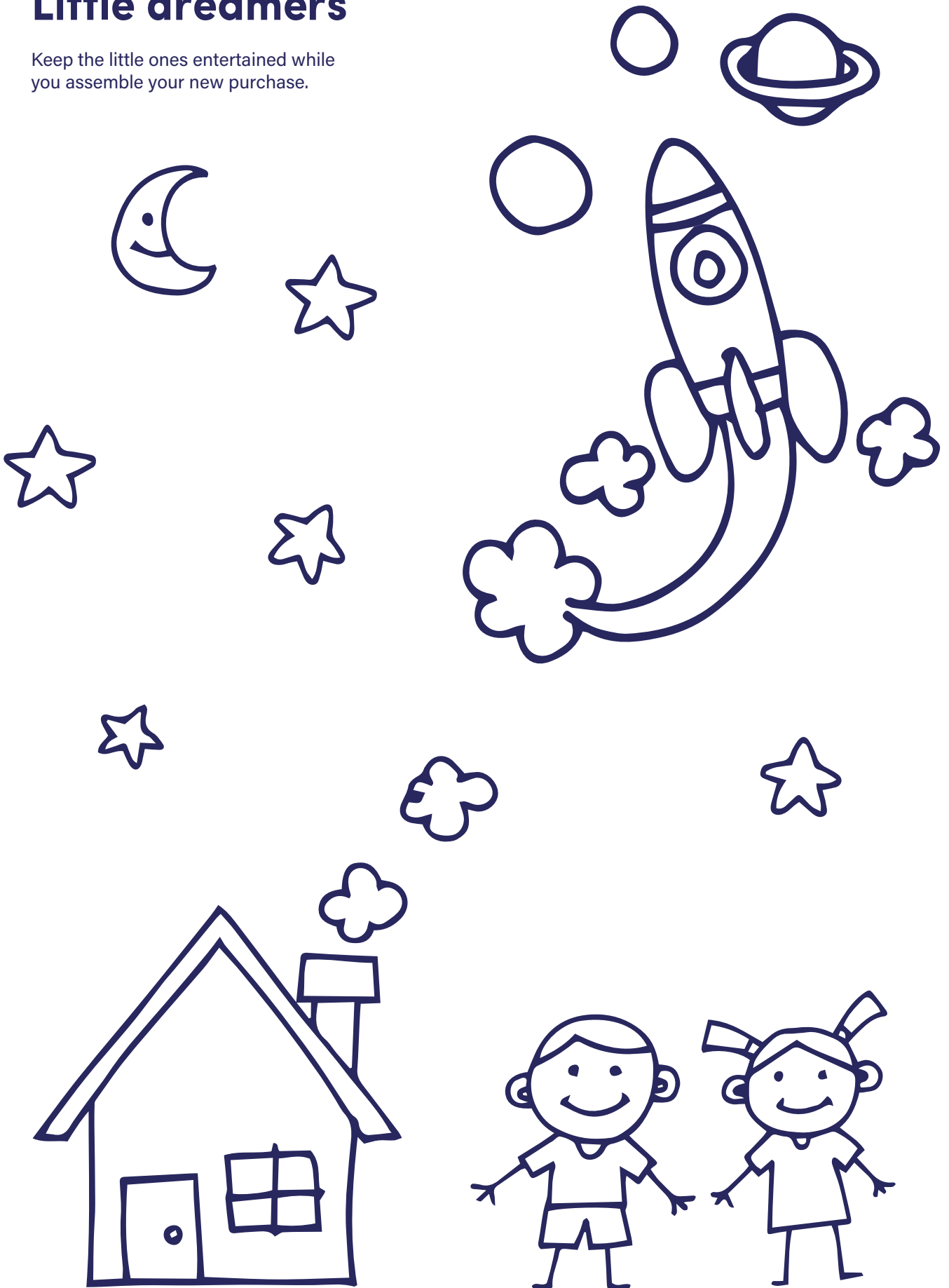
