Top tip

We recommend you switching your blanket on for an hour before bed-time so your bed is nice and cosy when you want to go to sleep.

All plastic and wrapping materials should be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. Please familiarise yourself with the important safety instructions contained within this manual.

Recycling

Please ensure that packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way and recycle where possible. Our assembly instructions are printed on recycled paper. Please keep your assembly instructions safe to refer back to in the future.

Important safety instructions

The following important safety instructions should be observed to avoid the risk of personal injury or damage to property:

- Carefully read the manual and keep it for future reference. Familiarise yourself with the operation of the Heated Blanket and how to use it.
- Connect the Heated Blanket only to sockets with the voltage indicated on the rating plate (AC only).
- The product can be used by children over 8 years of age. Also, individuals with reduced physical, sensory or mental abilities, or a lack of experience and/or knowledge, provided they've been supervised or instructed on the safe use of the product and understand the potential dangers.
- Please be particularly careful when using the product near children. Don't allow them to play with the product. Additionally, don't allow individuals who aren't familiar with the product to use it without prior instruction.
- This product must not be used by individuals who are sensitive to heat (e.g. danger of unnoticed burns). Nor by those who wouldn't be able to react to overheating (e.g. physically restricted individuals who wouldn't be able to free themselves).
- Children under the age of 3 years must not use this product, as they're unable to react properly to overheating.
- Inspect the Heated Blanket regularly for signs of wear, tear or damage. Do not use it if you spot any of these. Instead, contact a qualified technician for repairs.
- If the power cord of this product is damaged, it should only be replaced by a qualified technician to avoid danger.
- Do not use the Heated Blanket in combination with other heating devices.
- Turn off the control panel before inserting or removing the plug. Always remove the cable by pulling the plug and not the cable.
- Do not leave the product unattended during operation. Turn the switch off and remove the power plug when the Heated Blanket is not in use or before cleaning it.
- Do not use the Heated Blanket when it's damp or wet.
- Do not touch the product or the adapter with wet hands.
- Do not use devices such as hair dryers or clothes dryers for drying. Allow the blanket to dry by air.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug or the entire product in water or other liquids.

- Do not expose the product to environmental conditions (rain, sun etc.) and do not use the product in high humidity areas or the bathroom.
- Do not insert any sharp objects into the Heating Blanket.
- Take care not to pinch the blanket and cable when using it.
- Do not use the product in a folded or crumpled state.
- Use this Heated Blanket as an under-blanket only. It should not be used with futons or similar folding bedding systems.
- Never cover the controller.
- Do not iron the Heated Blanket.
- This Heated Blanket is not a medical product and is not suitable for therapeutic purposes.
- Connect the control element to the Heated Blanket before you plug the power plug into the power outlet.
- The product is equipped with an overheating protection. If this fuse is triggered, the product will no longer function. In this case, contact a qualified technician.
- Ensure that the Heated Blanket does not overhang the mattress.
- Do not dry clean this Heated Blanket as cleaning solutions may corrode the insulation.
- This Heated Blanket must not be used over or under a waterbed.

Intended use

The Blanket is not a medical device and is not suitable for therapeutic purposes. The Heated Blanket must not be used to warm babies, infants, helpless or heat-insensitive individuals or animals. Use only in dry indoor rooms. Use the product only for its prescribed purpose.



Important: Read these instructions carefully and thoroughly. Keep these instructions to read through at a later date. If you give the product to anyone else at some point in the future, please ensure you also pass on this manual.



Do not bleach



Do not iron



Do not insert pointed objects



Wash at maximum of 30°C in the gentle wash cycle (for models with removable control element).



Do not tumble dry



Do not dry clean



Do not use in a folded or crumpled condition



Not to be used by very young children (0-3 years)



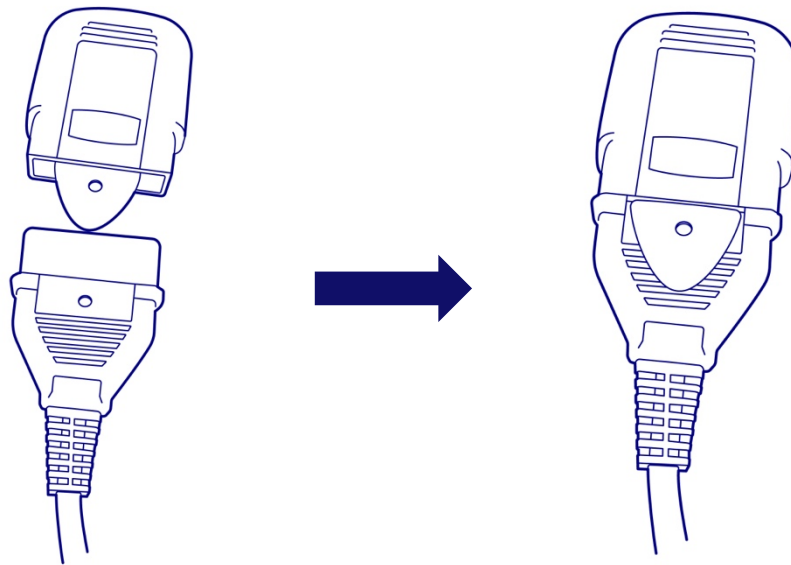

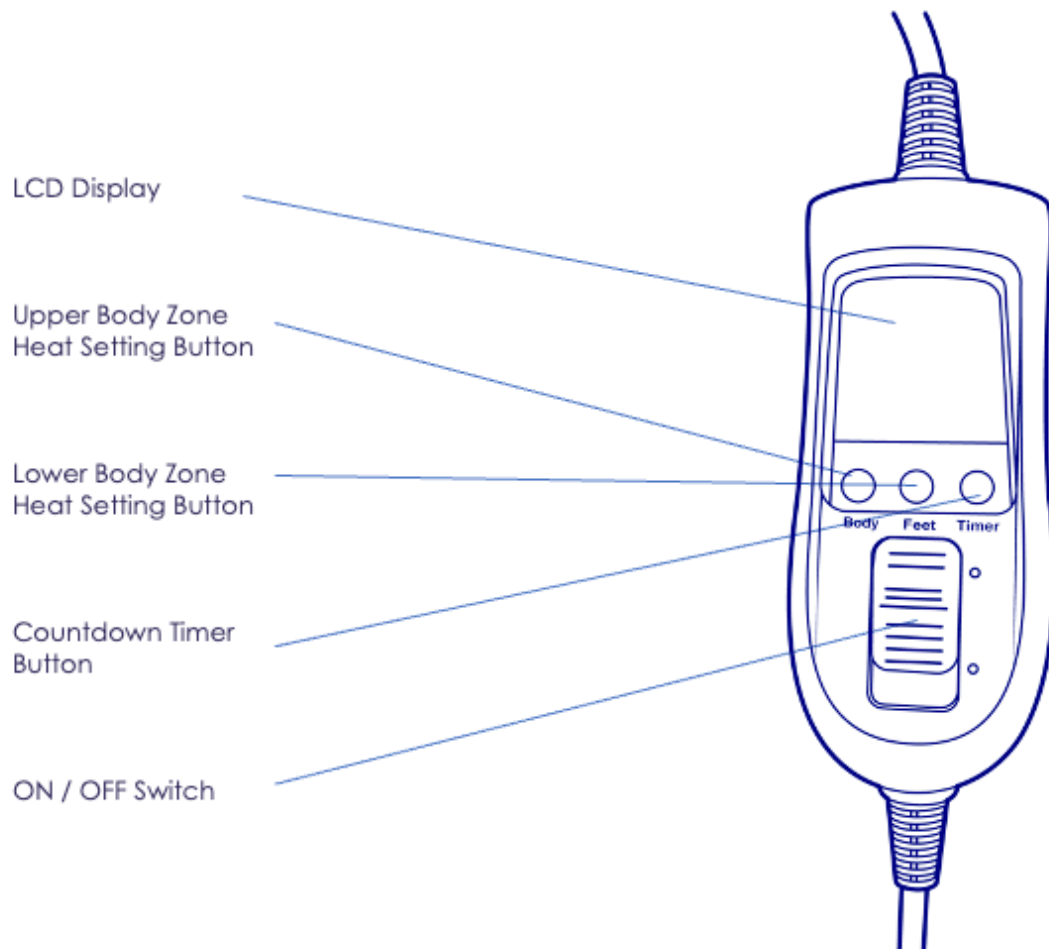
Operating instructions

Place the Heated Blanket on your mattress ensuring there are no folds or crumples. The side with the socket (shown in the image directly below) should be facing downwards towards the mattress.

The Heated Blanket should be placed with the controller located towards the pillow side of the bed. Use the corner straps to secure your Heated Blanket in place. This heated blanket is designed to accommodate multiple mattress depths so it has a plastic buckle on each corner strap that can be easily adjusted to enable a perfect fit for your particular mattress.

Ensure that the plug of the controller is inserted firmly into the socket on the blanket and then insert the plug into the mains power outlet.





Operating the Controller

Firstly, slide the ON / OFF switch upwards so you can see the word "ON". You will notice the blue light of the LCD panel is on and this shows the default heat setting of 9 for the upper body section and 9 for the lower body section. It also shows the default setting for the countdown timer as 1 hour.

If no buttons are pressed for 10 seconds, then the light within the LCD panel will switch off and the blanket will remain operating at the settings last shown.

To check the settings, you can simply press either the "Body", "Feet" or "Timer" button once and the backlight will illuminate.

To select the desired setting for the upper body please continue to press the "Body" button until the number in the top left of the display matches your requirement. For the lower body setting please do the same using the "Feet" button. The number in the bottom left of the display relates to this setting.

The heat settings available are 0-9. The "0" setting will not give any heat with gradually increasing heat output from 1-9 with "9" being the maximum heat setting.

You can use any of these heat settings to pre-heat your bed but only heat settings "1", "2" or "3" should be used whilst sleeping on top of the blanket.

Heat setting "9" will pre-heat your bed quickly but we recommend only using this setting for one hour.

DO NOT SLEEP ON YOUR BLANKET WITH THIS SETTING.

The count-down timer can be set to power down the blanket for up to 12 hours. Press the "Timer" button until you have the number you want. When that time has elapsed, the heat will cut off. The number will be displayed on the right-hand side of the display.

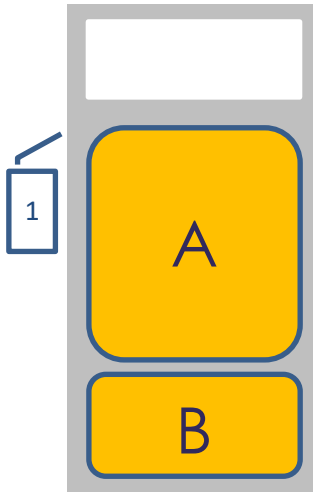
The numbers shown all relate to hour intervals from 1-9. To select 12 hours please ensure that "H" is showing on the display.

Important: When the blanket is not in operation, please slide the ON / OFF switch downwards so you can see the word "OFF".

Multiple Heating Zones

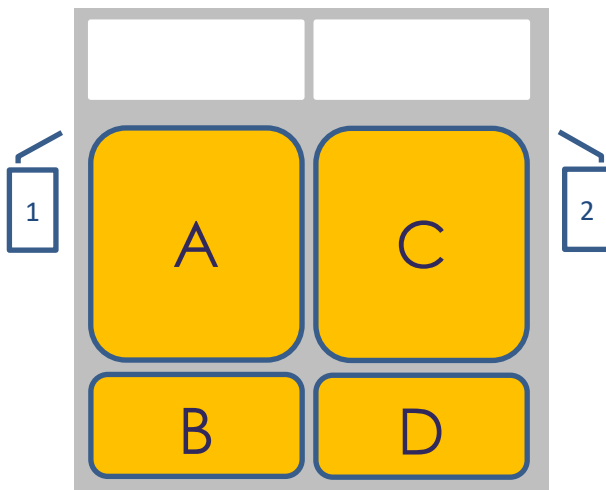
This heated blanket enables you to select different heat settings for your upper body and lower body so you can heat the bed according to your comfort preferences. In addition, the models with 2 x controllers (King and Super King sizes) enable each side of the bed to be set at different temperatures so that you can use a different heat setting to your partner.

Single and Double Size Blanket with One Controller



There are 2 heating zones operated by one controller. In the image, area "A"'s temperature relates to the upper body heat setting that is selected using the "Body" button on the controller. Area "B"'s temperature relates to the lower body heat setting that is selected using the "Feet" button on the controller.

King and Super King Size Blanket with Two Controllers



There are 4 heating zones operated by two controllers. In the image, areas "A" and "B" are controlled via controller "1". Areas "C" and "D" are controlled via controller "2".

You can safely use the heated blanket whilst you sleep using heat settings "1", "2", or "3" only.

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your Heated Blanket in tip-top condition. Please don't dry clean, tumble dry, or iron your Heated Blanket to avoid damage.



Spot cleaning

Sponge the dirty area using a warm soapy solution and when clean sponge the same area lightly with warm water. Remove any excess water using a paper towel or absorbent cloth and then leave to fully dry before use.



Machine washing

Always disconnect the control panel from the electric blanket before washing. Wash at maximum 30°C for a gentle wash.



Hand washing

Always disconnect the control panel from the electric blanket before washing. Do not wring your Heated Blanket.



Drying

Let your Heated Blanket dry naturally by air, do not tumble dry or use a hair dryer or clothes dryer to dry it. If you are hanging it to dry please drape it over the line and don't use pegs.



Storage

When not in use, fold your Heated Blanket and store in a cool, clean and dry location. Avoid pressing sharp creases into your blanket when folding. Only fold and store your blanket when it's fully cooled down.
