
Reign Ottoman Bed

Assembly tips

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. 
(1).Attach the side panels (C) to the headboard (A) locating the brackets behind the flat washers. Loosley screw in the bolts but do not tighten them 100% yet.







(1). Make certain the bed is squared up as shown in the diagram, then fully tighten all the bolts.


(1). Place the base boards into the bottom of the bed.





(1). Attached the piston to the ottoman arm, make sure the piston is assembled the correct way round, the black section attaches to the top of the frame (as per


the image).





(1).Attach the lock (H3) to the ottoman arm (F).








(1). Using bolts (H8) fit the ottoman arms to the side rail (C) and fully tighten all the bolts.







(1).Attach the bar (H11) to the slat frame(E).

Using bolts(H5),nut(H2),metal washers (H6)fit two bar of the slat frame,using allen key(H7)and spanner (H9)tighten all bolts 100%.

(2) Using bolts (H4), nut (H2), metal washers (H6) fit two slat frame, using allen key (H7) and spanner (H9) tighten all bolts 100%.








(1). Attach the slat frame (E) to the ottoman arms (F).

Using two bolt sets on each side (H1, H2,H6,H7,H9),looslet fix the slat frame to to the arm once all 4 bolt sets are in place,please then fully tighten all the bolts.








(1). Push mattress stoppers(1)x 2 into metal frame.

(2).Push rope(J)x 2 into metal frame.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose, over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the colour of the fabric can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
