


Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. Important Information

- Carefully check that you have all the parts before beginning assembly.
- Keep fittings out of children's reach and keep children well away from construction area.

We suggest you retain these instructions for future reference.

Technical description:

An electro-mechanically operated TV bed with a wireless remote control to operate the 'upward' and 'downward' movement of the TV mechanism in the bed base foot-end. The system is powered by voltage 100V - 240V 50/60Hz with a UK plug conforming to BS 1363 and pre-approved (UKCA/ CE marked) power supply unit. The beds upholstery conforms to EN 1725 & BS 5852 Standards. The product is sold to the retailer - without mattress and TV unit.

Intended use:

The product is designed for indoor home, domestic use where TV beds are considered suitable for "adults of 12 years and above". Its main intended use is for sleeping or resting. However, the foot-end of the bed has been designed and manufactured to accommodate, raise and lower, compatible televisions, purely for the purpose of the experiencing media entertainment.

TV Lift System has a maximum load capacity of 80lbs (37kg)

Compatible with slimline LED Televisions with a screen size between 20" and 32"

Maximum TV Dimensions are as follows - Depth 90mm x Width 709mm x Height 399mm (WITHOUT STAND).

(Note: The manufacturer does not accept any responsibility for damages caused to Televisions or Bed Frame Foot-ends, in scenarios or instances where a 'none compatible Television has been selected. Depths of TV and 'rear cable' protrusion measurements should be of particular note.

Application environment:

This product is designed for sale in the UK for use within a domestic environment (excluding nursing homes, geriatric facilities, hospitals, contract environment). The product is designed to be moved only within the intended room of use, for cleaning and for access.

Care Instructions


- Avoid exposing the furniture to excessive heat or direct sunlight as this can cause cracking and deterioration of the color.
- Periodically check & re-tighten any fastener.
- Periodically dust lightly with a clean soft cloth.
- Do not use silicone based furniture polish.
- Any spills should be removed immediately with a soft damp cloth.
- TAKE CARE WHEN MOVING THE FURNITURE AND NEVER DRAG THE PIECES ACROSS THE FLOOR, AS THIS WILL CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE JOINTS.

Head End Connect the AC Adaptor


- The head end will be against the wall.
- Connect the LED connector from the back of headboard to the 3 way power adaptor (M) as shown.
- Touch once to switch on, touch again to switch off the LED. Long press to dimmer / brighter.



Foot End Hardware



- Carefully remove the footboard from carton 2, remove the Hardware Box and all extra transportation packaging from inside.
- To do this you will need to gently lay the foot end on it's back. Before doing so please ensure the area is completely free of anything that may cause damage or press into the fabric. Place a protective cover on the floor to avoid possible damage.
- The controls and hardware are held in place by string please carefully cut these and remove.



Head End & Foot End Assembly



- Open the top lid using Velcro located at TV Footboard (B) and remove the packing material inside the footboard cavity.





- Carefully lift the foot end back to it's upright position.
- Loosen the bolts (K) located in the head end & foot end.
- Please note these should be loosened and NOT removed.
- Hook the side rail brackets over the bolts.




Trundle Cross Rail Assembly


- Loosen the bolts (K) located in the head end & foot end.
- Attach the Trundle Cross Rail (E) & fix with bolts.
- Tighten all fixings to ensure a stable structure.


- Connecting the TV mechanism cable as shown. It is essential that connecting to the power supply is done in this order. Failure to do so will result in damage to your product.
Step 5-1 Connect the AC adapter cable (11) to the TV Lift socket at the footboard (B) as shown.
Step 5-2 Connect the other end AC adapter (11) into an 4 socket extension lead, then switch on.
Step 5-3 Switch on the main power supply.


INSTRUCTION MANUAL FOR TV LIFT CONTROLLER



- Press "UP" button, and release to raise your TV LIFT. To stop press again the "UP" Button.
- Press "DOWN" button, and release to lower your TV LIFT . To stop press again the "DOWN" Button.

CHARGING

- 1) Please monitor the plugged in device being charged. If the device gets hot stop charging immediately.
- 2) Ensure the device being charged is free from moisture and the charge cables are free from damage.
- 3) Please refer to the device manufactures user manual to check suitability of the charging method.
Do not use devices which require high charge input such as laptops and power banks.



PRECAUTIONS

- Before using the bed system connect all cables and mains power.
- Children, the elderly and disabled must be supervised when operating the system.



Tv Cable Connection Plan


- Cable connection plan. Make sure you have all the relevant cable connections required (HDMI cable, TV Aerial cable, TV power cable, Optical cable etc...) before you install the TV.
- The cable management holes are to help you to manage the cable and keep them tidy and free from snags. Pass all cables cleanly through these holes. While ensuring any cable slack is taken up from the bottom end of the footboard.

TIP:

Before fitting the TV, pass any cables through the cable management holes from the top to the bottom, while ensuring the cables slack is taken up from the bottom end of the footboard, choose the best side to use depending on where the connection ports are, on back of your TV.



Note:- ALL TV, HDMI, Aerial, optical cables MUST go through the bungee cable at the Left / Right hand side of mouse hole. From a position looking at the TV screen. Always use the shortest route for your TV cable and ensure there is enough slack for the mechanism to operate freely.



Place all cables through the 'Cable Management' holes to prevent any damage to the cable when the TV Lift Mechanism is operating. Make sure all your the cables are long enough to let the TV Lift Mechanism move freely.

All the cables MUST be carefully pulled and fully extended.


Group the cables MUST be carefully pulled and fully extended. Group the cables together as required below the TV Tray using cable tie(17) provided.

TV Tray Adjustment

- Adjust the TV tray to suit the height of your TV (without stand). Please follow step below
Step 8-1 Make a note of the height (without stand !) of your television.
Step 8-2 Slightly loosen the bolts-half turn only, do not remove all as shown. (refer diagram below)
Step 8-3 Slide "UP / DOWN the TV Vertical Bar to using the measure line to match the noted height of your TV, then fully tighten bolts.
Step 8-4 When the TV is mounted it should sit neatly just underneath the Gooseneck.


Note: The minimum height of the TV Tray is 470mm which accommodates any of the of the smaller TV heights (without stand) below 470mm.





- You are now ready to install your TV.
- Raise the mechanism to it's highest position.
- While standing behind your television (on the outside end of the footboard) .
- Carefully place the TV on top of the two rubber TV mounting pedestals - ensuring the Gooseneck arm is perfectly in line with the horizontal 'centre' of the TV.

- **TV Bracket**
Please note: Item (21) or (22) or (23) or (24) or (29) or (30) or (31) or (32) screws have been supplied to fit most TV models. However sizes may vary depending on the TV model. If smaller or larger size screws are required these should be source from your local hardware store or TV specialist. Washers may also be required. Your retailer may also supply alternative fixings depending on the TV model supplied at the time.






- Loosen the bolts (L) located to the Side Rail and Trundle Cross Rail.
- Lay the Flat Slat on top of the Slat Support Rail and Trundle Cross Rail.
- The first and last Slat should be laid next to the bolts.


- Tighten the bolts as shown.
- Then, using the screw (N) to fix all the slat as shown.



Trundle Drawer Construction




- Attach the Castor (R) to the Trundle Support Rail using screw (Q) provided as shown.



- Attach the Trundle Side Panel over the hook as shown.
- Repeat the action on the opposite side.


- Attach the Trundle Base Panel (H) as shown.




Assemble Drawer to Bed

- Make sure to even the Trundle Drawer.



TROUBLE SHOOTING



User Action: TV Lift Reset Method: Turn off the main power----- > Unplug the power connector from the foot end ----- > wait 60s ----- > Plug in the power connector and turn on the main power.

USB Without taking any charging from your device

- Check the power supply (green light).
- Replace new device charge cable.
- Call Service centre, if has furthermore issue.



Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't been become loose, over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.

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
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
