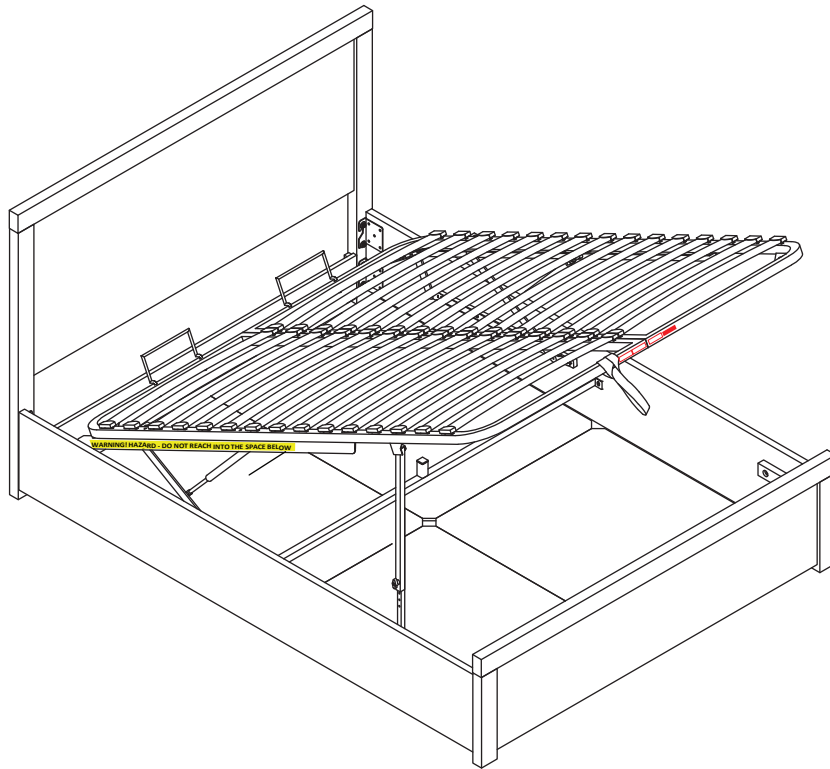


Tribeca Ottoman Bed



IMPORTANT OTTOMAN SAFETY WARNINGS

- **IMPORTANT - READ CAREFULLY - RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**
- **You must ensure that the mattress is on the bed frame before operating the lift mechanism - Failure to do so could result in injury.**
- **Keep hands clear of the mechanism when opening or closing the ottoman.**
- **Beware of entrapment - Never reach in through the mechanism to access the storage area.**
- **Always ensure that the ottoman is FULLY opened before accessing the storage area.**
- **Do not exceed the maximum weight as specified in the table below:**

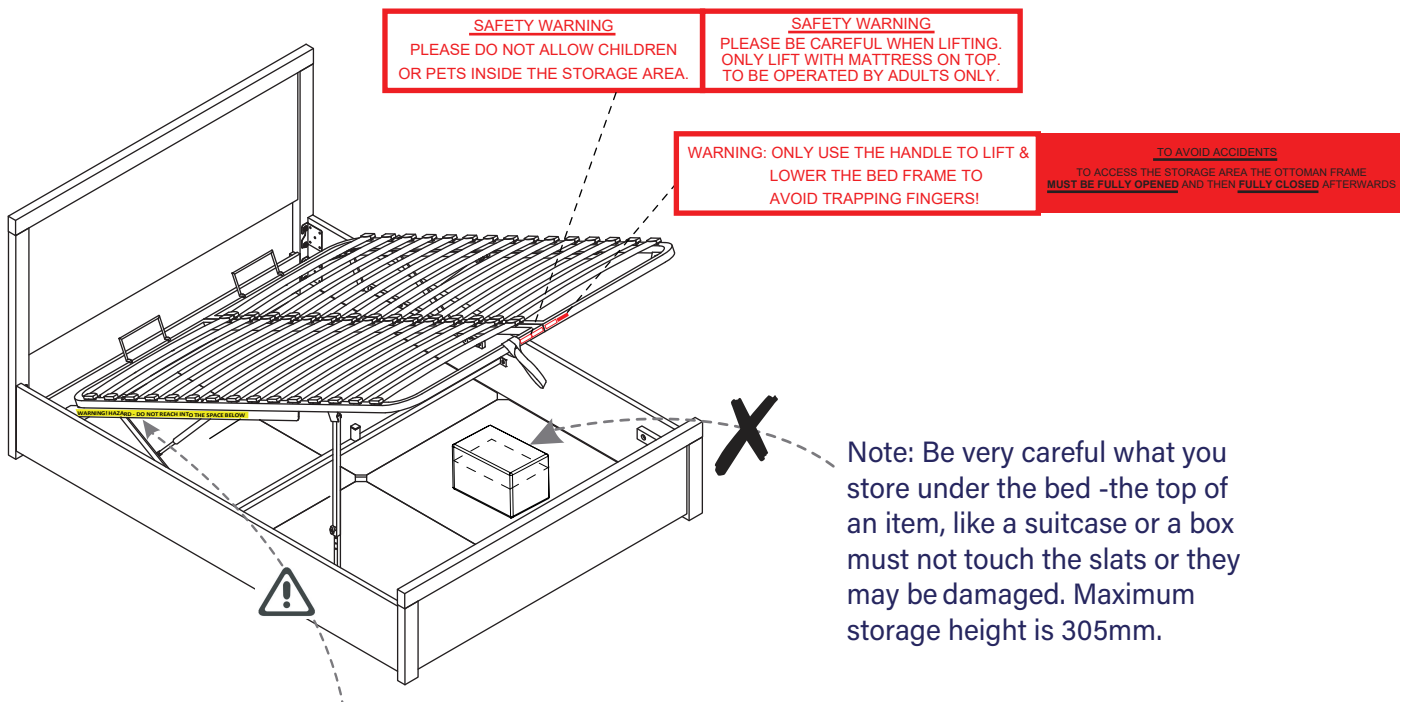

IMPORTANT OTTOMAN SAFETY WARNINGS Cont.



- Use caution when operating, always use the handle when lifting.
- Note: This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- To be operated by adults only.
- Please ensure that children and pets are kept away from the bed when operating the lift mechanism.
- Keep children and pets away from the storage area.
- Do not overload the internal storage base.
- Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.
- Before removing the mattress secure the frame to ensure it does not open unexpectedly.
- Do not attempt to lie on the mattress when the ottoman is in the raised position.
- When lifting the ottoman, remove all bedding except the fitted sheet.

Our aim is always to give you the best experience and to ensure every effort has been made to guarantee your comfort and safety. Please take time to look at these instructions as they will help remind you how to operate your ottoman bed safely.

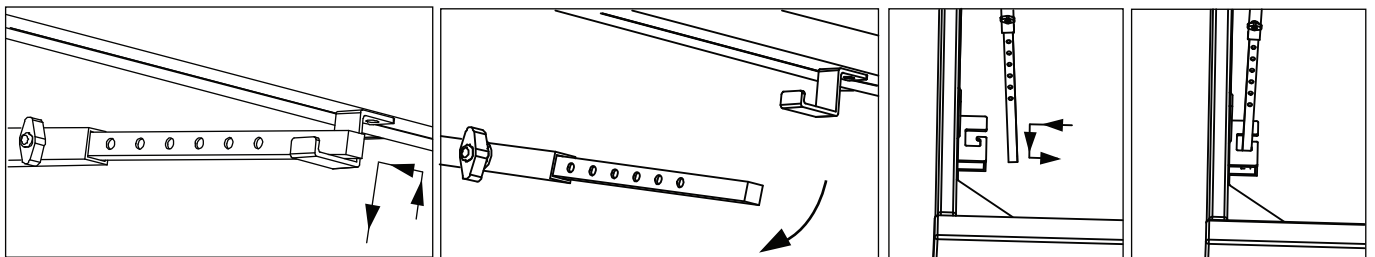
Here's a few things you need to remember;

- ✓ **Pistons are already assembled in their correct orientation - this improves piston performance and durability.**
- ✓ **"Break in" the piston seals on first use by raising & lowering the platform at least five times.**
- ✓ **Recommended mattress weights - do not exceed the maximum relevant weight specified on the Assembly Instruction.**
- ✓ **Ottoman support bar - always engage the support bar when accessing the ottoman storage area.**

Read all the instructions before using your Ottoman bed-frame and save the instruction booklet for future reference.

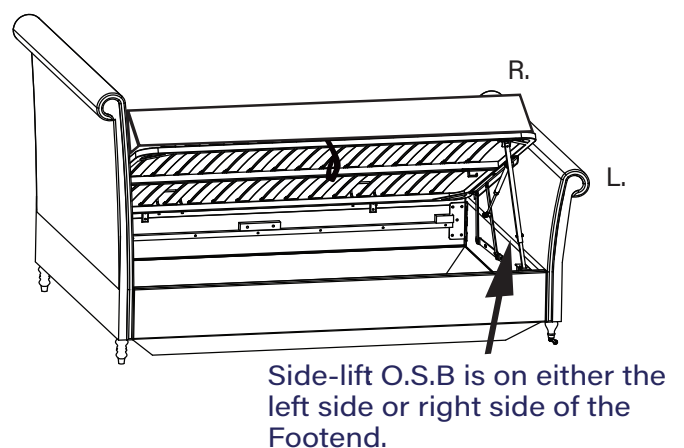
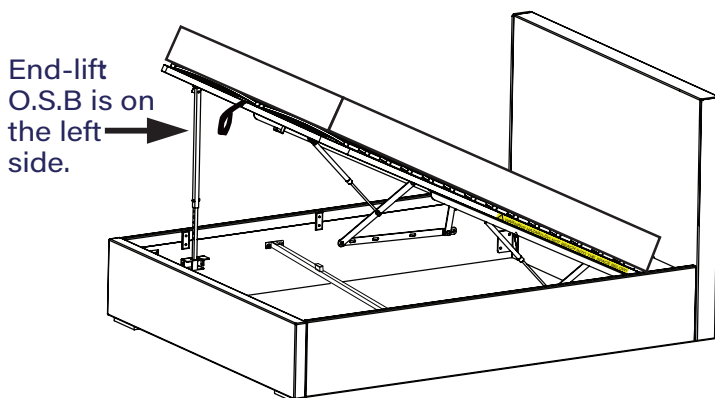
Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.)

For optimal safety during operation, always ensure the O.S.B. is engaged when accessing the ottoman storage area.



1. Always raise the ottoman slat-frame to its highest position before using the storage area.
Locate the end of the O.S.B and insert into the fixed retaining bracket on the bed frame.
2. When you are ready to lower the ottoman platform, return the O.S.B to its original parking position.
3. Always ensure that the O.S.B is in position when the ottoman is open, this prevents injury, or damage to the product.

WARNING! Risk of Entrapment

- The pistons on the ottoman bed frame can support a maximum load (evenly spread) as indicated in the Minimum and Maximum load table, in the main Assembly Instruction.
- Overloading the sleeping platform may contribute to damage to the product resulting in potential serious injury.
- Do not sit on the mattress whilst the platform is in motion or is in the raised position.
- Users should only get in and out of bed when platform is in the flat (horizontal) position.

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.

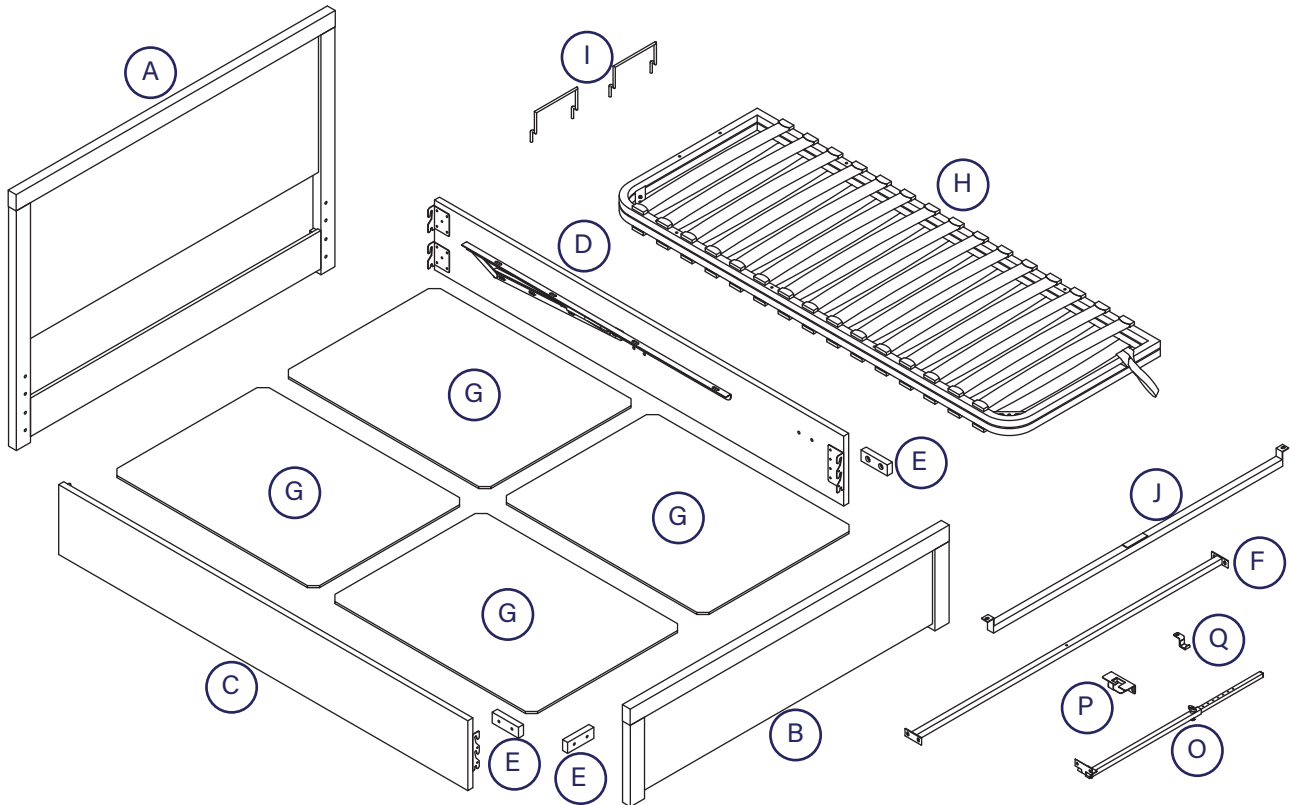
Parts

The bed you have purchased comes with two different base options, Ottoman lift-up or Sleepmotion base. Identify which base you have purchased as the assembly method may change.

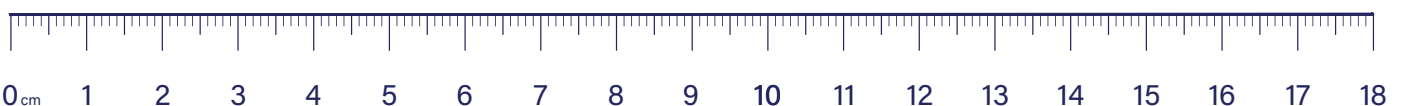
If you have purchased the Ottoman base please follow the instructions below in the current order.




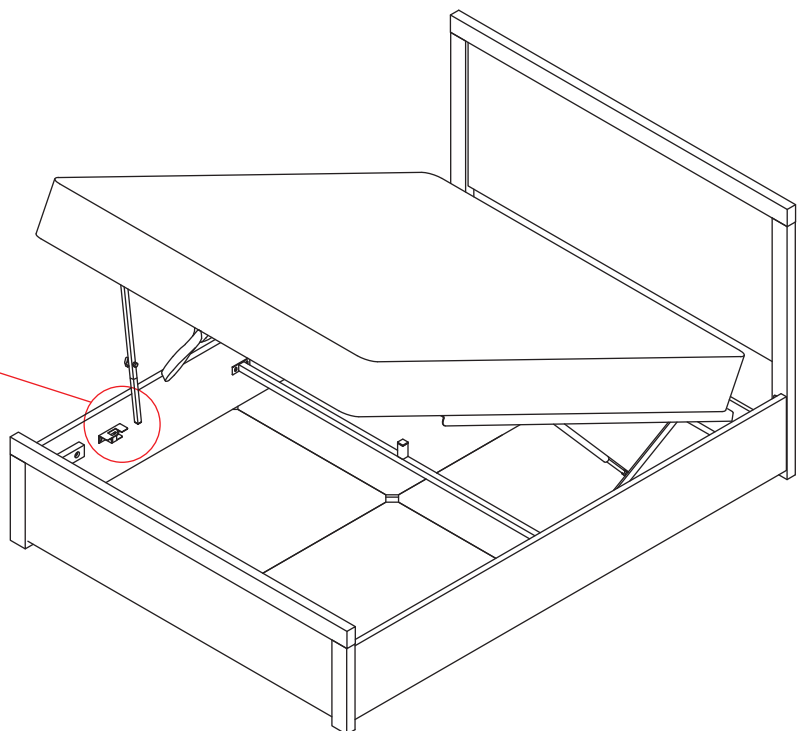
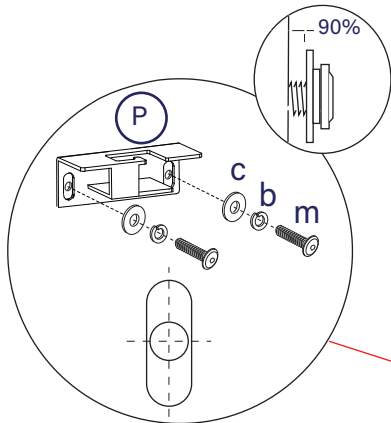
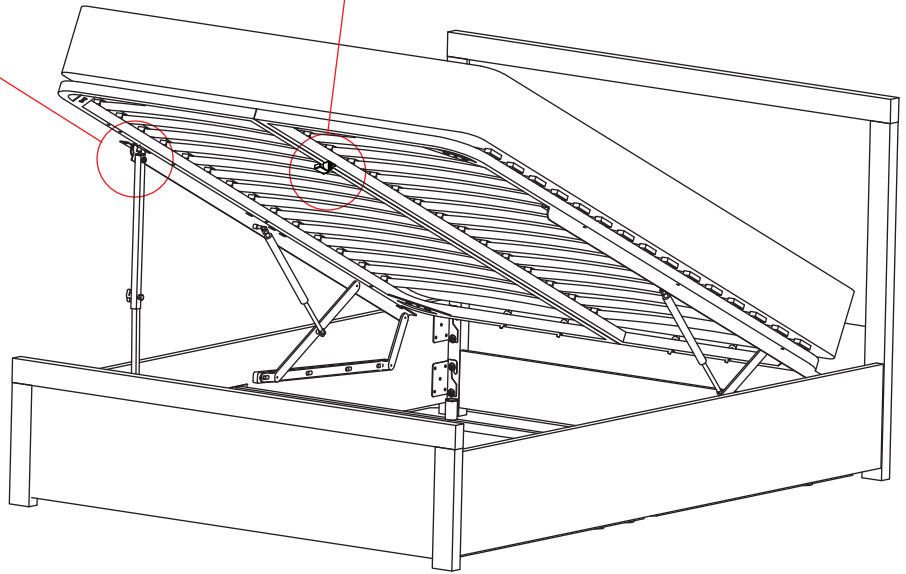
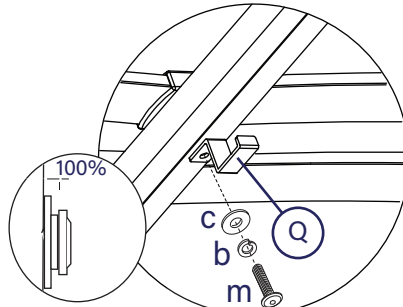
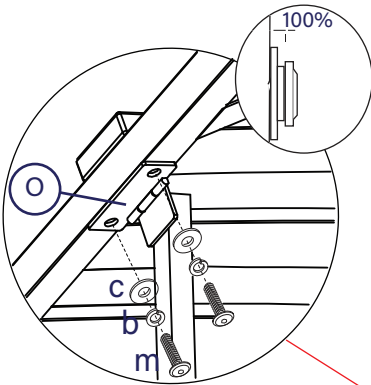
13 Unpack the contents of the Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.) from its carton - this is packed inside Pack 2.

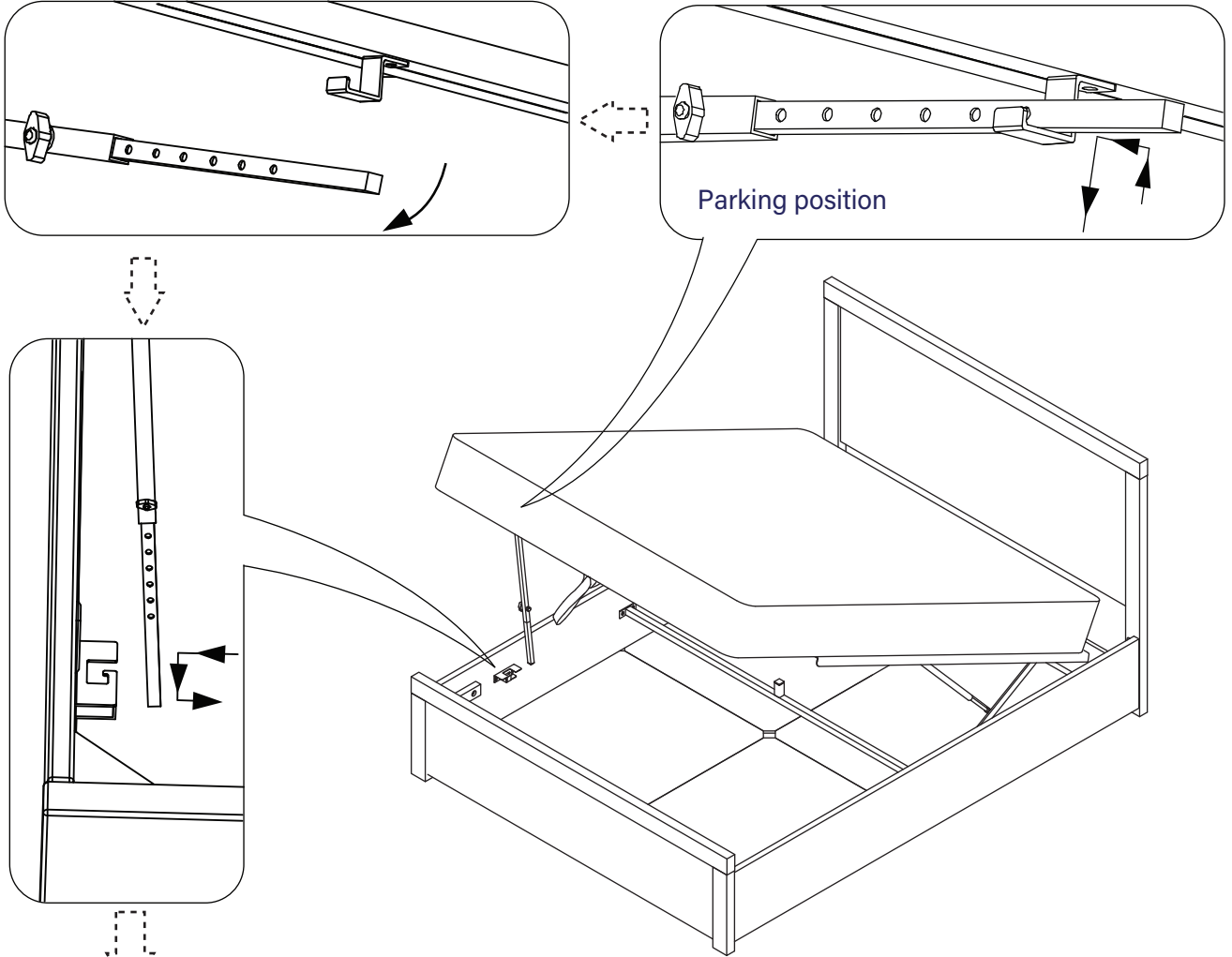

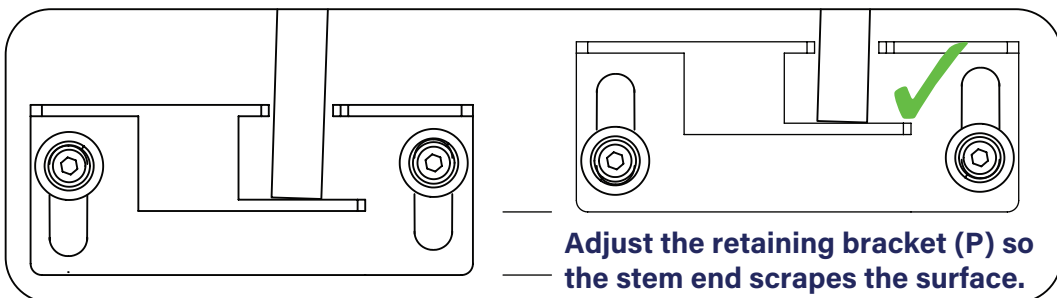
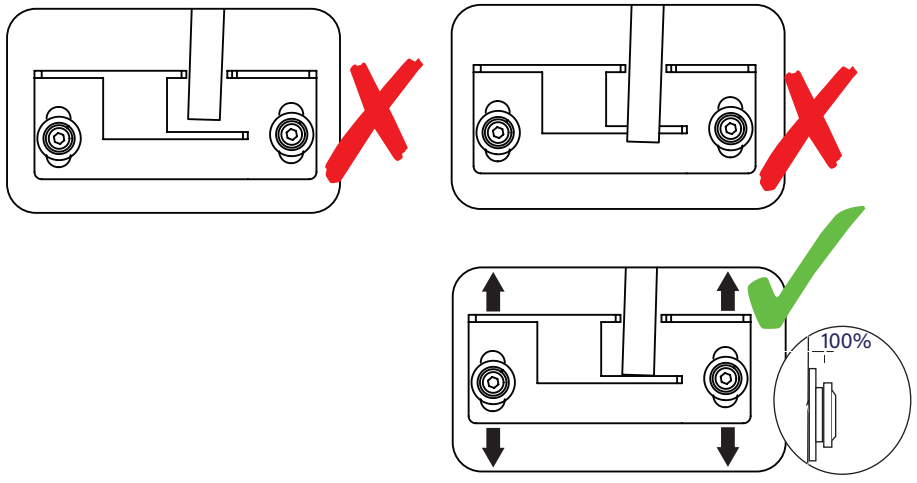

Setting the inner stem of the support bar (O), adjust the inner stem to the correct length.



Set the inner stem to the correct length so the end just touches the retaining bracket - it needs to touch to hold it in position.

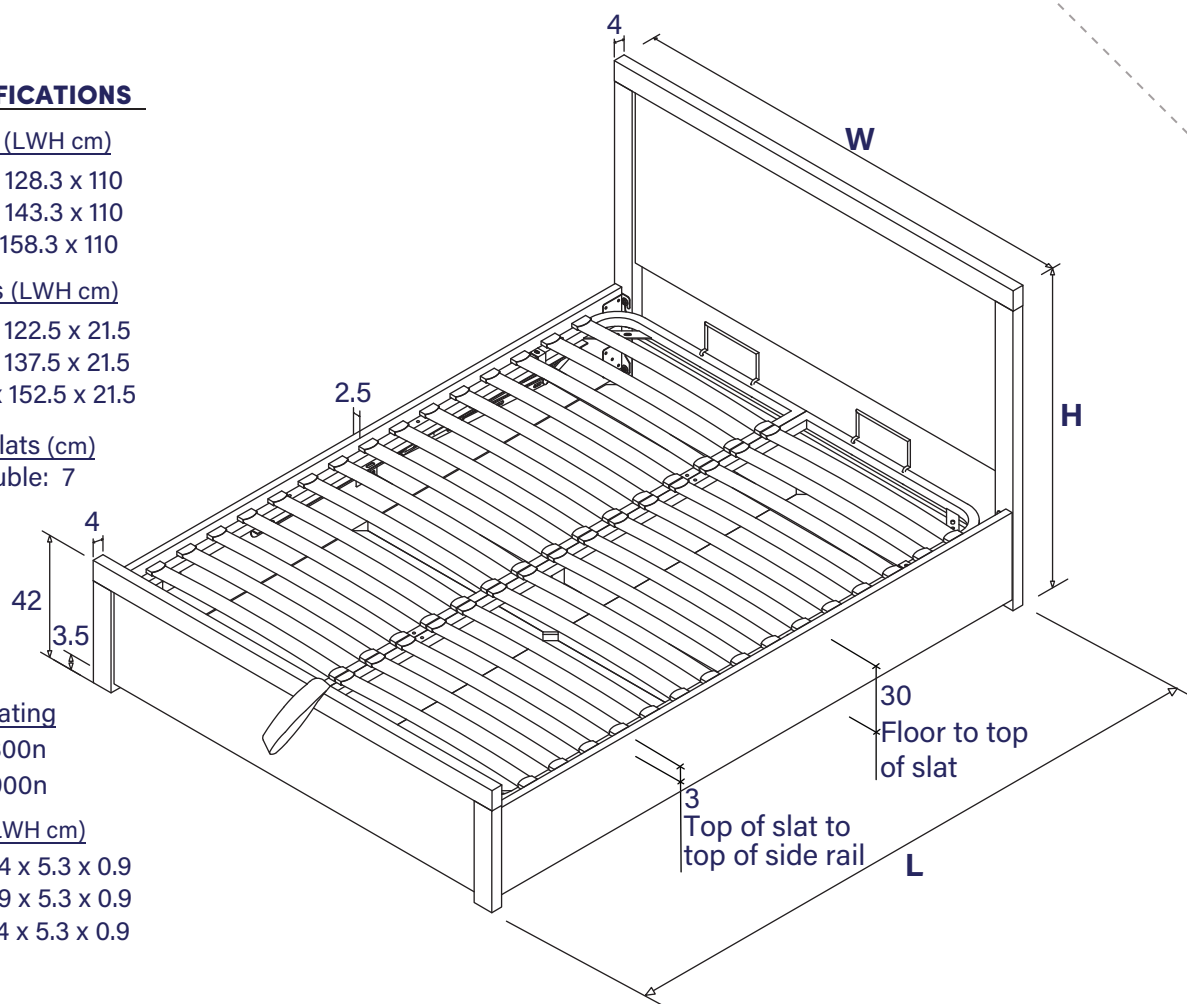

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose, over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
