



(A) Endboard x 2




(B) Top side rail A x 1




(C) Top side rail B x 1



(D) Bottom side rail x 2





WARNING-This bed must be place in a room that have good ventilation in order to keep the humidity low and to prevent mould in and around the bed.

WARNING-High beds & the upper bed of bunk beds are **not suitable** for children under six years due to risk of injury from falls. Do not allow children under 6 years to sleep or access the top bunk.

WARNING-Allow only one person on the top bunk.

WARNING-Do not allow children to play on bunk beds.

WARNING-Make sure your child is taught how to use bunk beds safely.

WARNING-Assemble the bunk bed properly following manufacturers instructions.

WARNING-Do not place bunk beds near windows, curtains/blinds or within 2 metres of a ceiling light fitting.

WARNING-Check regularly to make sure the bed frame is sturdy and free from signs of wear and tear.

WARNING-Check for any gaps that may trap fingers, limbs and heads.

WARNING-Make sure there is nothing sticking out from the bed which could catch in your child's clothing.

WARNING-Bunk beds & high beds can present a serious risk of injury from strangulation if not used correctly. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed to be used with the bed. For example, ropes, strings, cords, hooks, belts and bags.

WARNING-Children can become trapped between the bed & the wall, a roof pitch, the ceiling, adjoining pieces of furniture (e.g. cupboard) and the like. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the adjoining structure shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm.

WARNING-Do not use the bunk bed / high bed if any structural part is broken or missing.

WARNING-Do not use mattress more then 6 inches / 150mm thickness.

WARNING-Keep the area under the bunk bed clear of furniture, toys and other sharp objects.

Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.

Please do not jump on your furniture.

Periodically check the condition of your bed slats and plastic locating caps to ensure they are in good condition and have not become loose.

This is very important when moving your bed. It is best to lift the bed, and never to drag it.

Top Tips before you start!

1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture, as once assembled, the furniture is exempt from our home approval policy.
2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
3. For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people (as indicated on page 1) to assemble your product safely.
4. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
5. For the protection of your furniture, particularly items of high gloss finish, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
6. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product.

1- ATTACH BOTTOM SIDE RAIL TO ENDBOARD


LOOSEN BOTTOM SIDE RAIL ATTACHMENT BOLTS FROM ENDBOARD.

REMARK: BOLTS ONLY TO BE LOOSENED AND NOT REMOVED.

HOOK THE BOTTOM SIDE RAIL OVER THE BOLTS IN THE ENDBOARD AS SHOWN.

ATTACH THE SCREWS LOOSELY.

DO NOT TIGHTEN THE BOLTS UNTIL STEP 2.



2- ATTACH TOP SIDE RAIL TO ENDBOARD


LOOSEN TOP SIDE RAIL TOP ATTACHMENT BOLT FROM THE ENDBOARD.

REMARK: BOLT ONLY TO BE LOOSENED AND NOT REMOVED.

REMOVE THE OTHER THREE REMAINING BOLTS FROM THE ENDBOARD.


HOOK THE TOP SIDE RAIL OVER THE BOLTS IN THE ENDBOARD AS SHOWN.
ATTACH BACK THE THREE REMOVED BOLTS TO THE ENDBOARD.

TIGHTEN ALL FIXINGS TO ENSURE A STABLE STRUCTURE.



3- ATTACH METAL LADDER TO THE BED


ATTACH THE METAL LADDER TO THE BED AS SHOWN.
TIGHTEN THE LADDER TO THE SIDE RAIL USING
HARDWARE (I) & (M).




4- ATTACH TIE RAIL TO THE SIDE RAIL

REMOVE TIE RAIL ATTACHMENT BOLTS FROM SIDE RAIL.



ATTACH THE TIE RAIL (E) TO THE BED AS SHOWN.
TIGHTEN THE TIE RAIL (E) TO THE SIDE RAIL USING BOLTS PROVIDED.




5- ATTACH POSTURE SLATS TO THE BED

On Delivery

Once your new bed is in place and all the packaging is removed, let it air for approximately 1 hour before putting on your mattress, mattress protector and bed linen.

Don't worry if your bed feels a little strange at first. It takes time for your body to adjust to a new level of support and comfort. You'll soon be enjoying a more relaxed sleep.

Please consider the surface your bed will be stood on. If your bed frame is to be stood on an uncarpeted surface please ensure that you use rubber backed mat under the legs to avoid slipping.

Day to day Care

Check all bolts, screws and legs regularly to make sure they haven't loosened and tighten all joins of your furniture or bedstead after 6 months. Please keep these instructions in a safe place for further use.

Storage Drawers in Bedsteads are designed to carry lightweight items such as Pillows, duvets and linen. Please try to avoid storing heavier items such as books or toys.

Returns

If you have bought a large item such as a bed or mattress which is damaged or faulty and would like to return it, we will be able to arrive at your home and take your item away. All we ask is that your item is in perfect condition and in its original packaging (you can open the packaging to inspect your item). Items will not be able to be returned if they are not in their original packaging.

For online and telesales orders, you can only return an item within 7 days from the date of your delivery.
