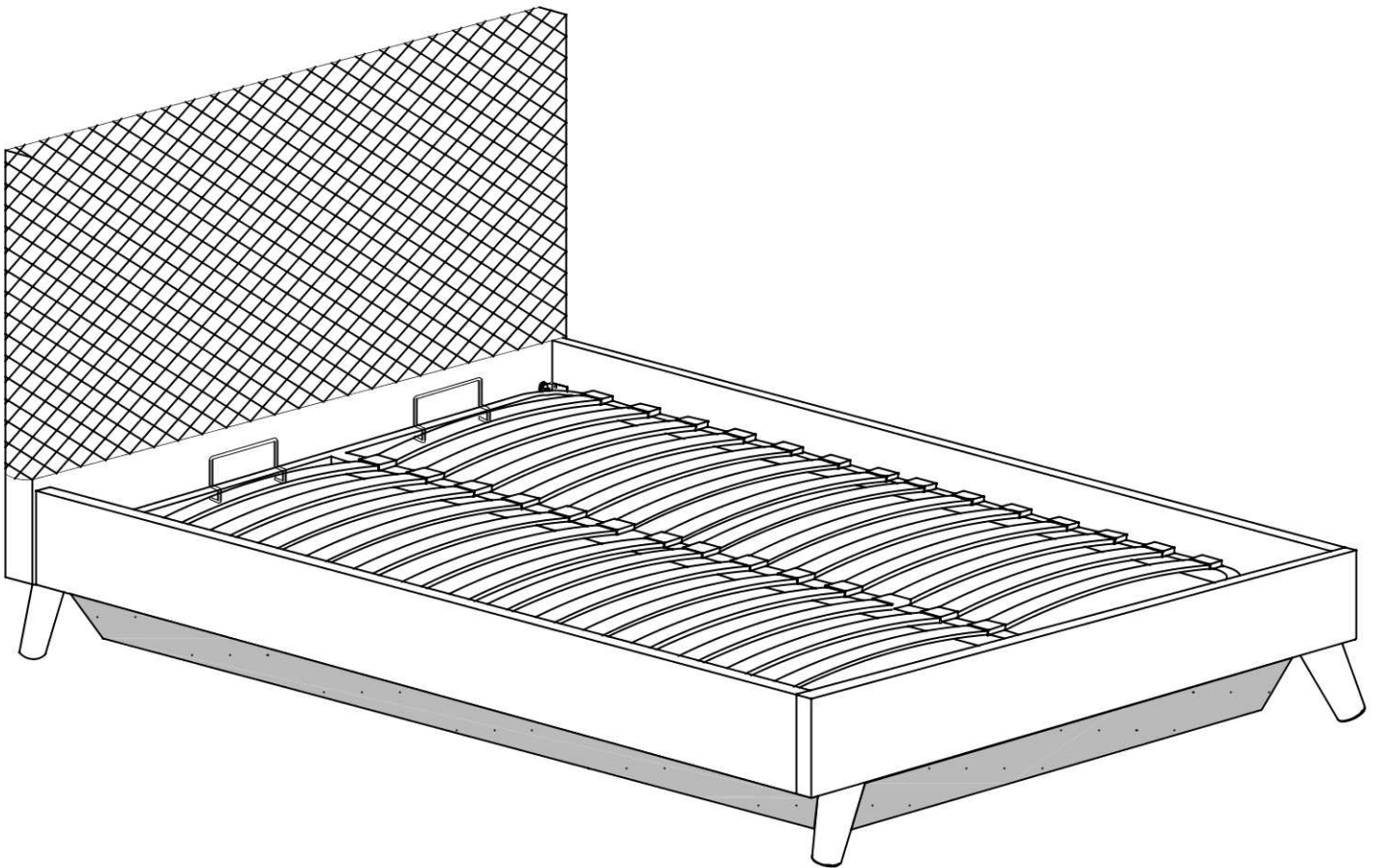

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.

Recycling

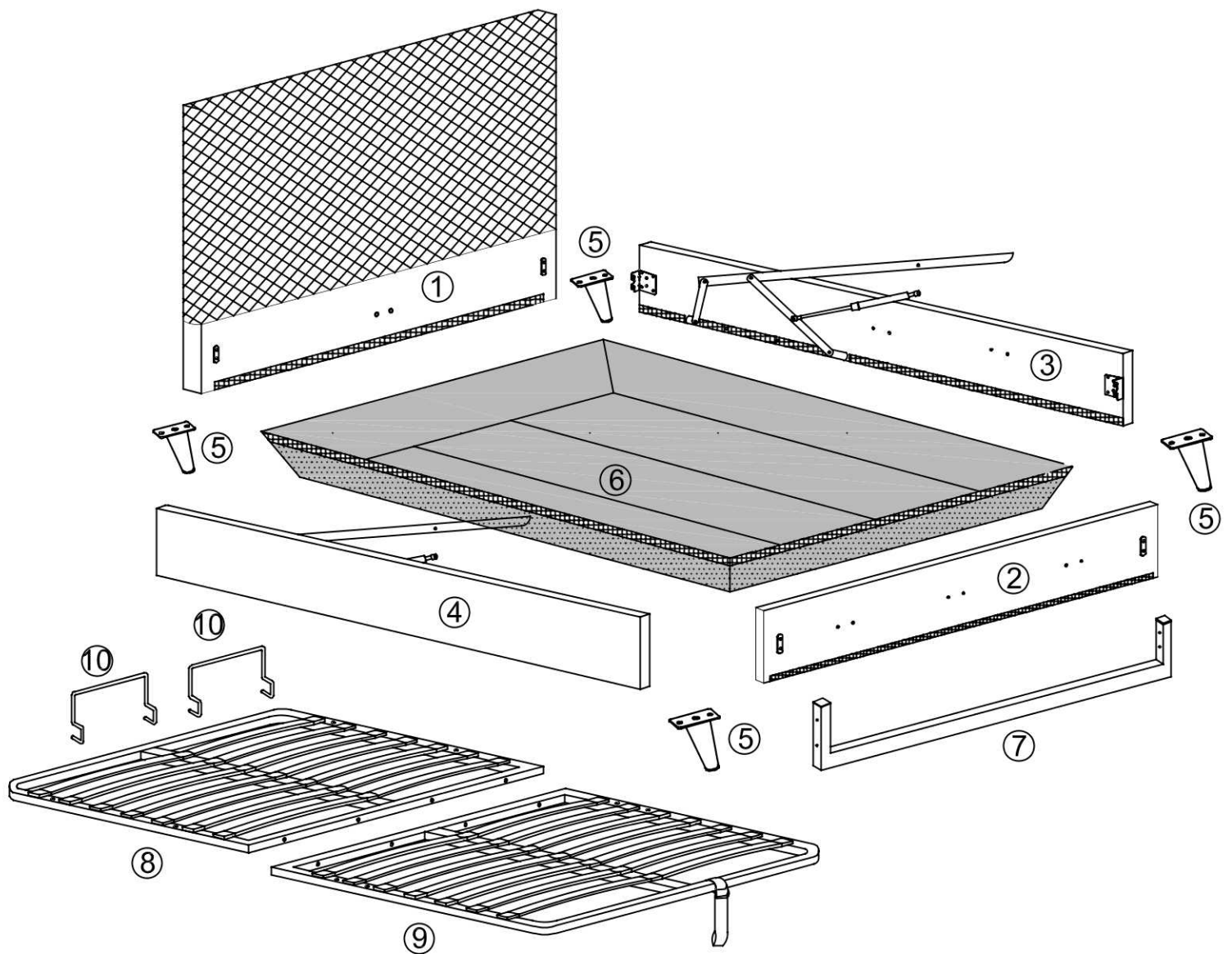
Please ensure that packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way, and recycle where possible. Our assembly instructions are printed on recycled paper. Please keep your assembly instructions safe to refer back to in the future.

Important Ottoman Safety Warnings

- Caution. This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Use caution when operating - Always use two hands at arm's length, and only where illustrated on the product.
- you must ensure the mattress is on the bed frame before lifting the mechanism - Failure to do so may result in injury.
- Please ensure Children and Pets are kept away from the bed when operating the bed mechanism.
- If removing the mattress, make sure that the frame is secured as it could flip open.
- Only use the storage compartment when the frame is fully raised in the 'up' position.
- No children or animals are left unattended when the frame is in the 'up' position.
- Do not remain on the bed whilst the lifting mechanism is in use.
- Beware of Entrapment - Keep both hands clear of mechanism when operating the mechanism.
- When lifting the bed remove all bedding - Except the fitted sheet.
- Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed.
- Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.
- NOTE: When fully assembled and the mattress is in position, please raise and lower the ottoman 4 / 5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.

Step 1



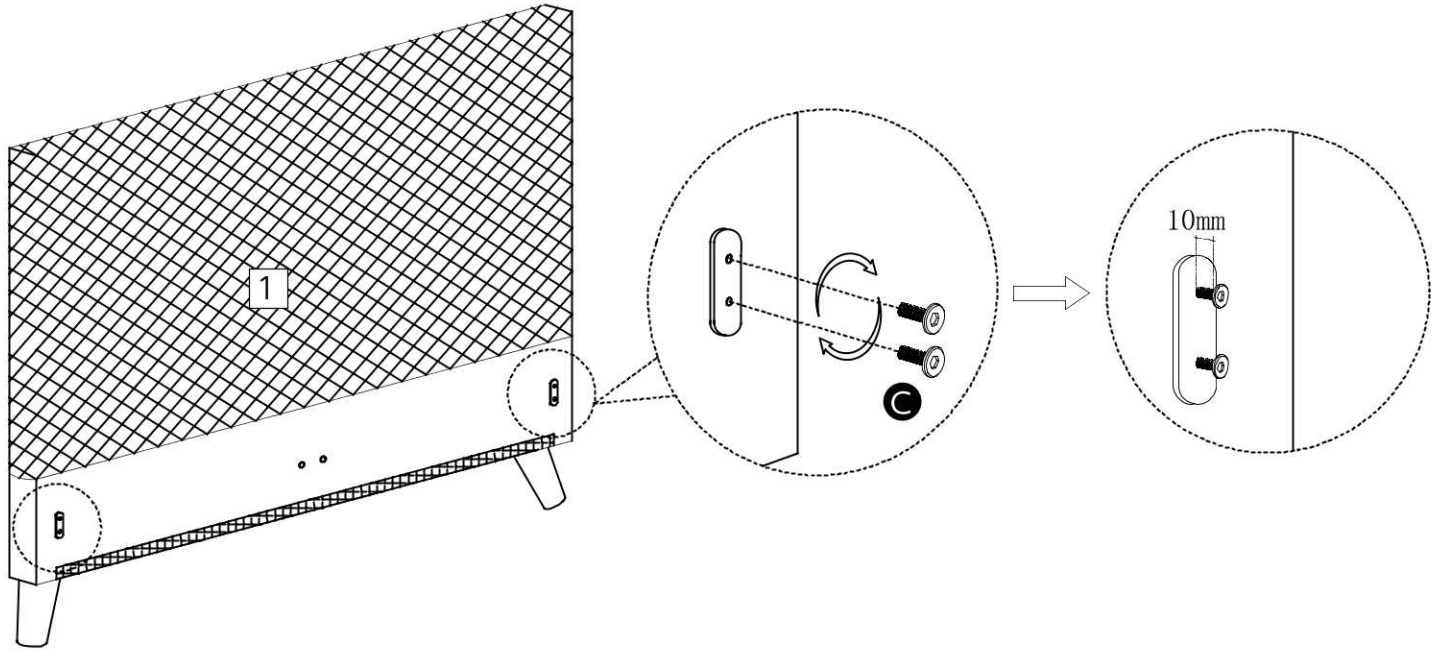
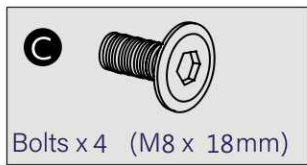
Attach 2 x legs (5) to the bottom of headboard (1) with 4 x bolts 20mm (A) and 4 x washers (B) by using allen key (D).

Step 2



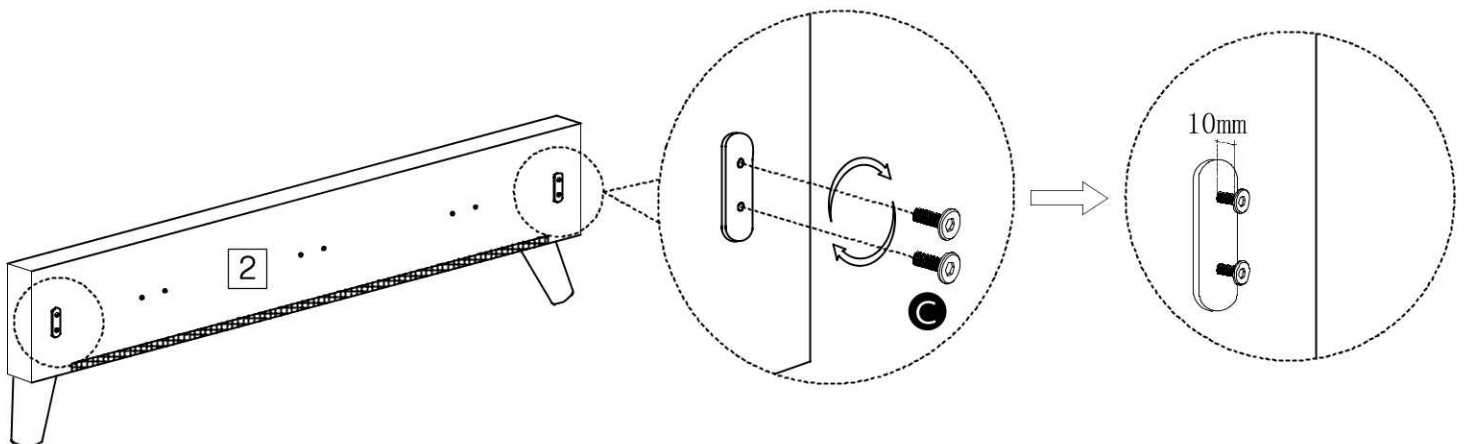
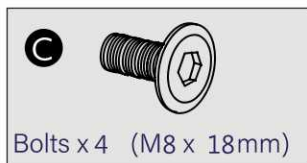
Attach 2 x legs (5) to the bottom of footboard (2) with 4 x bolts 20mm (A) and 4 x washers (B) by using allen key (D).

Step 3



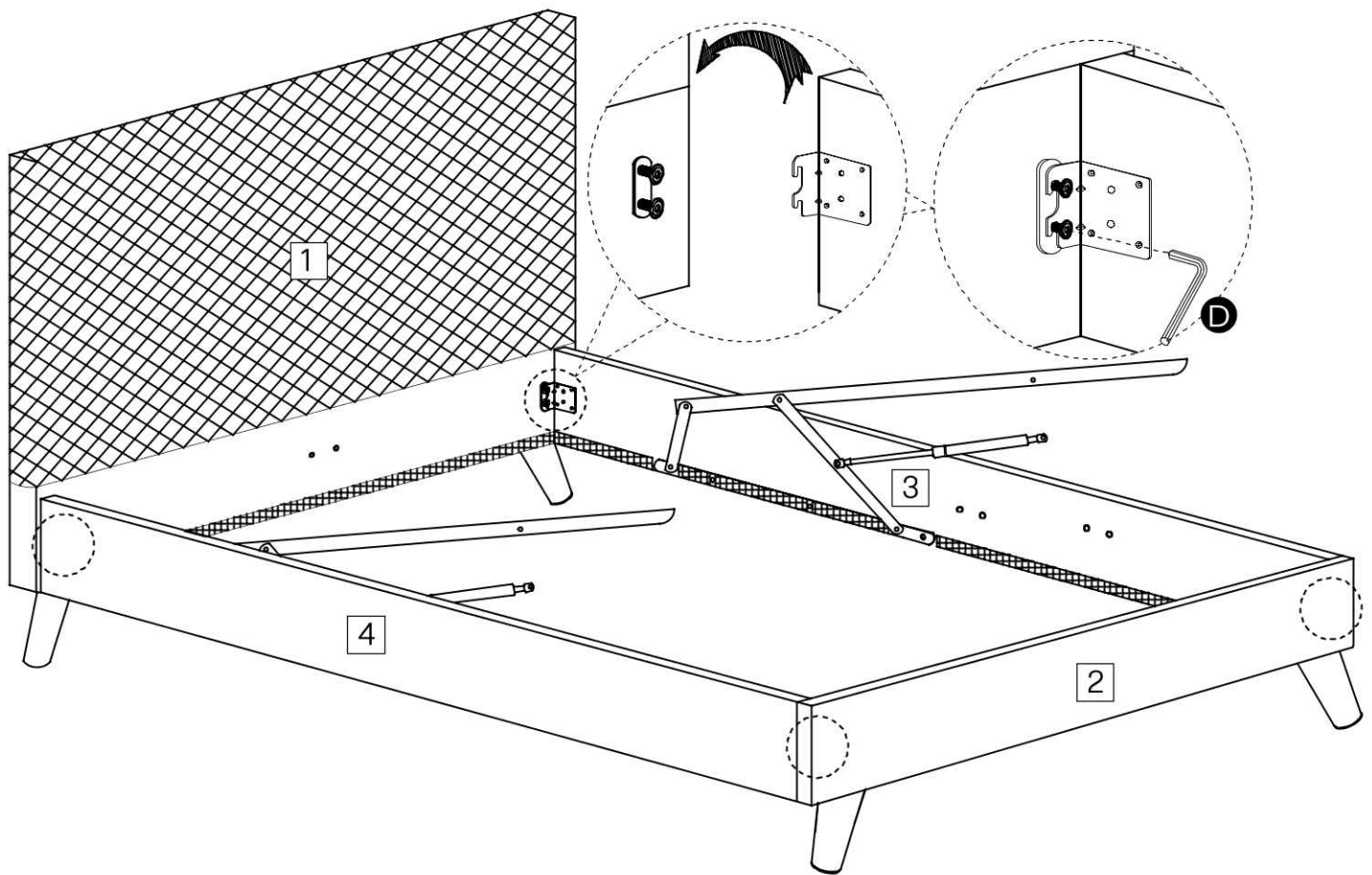
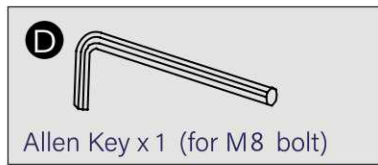
Install 4 x bolts 18 mm (C) to the holes in the headboard (1) as shown by hand.
Note: Do not tighten fully but leave 10mm gap as in the diagram.

Step 4



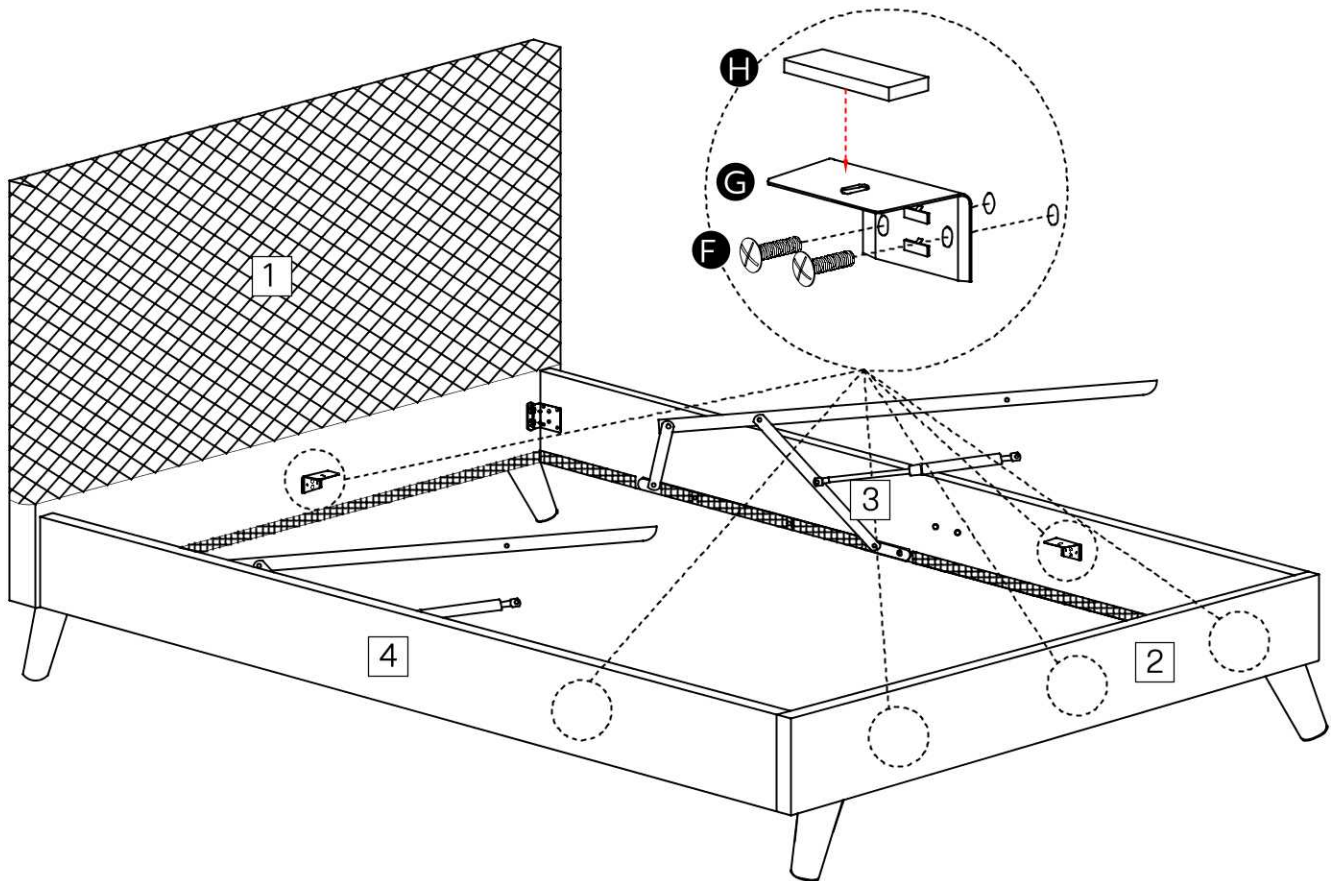
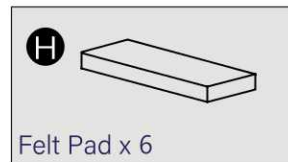
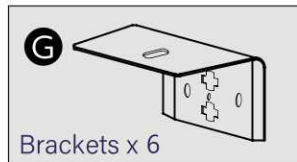
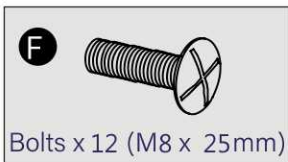
Install 4 x bolts 18 mm (D) to the holes in the footboard (2) as shown by hand.
Note: Do not tighten fully but leave 10mm gap as in the diagram.

Step 5



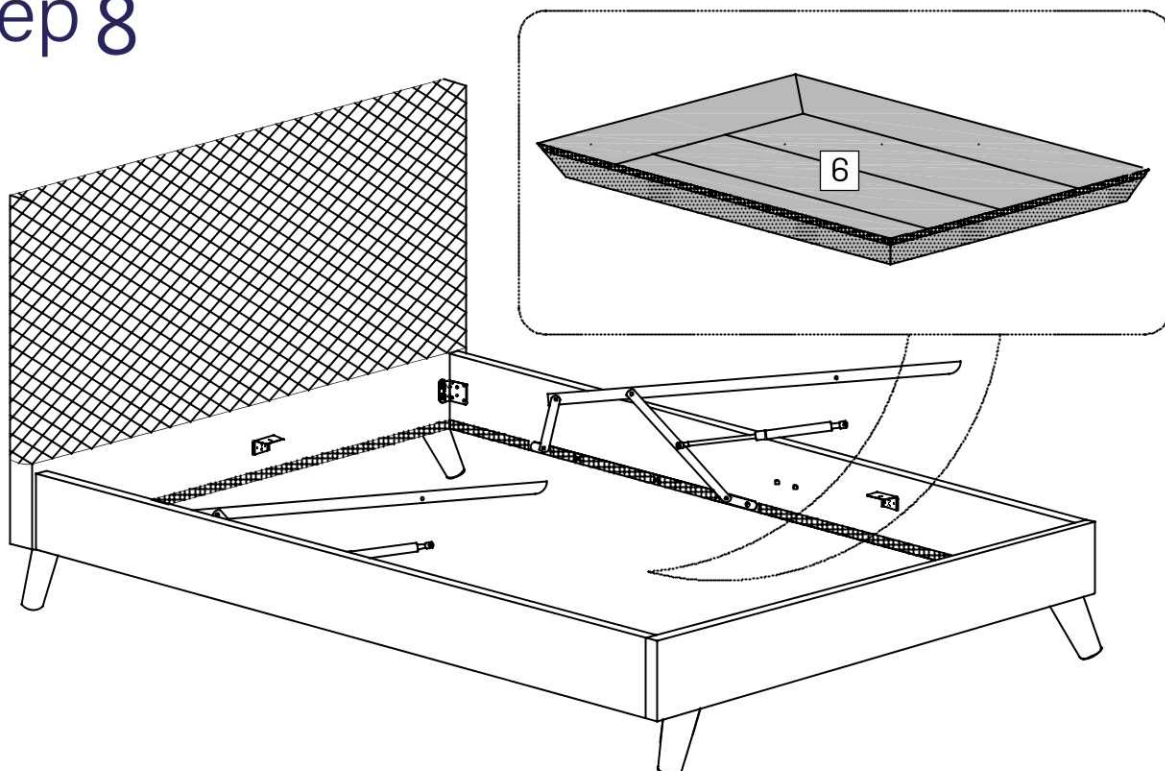
Attach side rails (3 and 4) to headboard (1) and footboard (2) by Allen key (E) as shown.

Step 7



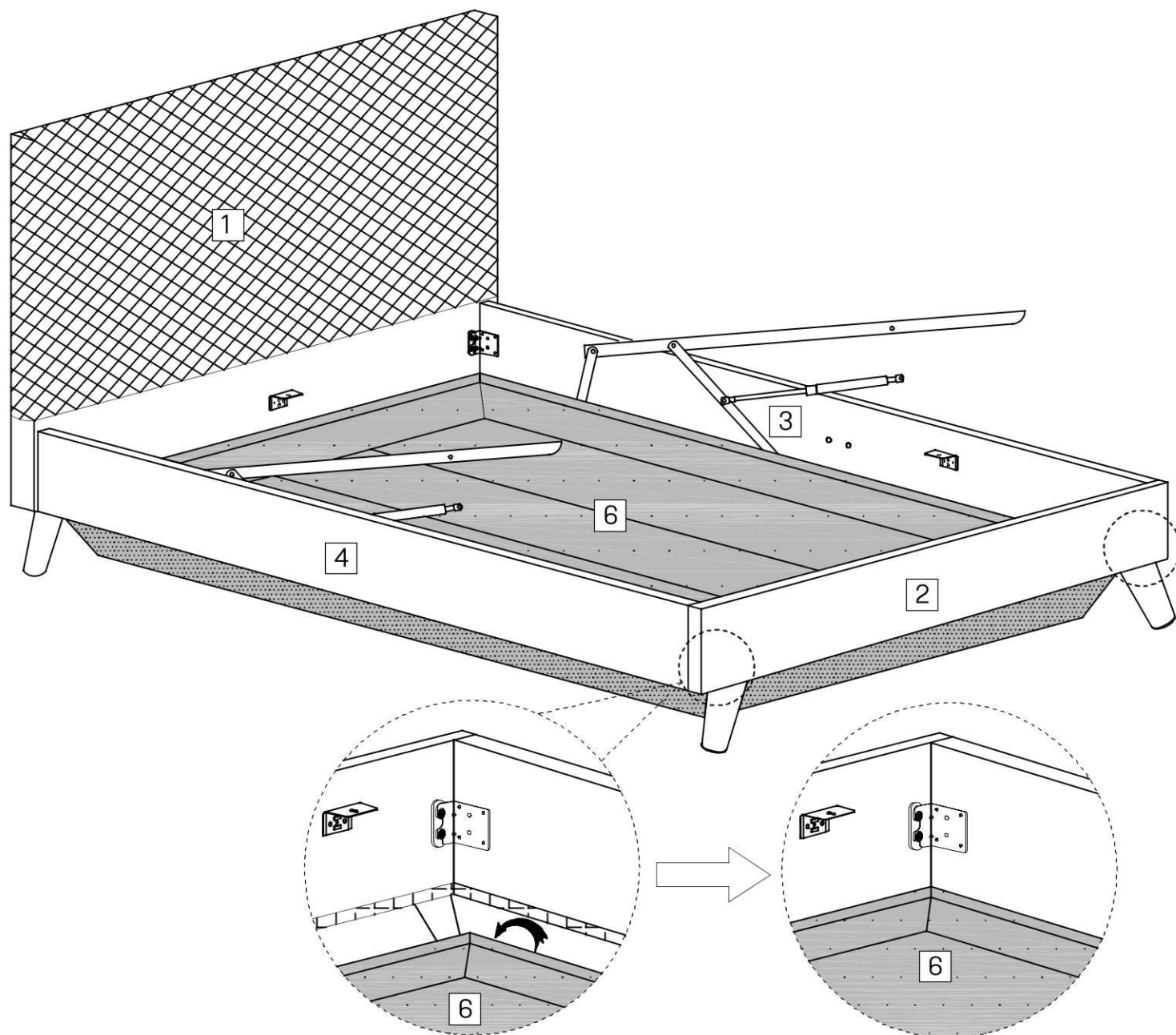
Attach 6 x brackets (G) to the headboard (1), side rails (3 and 4) and footboard (2) with 12 x bolts 25mm (F) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided).
Stick the felt pad (H) on each top of bracket (G).

Step 8



Put the baseboard (6) inside of bed. Attach the velcro to the four edges of frame.

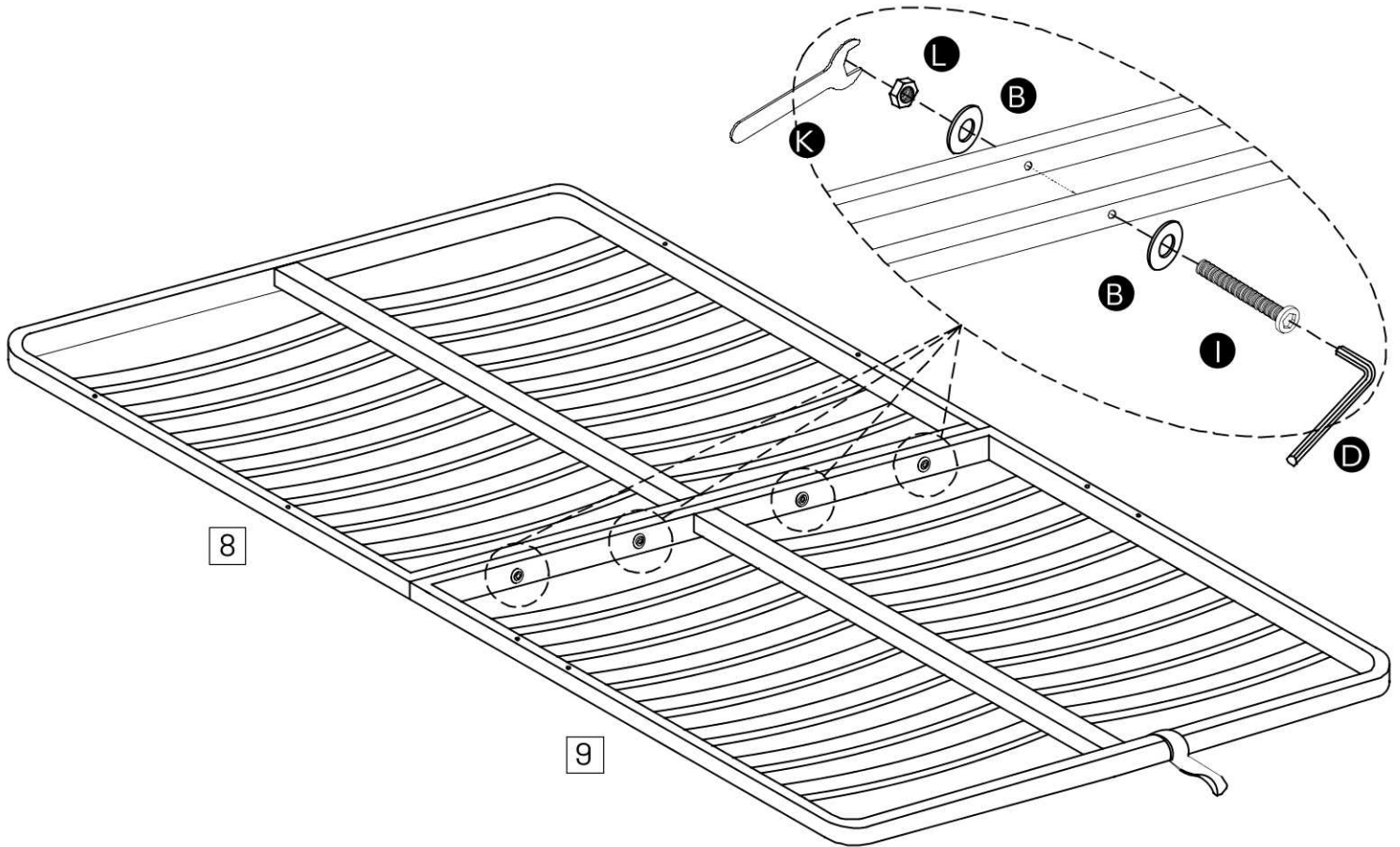
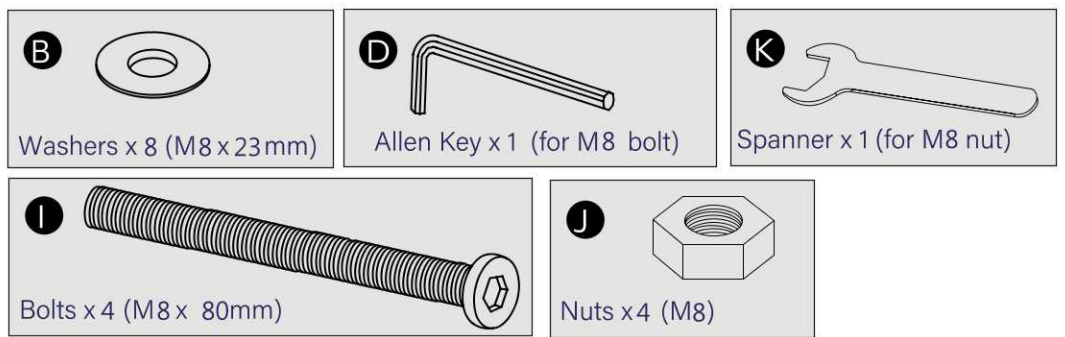
Step 9



Note: The two wings of baseboard should be attach to the footboard.

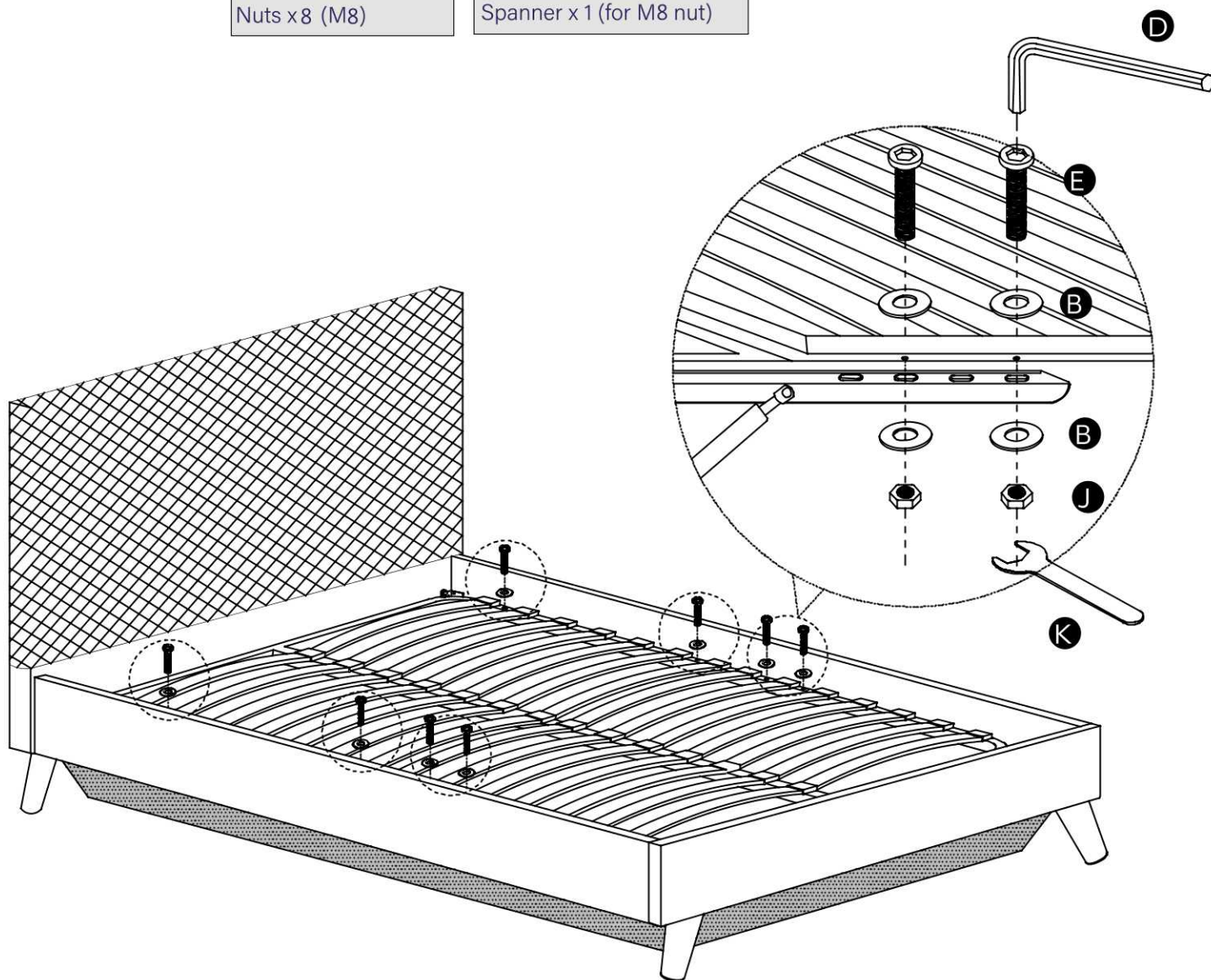
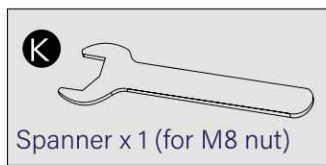
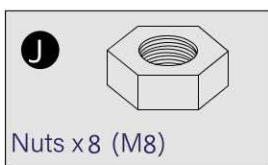
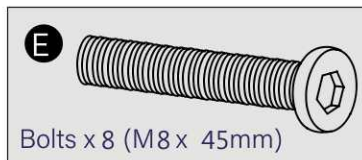
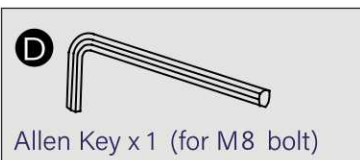
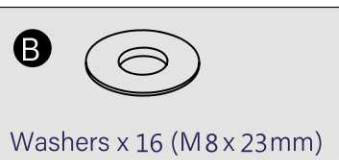
Please do not store items on side panels

Step 10



Tighten both slat frame (8 and 9) together with 4 x bolts (I), 8 x washers (B) and 4 x nuts (J) by using spanner (K) and allen key (D).

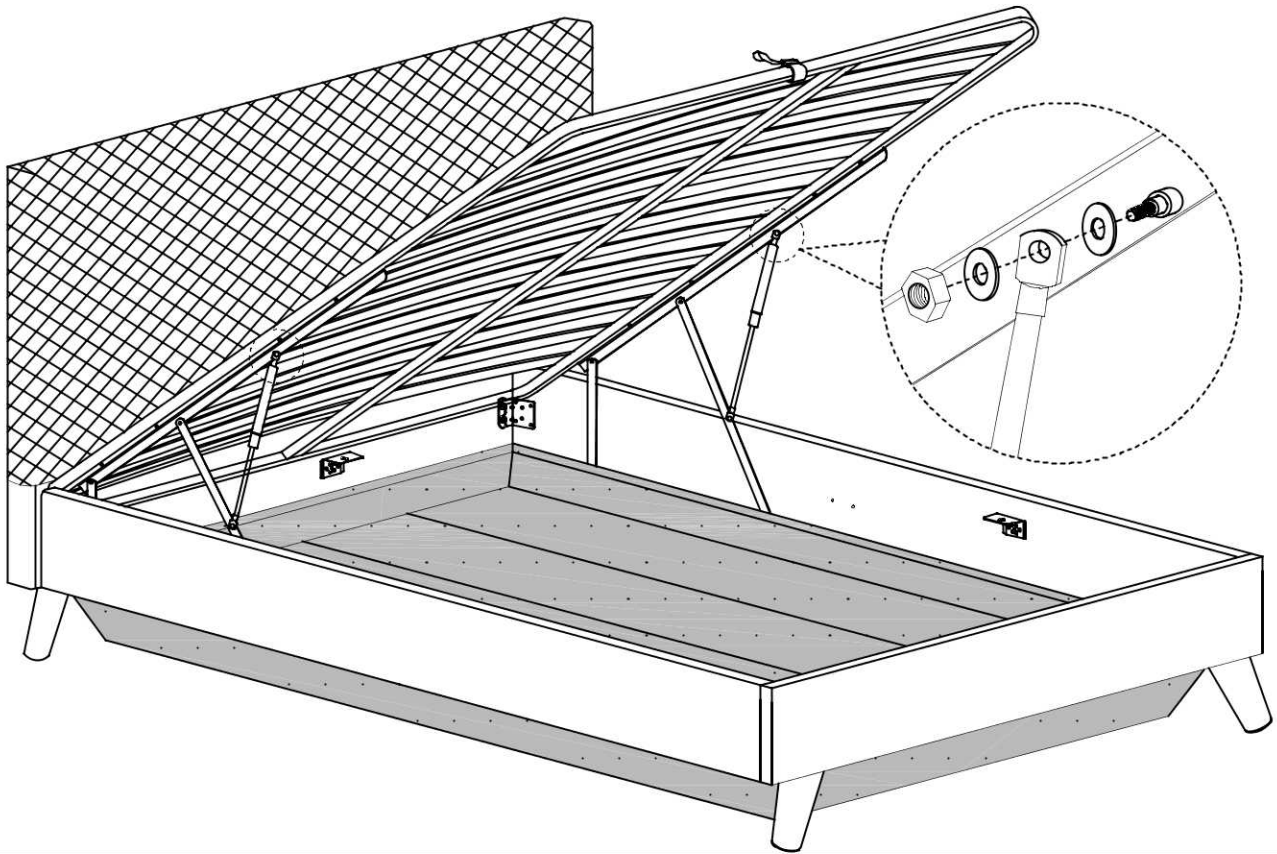
Step 11



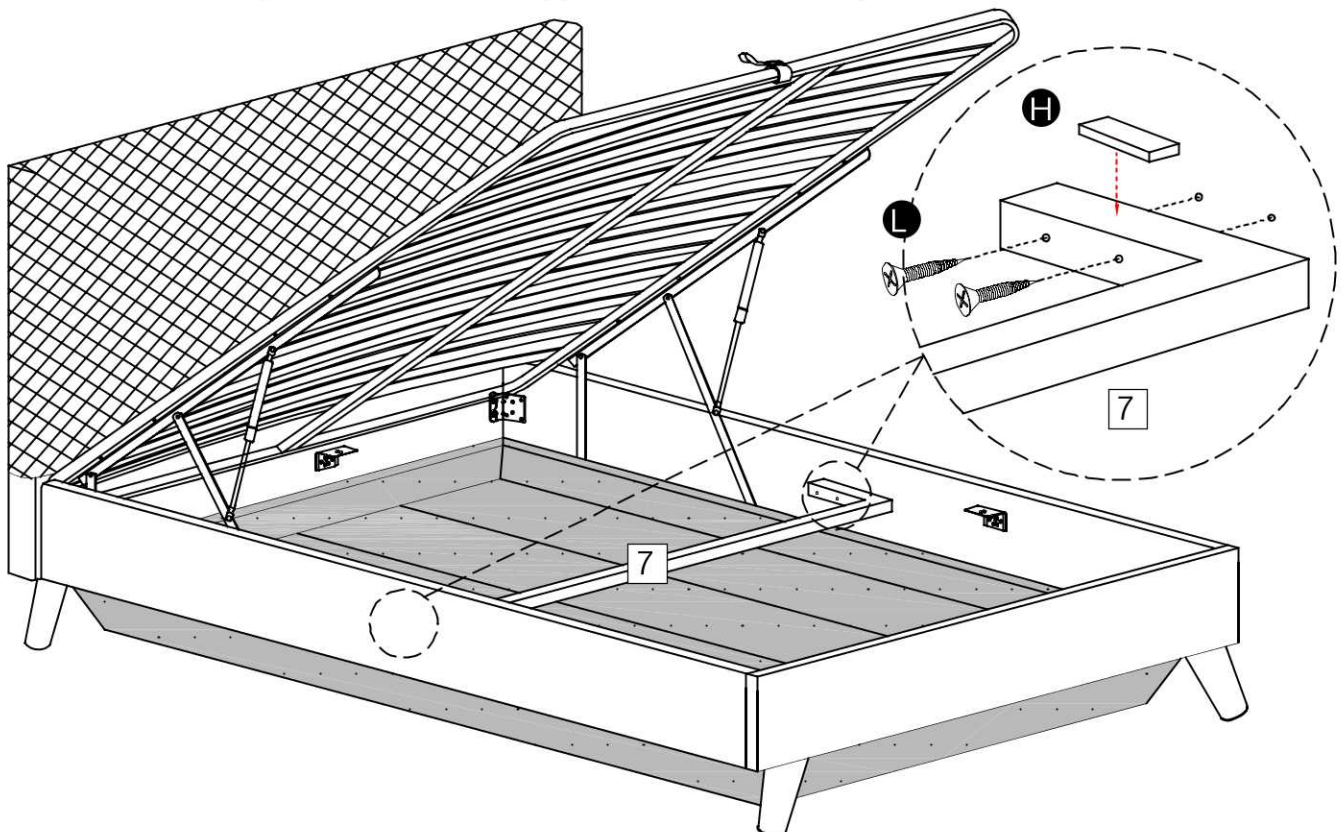
With help from your assistant, lift slat frames(10 and 11) onto slat frame support bars aligning first set of holes on the support bars (nearest to headboard). Using 8 x bolts 45mm (E) , 16 x washers (B) and 8 x nuts (J) by allen key (D) and spanner (K) .

Step 12

Un-tie each mechanism, take out the transit protection block.
Tilt the arms upwards slat frame support bar.
Tighten all nuts and washers on the arms.



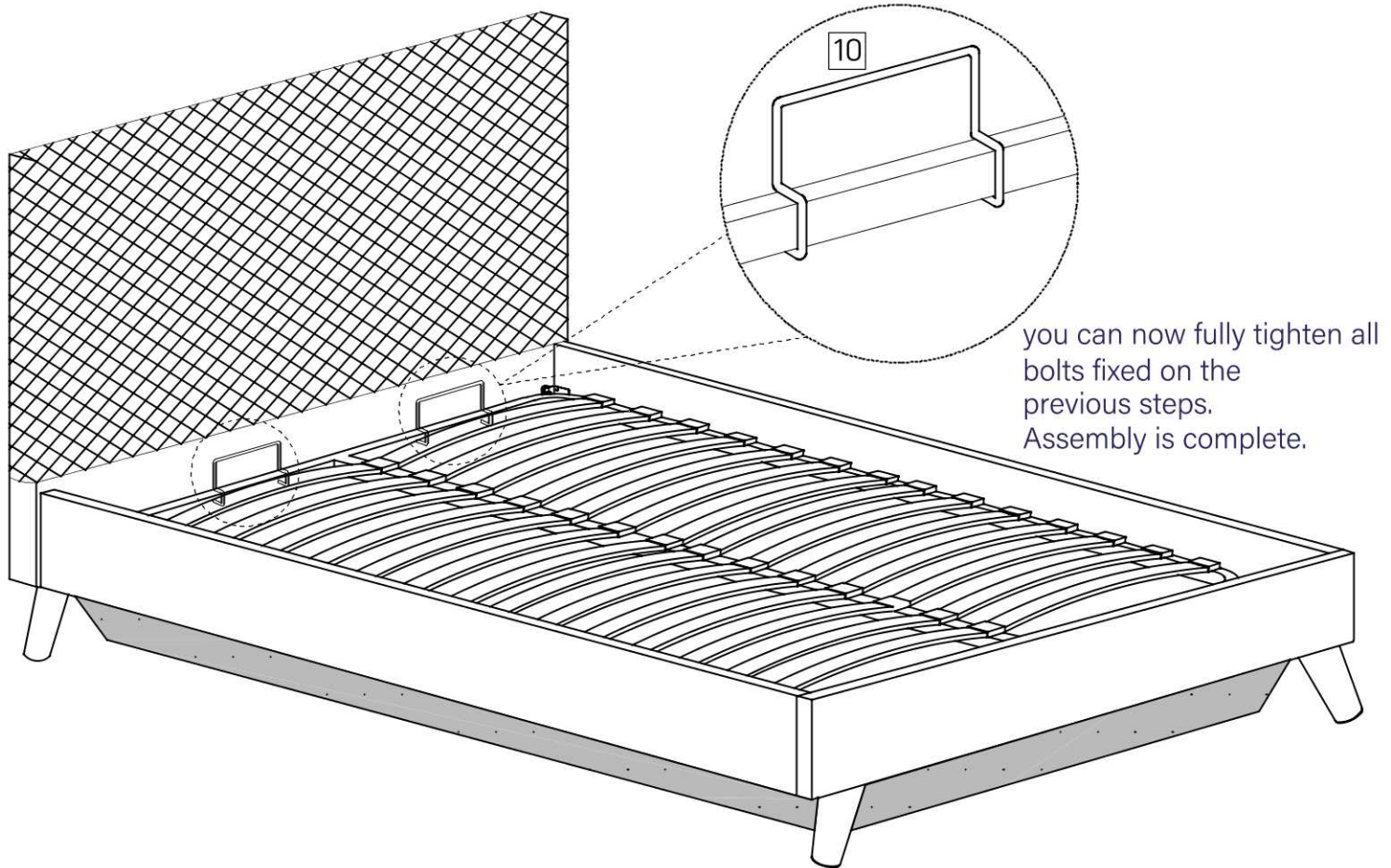
Step 13



Tighten the center supporter(7) to the side rails (3 and 4) with 4 x screws (L) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided). Stick the felt pad (H) on the top of end of center supporter (7).

Step 14

Put mattress holders (10) on the slat frame shown in the diagram.



you can now fully tighten all bolts fixed on the previous steps. Assembly is complete.

Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed. Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
