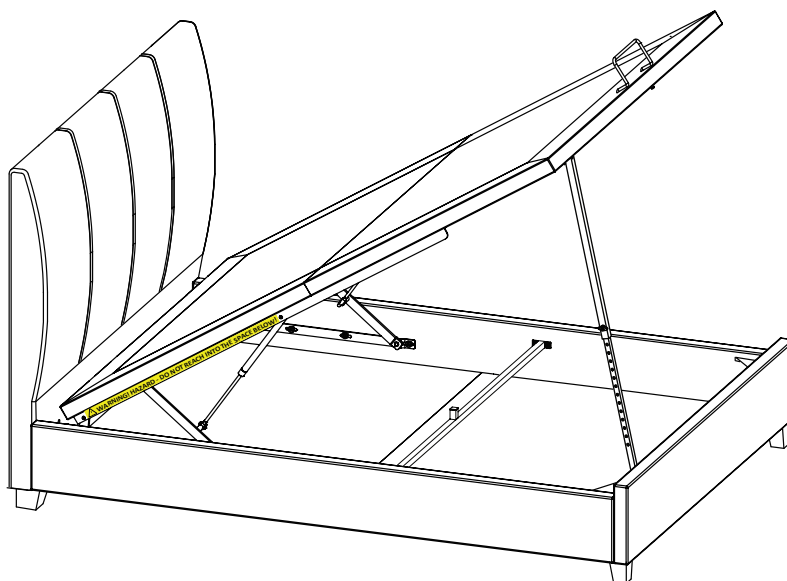

IMPORTANT OTTOMAN SAFETY WARNINGS

- **IMPORTANT - READ CAREFULLY - RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**
- You must ensure that the mattress is on the bed frame before operating the lift mechanism - Failure to do so could result in injury.
- Keep hands clear of the mechanism when opening or closing the ottoman.
- Beware of entrapment - Never reach in through the mechanism to access the storage area.
- Always ensure that the ottoman is **FULLY** opened before accessing the storage area.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight as specified in the table below:

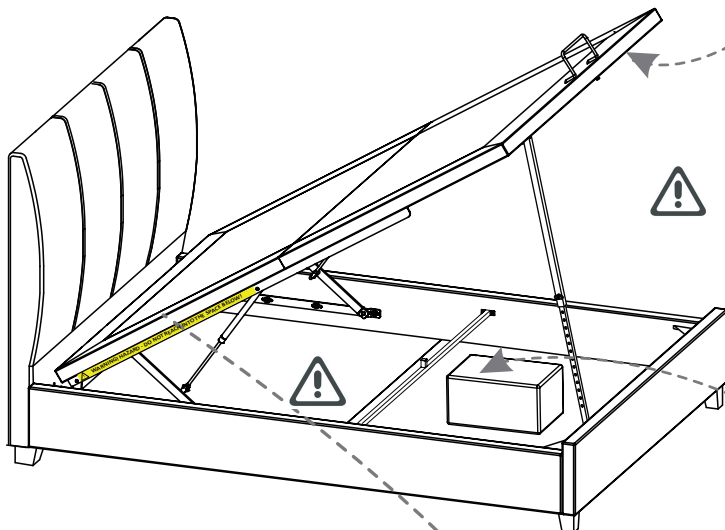


Don't lift without mattress



Ensure mattress is on
before lifting

- Use caution when operating, always use the handle when lifting.
- Note: This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- To be operated by adults only.
- Please ensure that children and pets are kept away from the bed when operating the lift mechanism.
- Keep children and pets away from the storage area.
- Do not overload the internal storage base.
- Do not stand inside the internal storage area of the bed.
- Before removing the mattress secure the frame to ensure it does not open unexpectedly.
- Do not attempt to lie on the mattress when the ottoman is in the raised position.
- When lifting the ottoman, remove all bedding except the fitted sheet.



⚠ WARNING

TO AVOID ACCIDENTS

To access the storage area, the ottoman frame MUST BE FULLY OPENED and then FULLY CLOSED afterwards.

CAUTION

To be operated by ADULTS ONLY.

Keep children and pets away from the storage area.

Avoid trapping your fingers by using the handle to lift & lower the base.

Only lift when the mattress is in place.

Ensure the ottoman support bar is secure when the base is open.

Regularly air internal storage area and contents.



Note: Be very careful what you store under the bed - the top of an item, like a suitcase or a box, must not touch the underside of the mattress base or it may get damaged.

Maximum item height is 225mm.

Ottoman Beds – Important Safety Features

Our aim is always to give you the best experience and to ensure every effort has been made to guarantee your comfort and safety. Please take time to look at these instructions as they will help remind you how to operate your ottoman bed safely.

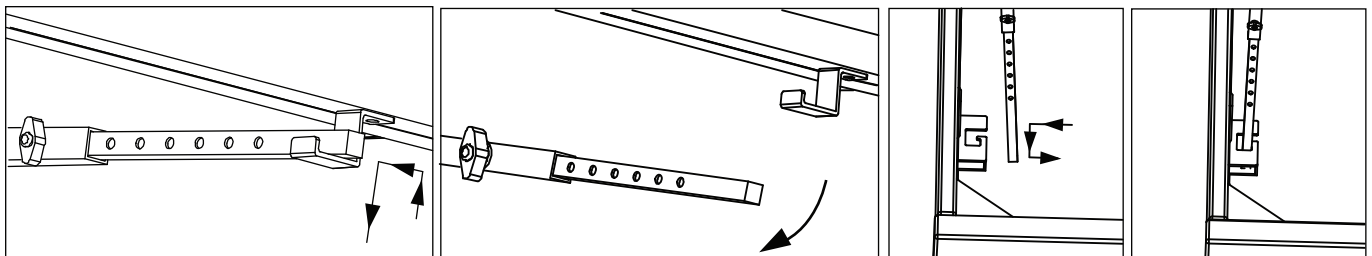
Here's a few things you need to remember;

- ✓ **Pistons are already assembled in their correct orientation – this improves piston performance and durability.**
- ✓ **"Break in " the piston seals on first use by raising & lowering the platform at least five times.**
- ✓ **Recommended mattress weights - do not exceed the maximum relevant weight specified on the Assembly Instruction.**
- ✓ **Ottoman support bar – always engage the support bar when accessing the ottoman storage area.**

Read all the instructions before using your Ottoman bed-frame and save the instruction booklet for future reference.

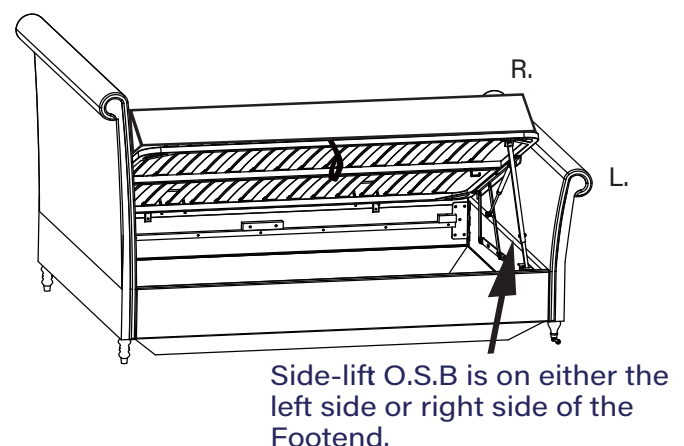
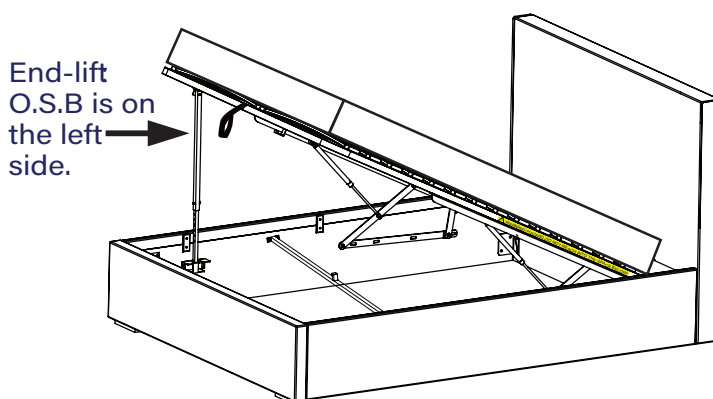
Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.)

For optimal safety during operation, always ensure the O.S.B. is engaged when accessing the ottoman storage area.



1. Always raise the ottoman slat-frame to it's highest position before using the storage area.
Locate the end of the O.S.B and insert into the fixed retaining bracket on the bed frame.
2. When you are ready to lower the ottoman platform, return the O.S.B to its original parking position.
3. Always ensure that the O.S.B is in position when the ottoman is open, this prevents injury, or damage to the product.

WARNING! Risk of Entrapment

- The pistons on the ottoman bed frame can support a maximum load (evenly spread) as indicated in the Minimum and Maximum load table, in the main Assembly Instruction.
- Overloading the sleeping platform may contribute to damage to the product resulting in potential serious injury.
- Do not sit on the mattress whilst the platform is in motion or is in the raised position.
- Users should only get in and out of bed when platform is in the flat (horizontal) position.

Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. 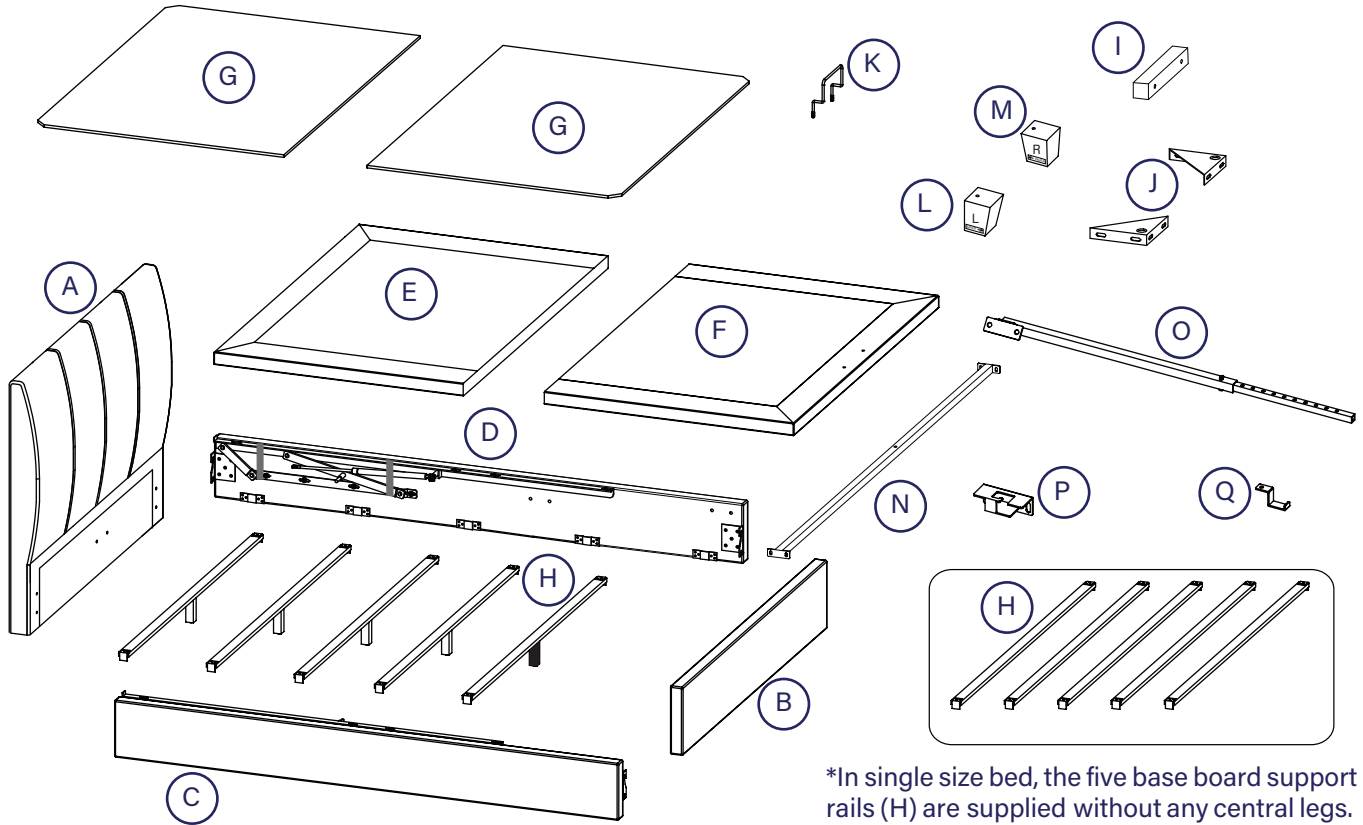

The bed you have purchased comes with an Ottoman lift up base, please follow the instructions in the current order.

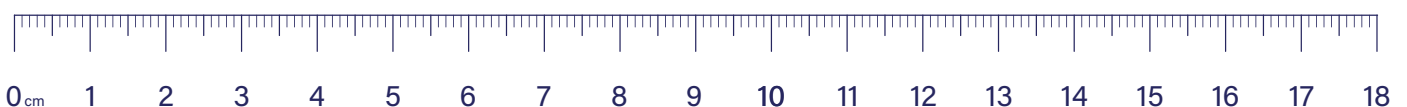

i) Please note: on the single size bed, there are no central legs fitted to the base board support rails (H).

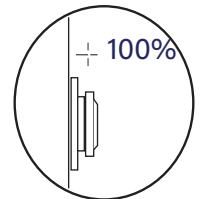

ii) On all the other size beds, the base board support rail with the black leg is the first support fitted into the brackets closest to the footboard.

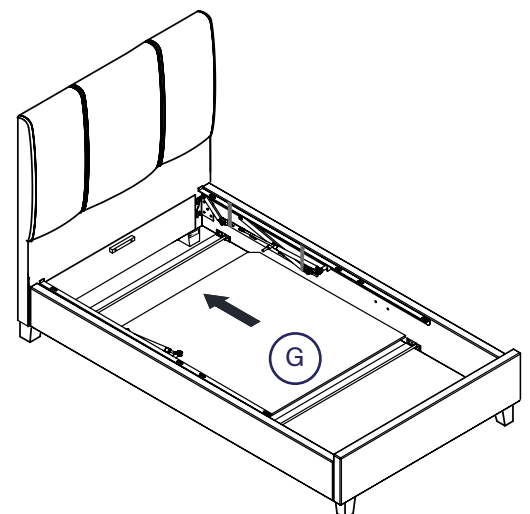
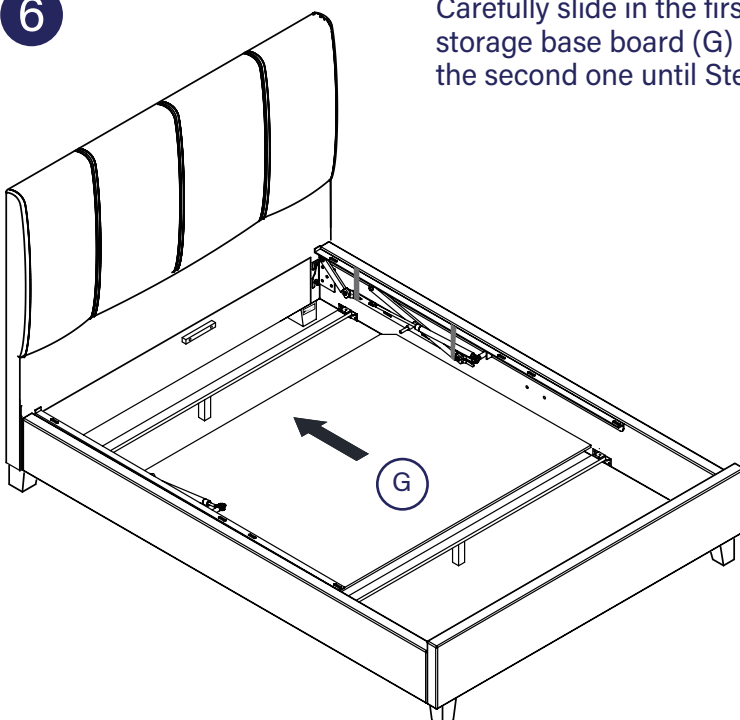


iii) After fitting the base board support rails, make certain the bed is squared up as shown in the diagram then tighten all bed assembly bolts 100%.

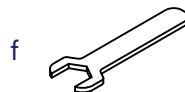

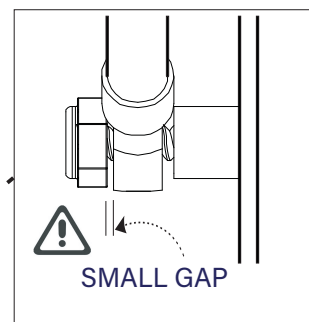
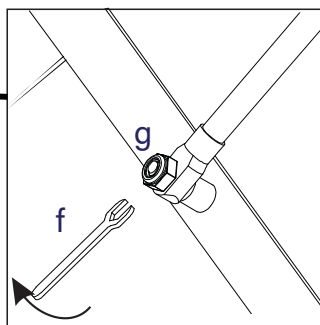
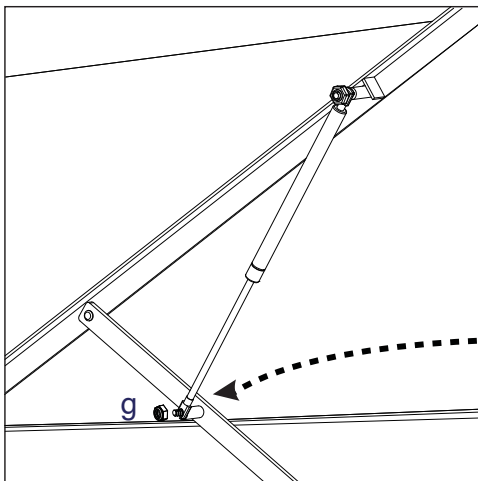
i) Untie the two mechanisms.



ii) Lift up mattress base board support bars.

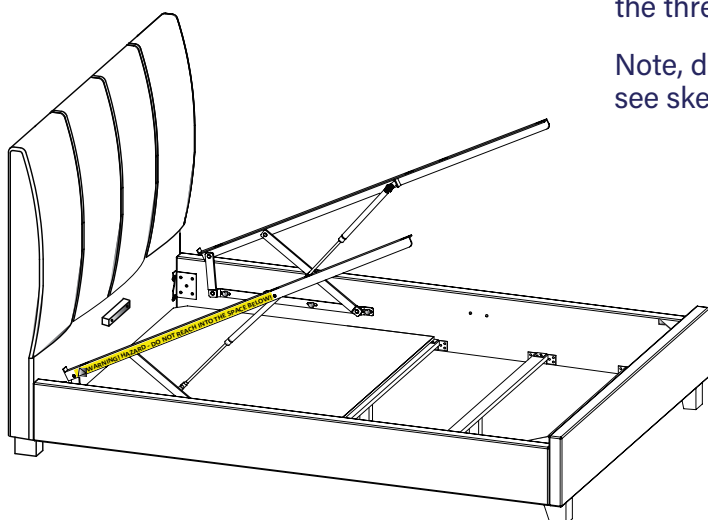


iii) Connect the piston stems

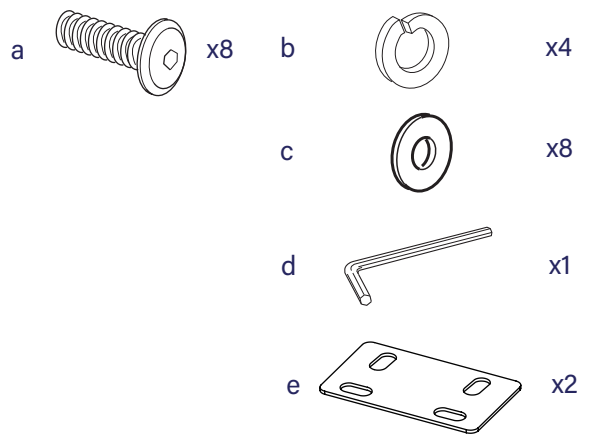


iv) Hold up each support and slide piston stem onto the threaded axle and fit nut (g) using spanner (f).

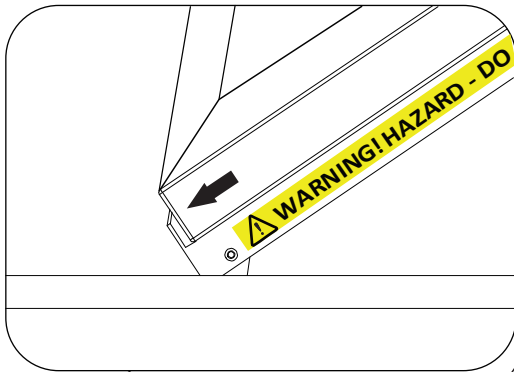
Note, do not over-tighten - a small gap needs to be left see sketch.



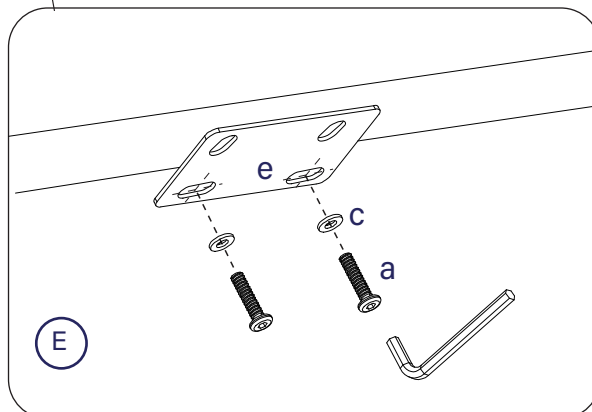
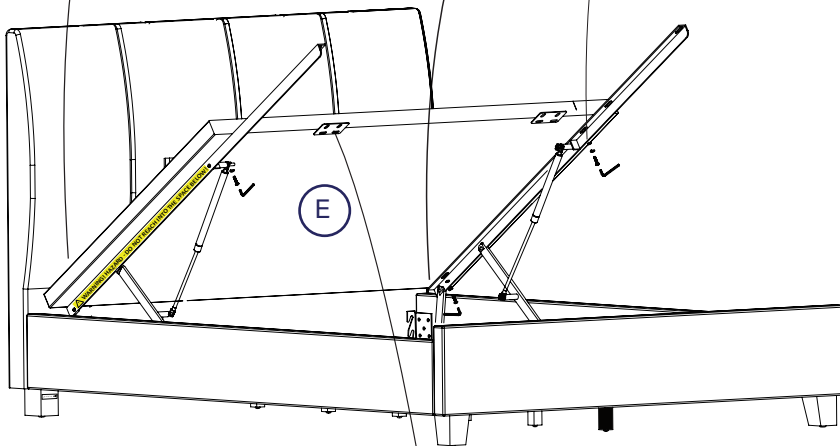
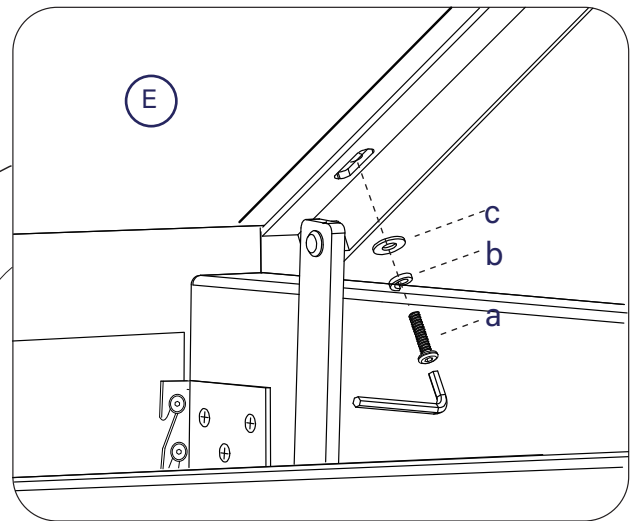
8 Mattress Base Assembly - Use Pack 'B'



i) Slide headend mattress base board (E) up against the lifting arm stop plates.



ii) Carefully screw x4 bolt sets through the supports into the mattress base board as shown - do not tighten 100% yet.

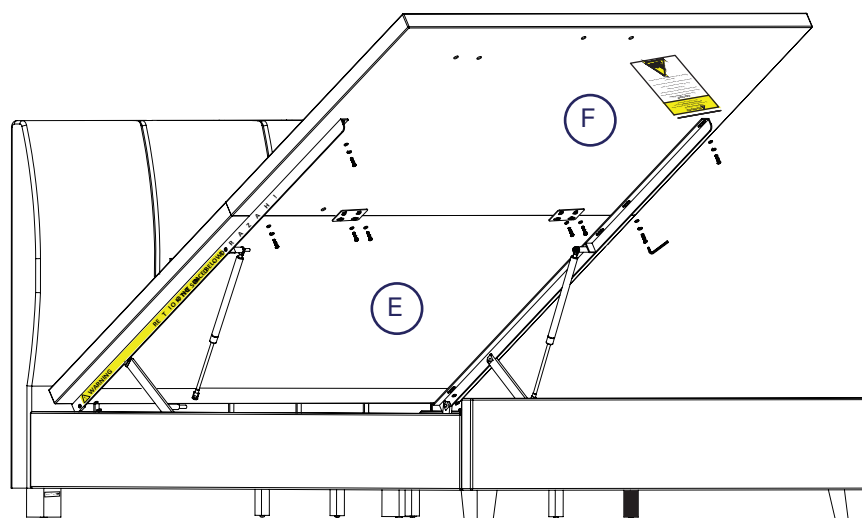
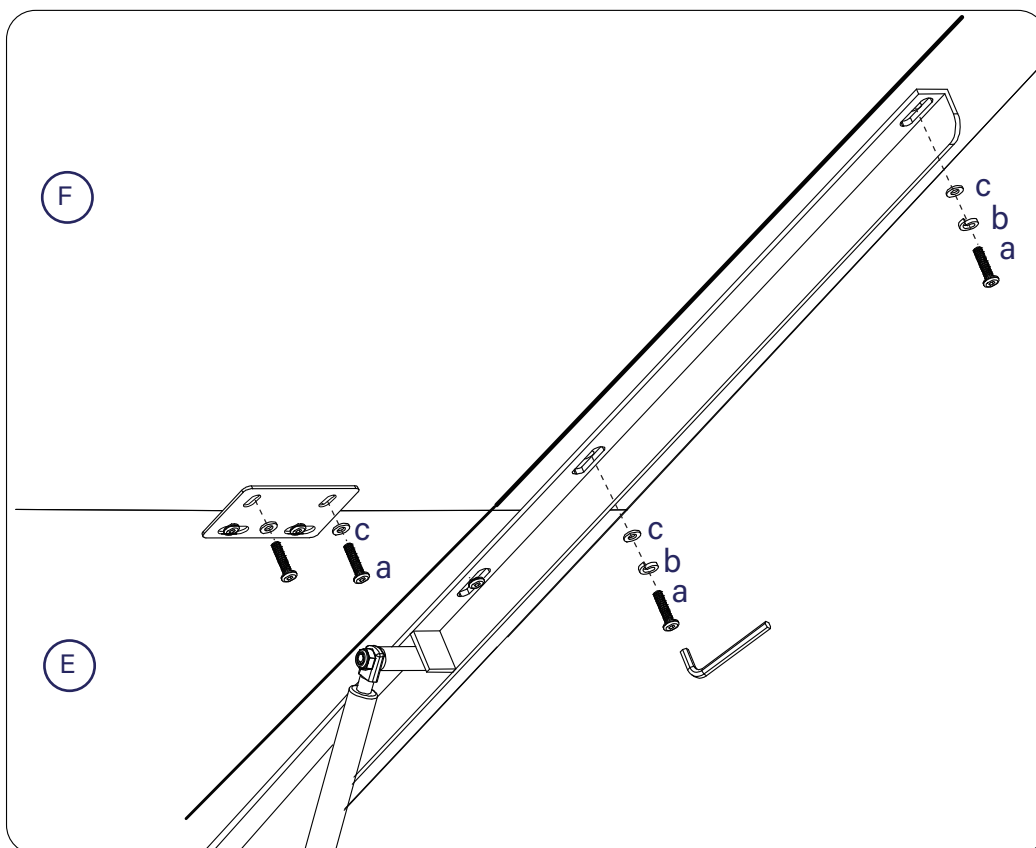


iii) Firstly, fit both connection plates (e) to the mattress base board (E) using bolt set (a & c), do not tighten the bolts yet.

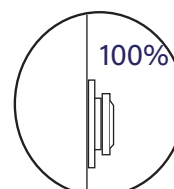


i) Slide the footend mattress base board (F) into position.

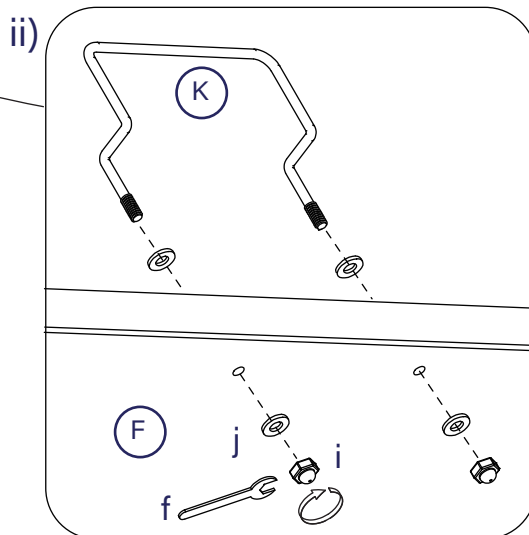
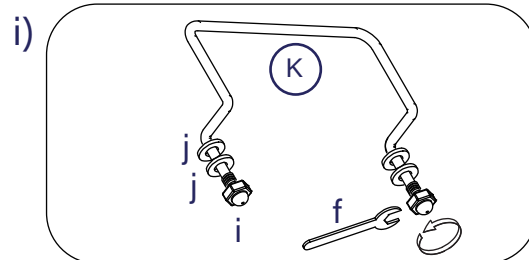
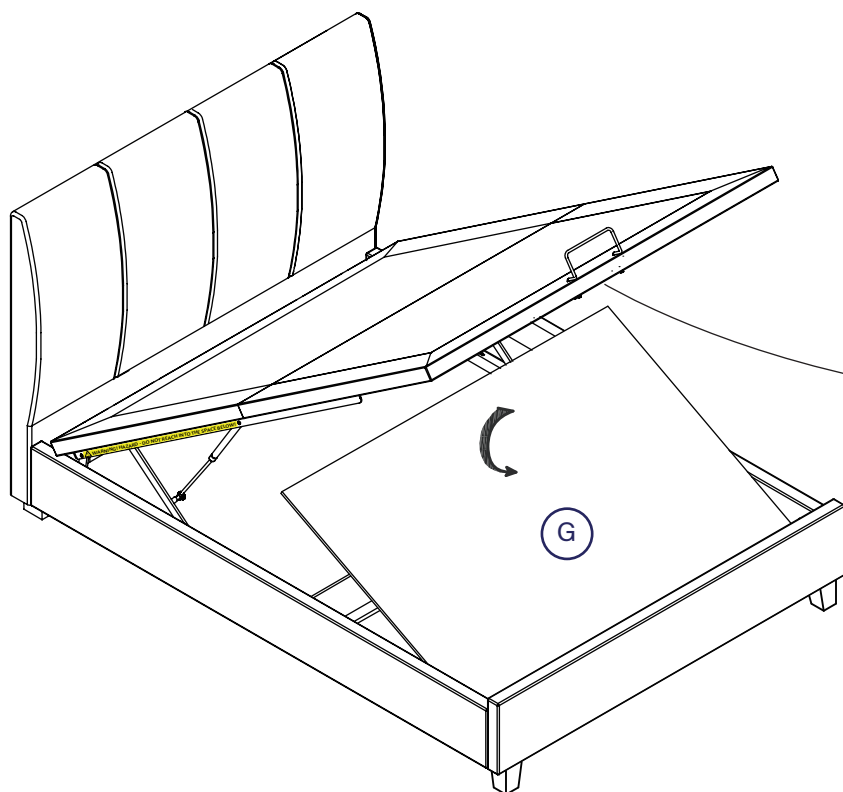
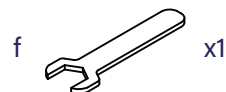
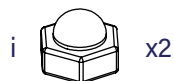


ii) Loosely connect plates (e) to (F) using bolt set (a & c) then screw other bolt sets (a, b & c) through the supports into the mattress base board at each side.

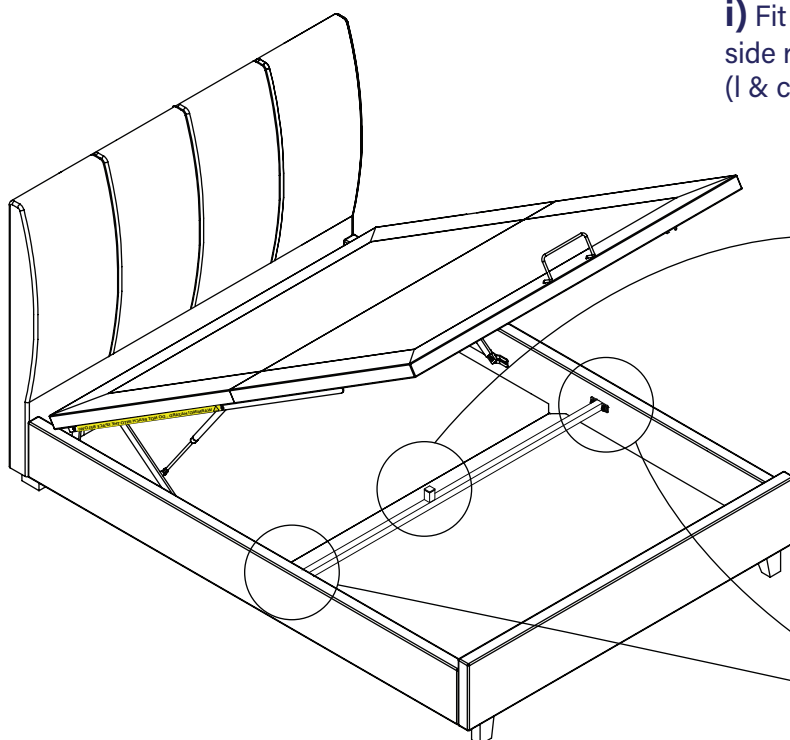
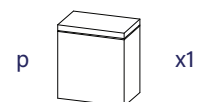
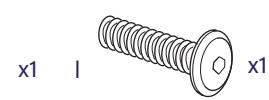
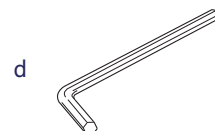
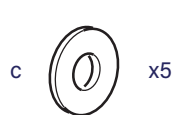
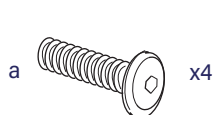
When all x16 bolt sets are in place, tighten all bolts 100% using Allen key (d).



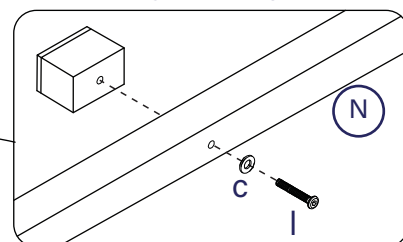
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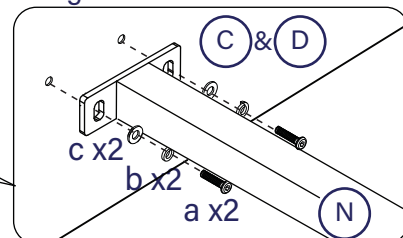

i) Fit the support block (p) in the centre of the side rail cross bar (N) using a bolt & flat washer (l & c). Tighten 100% using Allen key (d).



ii) Using four bolt sets (a, b & c), fit cross bar (N) to both side rails (C&D). Tighten 100% using Allen key (d). Take care not to damage the fabric when fitting.

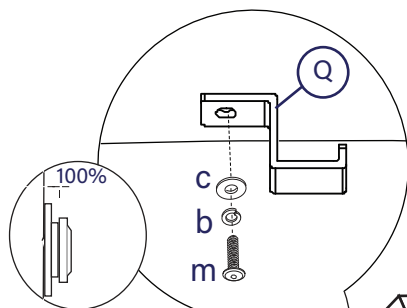

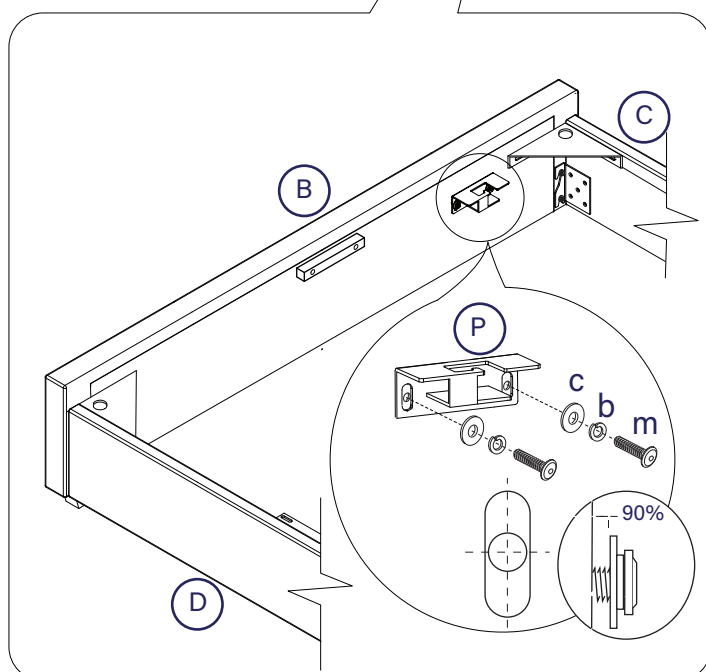
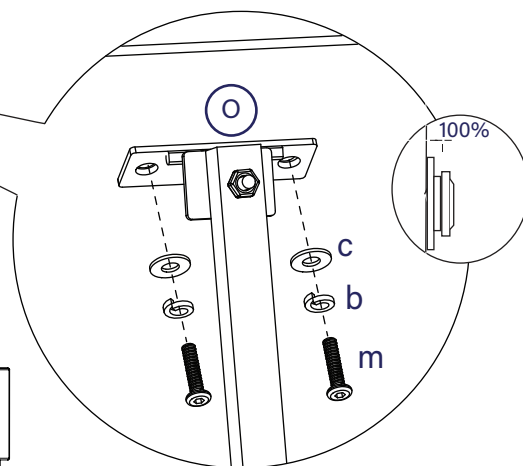
Unpack the contents of the Ottoman Support Bar (O.S.B.) from it's carton - this is packed inside Pack 3.



- i)** To underneath of the mattress base board, fit the parking bracket (Q). This is used to safely keep the support bar out of the way when not in use. Use one bolt set (m, b & c) - please make sure the bracket is fitted the correct way round as shown. Screw into the threaded insert on the underside of the board.



- ii)** To underneath of mattress base board, fit the O.S.B. support bar (O) as shown. Using two bolt sets (m, b & c), screw the bolts into the threaded inserts on the underside of the frame.

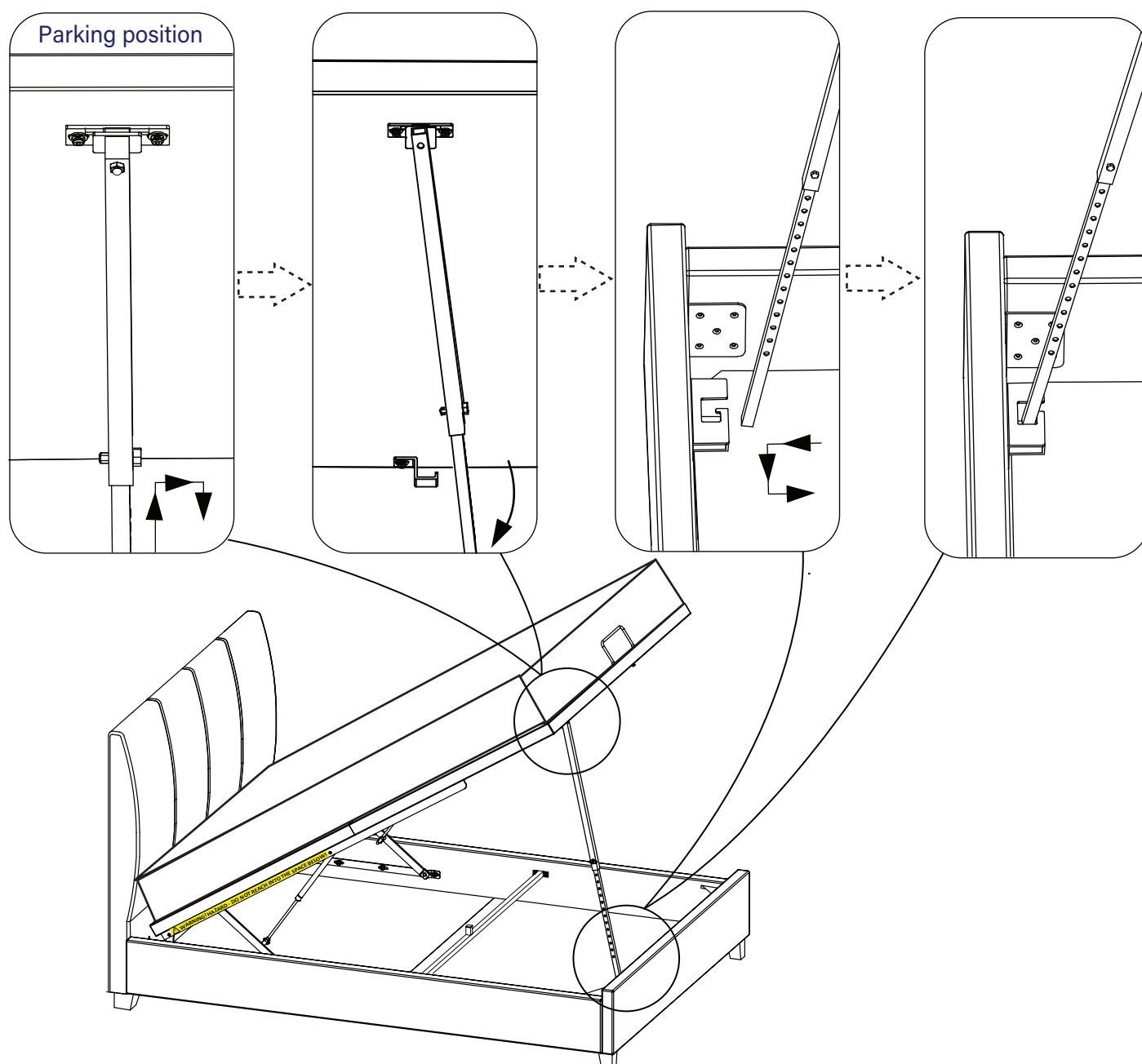


- iii)** Fit the fixed retaining bracket (P) to the footboard using two bolt sets (m, b & c). Screw the bolts into the threaded inserts on the footboard. Make certain the bracket is level and at the correct height.

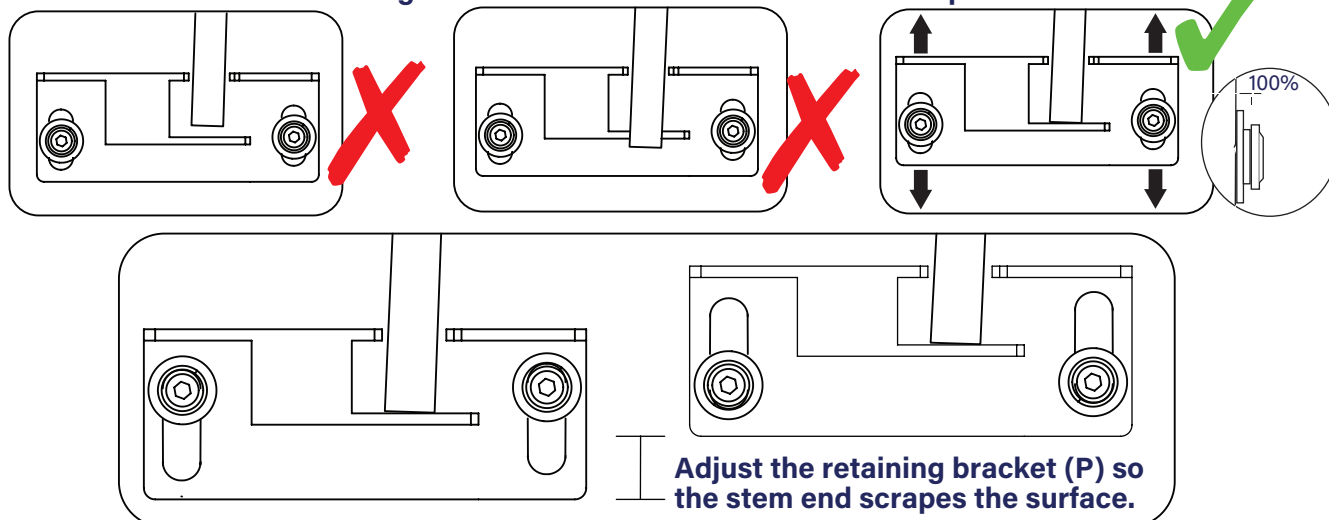
Please do not tighten 100% yet.

- iv)** The bolts should be in the centre of the long holes and one may need to slide the inner bar and the bracket, up or down so the bottom of the O.S.B. stem just touches the surface - better to do this **AFTER** the mattress is fitted.

13 Setting the inner stem of the support bar (O), adjust the inner stem to the correct length.



Set the inner stem to the correct length so the end just touches the retaining bracket - it needs to touch to hold it in position.

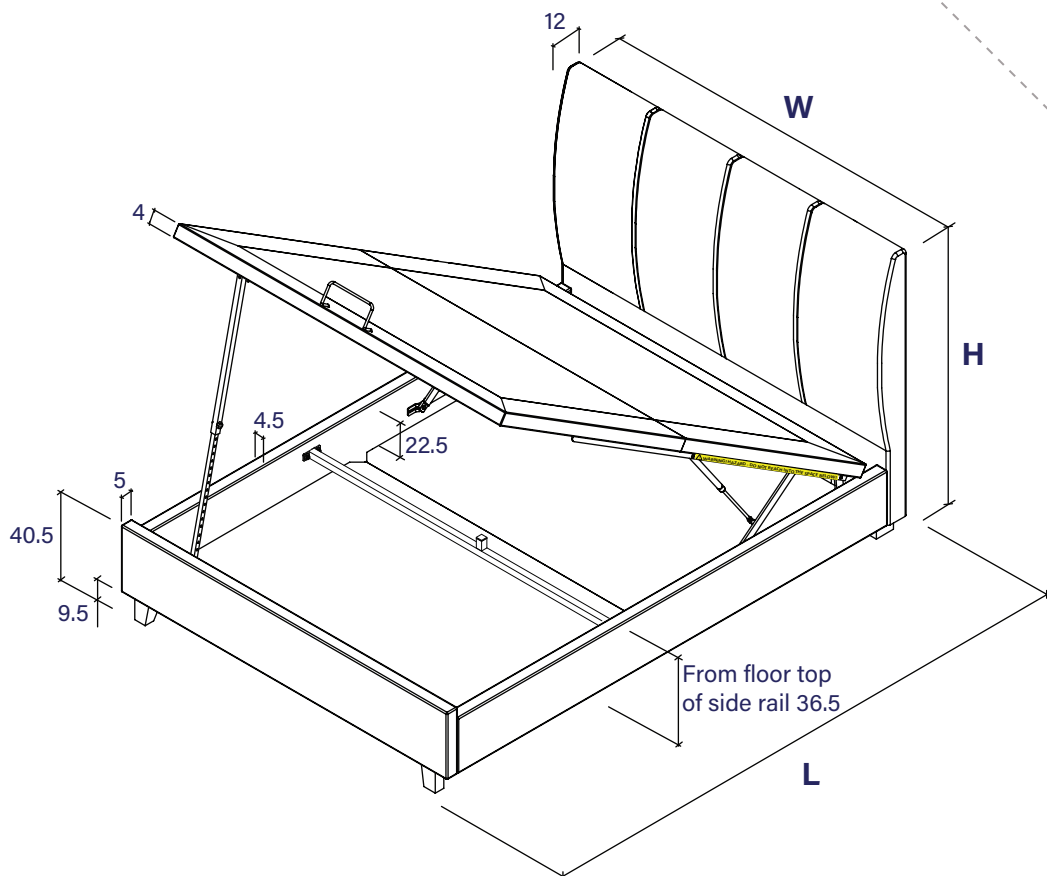

Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to your flooring.



Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Fabric

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



Metal

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.

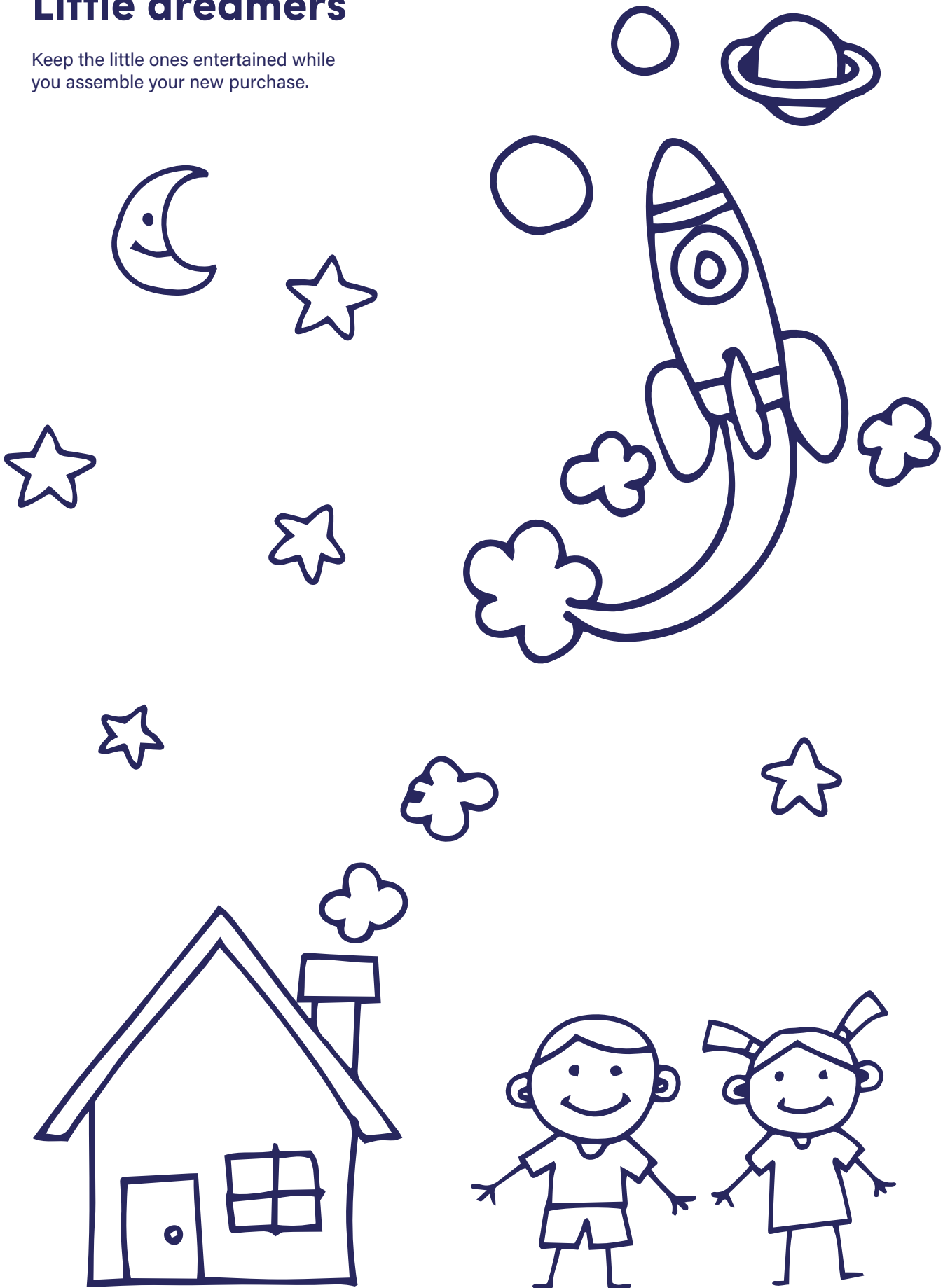
