

#### Assembly tips

Before you begin, it's best to identify all parts and fittings to build your bed. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and familiarising yourself before building.



#### Top tip

We recommend that you build your new bed in the room you'd like it to be located - this will help prevent any risk of damage to your newly built bed whilst moving it.



### Safety and care

It's really important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation. To keep your little ones busy, there is a colouring page inside the back cover.


### Important Ottoman Safety Warnings

- Caution. This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Use caution when operating Always use two hands at arm's length, and only where illustrated on the product.
- you must ensure the mattress is on the bed frame before lifting the mechanism
   Failure to do so may result in injury.
- Please ensure Children and Pets are kept away from the bed when operating the bed mechanism.
- If removing the mattress, make sure that the frame is secured as it could flip open.
- Only use the storage compartment when the frame is fully raised in the 'up' position.
- No children or animals are left unattended when the frame is in the 'up' position.
- Do not remain on the bed whilst the lifting mechanism is in use.
- Beware of Entrapment Keep both hands clear of mechanism when operating the mechanism.
- When lifting the bed remove all bedding Except the fitted sheet.
- Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until
  you get used to the speed.
- Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame keep fingers well away from the moving parts.
- NOTE: When fully assembled and the mattress is in position, please raise and lower the ottoman 4 /5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.







Cross head screwdriver









6 x washers (B) and 6 x spring washers (C) by using allen key (E) and 4 x screws 38mm (N) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided).









Attach 2 x legs (6) to the bottom of support wood (5) with  $4 \times bolts 20mm$  (A) and  $4 \times aushers$  (B) by using allen key (E).











Attach 2 x legs (6) to the bottom of headboard (1) with 4 x bolts 20mm (A) and 4 x washers (B) by using allen key (E).

Step 4







Install 4 x bolts 18 mm (D) to the holes in the headboard (1) as shown by hand. Note: Do not tighten fully but leave 10mm gap as in the diagram.




Install 4 x bolts 18 mm (D) to the holes in the footboard (2) as shown by hand. Note: Do not tighten fully but leave 10mm gap as in the diagram.



Attach side rails (3 and 4) to headboard (1) and footboard (2) by Allen key (E) as shown.




Attach 6 x brackets (I) to the headboard (1), side rails (3 and 4) and footboard (2) with 12 x bolts 25mm (H) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided). Stick the felt pad (J) on each top of bracket (I).




Put the baseboard (7) inside of bed. Attach the velcro to the four edges of frame.




Note: The two wings of baseboard should be attach to the support wood (5) of footboard.

### Please do not store items on side panels




Tighten both slat frame ( 9 and 10) together with  $4 \times bolts$  (K),  $8 \times washers$  (B) and  $4 \times nuts$  (L) by using spanner (M) and allen key (E).











With help form your assistant, lift slat frames(10 and 11) onto slat frame support bars aliging first set of holes on the support bars ( nearest to headbaord). Using 8 x bolts 45mm (G) , 16 x wahsers (B) and 8 x nuts (L) by allen key (E) and spanner (M) .



Tighten the center supporter(8) to the side rails (3 and 4) with 4 x screws (N) by using phillips head screwdriver (not provided). Stick the felt pad (J) on the top of end of center supporter (8).

Put mattress holders (11) on the slat frame shown in the diagram.



Depending on the weight of the mattress, the rising speed will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed.

Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.

NOTE:When fully assembled and the mattress is in position, please raise and lower the ottoman 4 /5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.

### Care and maintenance

Here are some tips to keep your new bed in tip-top condition



### Cleaning

To clean your new bed, we'd advise using a warm damp cloth or if fabric, remove dust using a low suction vacuum cleaner - please do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.



### Checking and moving

Periodically we recommend you check that the screws or fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your new bed, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.



#### Wood

Please note each of our wooden pieces are unique, meaning that markings and shade can vary slightly between beds. Over a period of time, the wood might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



#### **Fabric**

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time, the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.



#### Metal

Sleep well

Metal tends to be more resilient to everyday wear and tear. We recommend to gently dust your metal furniture and keep it dry to maintain its look.
